

Catching Up on Some Emails, Part 2

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Good morning everyone. Thank you again for taking the time to listen to the message this morning. I appreciate you and it is encouraging to know that so many are listening and are passing on the information you are getting from this hour on Missouri Liberty Radio.

It will be here before you know it. It's what the world calls March 18th through the 21st and will be, Lord willing, at the Maranatha Bible Camp and Event Center. It's about 30 miles northwest of Springfield Missouri. If you are planning to attend, please let us know as soon as you can. Once again, we are providing the food and we need to have a good idea how many to prepare for. So, if you even think you might be coming, please let us know.

Also, I have reworked the Funny Pages on the website. I think this one looks and functions a lot better than the old one. Some of you have stopped sending submissions to the page. These pages get a lot of views, so let's keep the cartoons or as the kids say, the memes, keep them coming.

Around 1989 or so, I wrote my second book. At the time, it was called *The Greatest Hoax*. And it was subtitled "*The deception of the "Christian" churches regarding the "End of the World."* At some point later, I can't recall the exact date, I made some minor updates and then changed the title to "*The Religion of the New World Order*" with the subtitle staying the same as it was before.

I do, still, to this day, believe that the false teaching regarding the "end of the world" as found in Matthew 24, is the official religion of the New World Order. The fact that the quote "end of all things" is always in the news, it's always a crisis moment, there's always a great fear, a great enemy, whether it's the blacks, or the Muslims, or a virus, or a nuclear bomb, or an asteroid, or an alien invasion - whatever these idiots contrive in their imaginations - there's always an imminent world-crisis - but don't worry too much - the New World Order is there to save the world.

If people - even just those who call themselves quote "Christians" - whether they are

true Christians or even simply “churchians” - if they just believed the Bible - as in Ecclesiastes 1:6-7:

One generation passeth away, and another generation cometh: but the earth abideth for ever.

[5] The sun also ariseth, and the sun goeth down, and hasteth to his place where he arose.

If the real Christians and even the “churchians” simply believed those 2 verses of Scripture, our present generation would quite possibly look nothing like it does today.

The “end of the world” mania is a direct result of false Bible teaching. Take that away, then the agenda would lose a lot of power.

The earth - the land and the waters that Yahweh created - abide forever. Read the entire chapter, the entire book of Ecclesiastes. The principles transcend the Old Covenant Age. These are generational principles that extend into the New World. The earth abideth forever. Man is not bigger than God's Creation. They may think they are - but we have a God that sits in the heavens laughing - laughing in derision at these mere men who think they have created the power to destroy what God Created - and what God said He loved - and what God said would abide forever.

And, why did I add verse 5?

The sun also ariseth, and the sun goeth down, and hasteth to his place where he arose.

I added verse 5 because of all the many new “catch-phrases” that these maniacs created in 2020, such as social-distancing, bubbles, masking, new normal, community spread, super spreader, contact tracing, contactless delivery - one that is particularly catching on - is “follow the science.”

I want you to know that in 2020, there have been people who call themselves quote “Christians” who have said, “the Bible, you know, it was written by a lot of people a long, long time ago, and they didn't have access to all the modern science that we have today, and well, those guys were wrong because they actually thought it was the sun moving and the earth sitting still. But, well, modern science has proven that those guys who wrote the Bible, they were wrong.”

Really? Really? Those guys that wrote the Bible were wrong about quote “science” because the modern scientist has proven them wrong.

Well, friends, those men wrote as they were inspired by God to write. If the Bible is wrong about quote “science” then the wrong is on the Creator - not on the created ones. The modern quote “scientist” today - points to nearly every single reference in the Bible to science - and says that quote “science” has proven the Bible to be false. For those of you who balk at this statement, I suggest you spend some time on Youtube - and yes - Youtube - because Youtube has chosen to be the voice or the platform for the modern quote “scientist” and watch some of their own videos.

I know that Bill Nye is an actor. But he's held out to the world, and the world believes him to be a representative of science. Listen to what he says about science and the Bible.

There is something really interesting about what Bill Nye said here. And it is when he said the U.S. needs - essentially - atheist tax payers, atheist engineers - basically - atheist citizens. He wants people to stop teaching their children the Biblical account of Creation - why? Because that stands in the way of the New World agenda, which ultimately removes God and the God of the Bible from all morality, from all quote “law-making.” Right and wrong is to be determined only by the inherent ethics found in man. To me, that's a problem.

Neil DeGrasse-Tyson is called the world's leading astrophysicist. His words are so ironic in that he says that quote “religion is not based on evidence, it's simply based on a belief” but his quote “scientific evidence” that he claims has existed for billions of years - is not belief - but evidence. That's so weirdly circular to me. Listen to what his belief in science has produced in him.

Now I realize that there are quote “scientists” out there who try to reconcile science with the Bible - or rather the Bible with science. I get that. There's a lot of those videos out there. But the basic issue that I'm presenting this morning is that the main goal of the quote “scientist” today - in politics - is to make people - especially young people - doubt the credibility of the Bible - thus making them doubt the very existence of God Himself. And, by removing God from society, then law-making is now totally left to man.

And today, in the U.S., it's all about following the science. Following the doctors. And not one single mention from any of them - about following God or the Bible. They've

basically conquered the God of the Bible in the minds of most of the people.

This is one of the reasons why I am so vigorously fighting against their obviously stupid masking requirements. You want me to believe that there is some virus out there that is apparently the most dangerous, ominous, killer virus known to man - and it can be defeated by wearing a simple little paper or cloth mask? Really?

I see images of military people with full protective body suits and gas masks and all that stuff - we've all seen it - yet we can protect ourselves and others from this killer virus with a cheap, fifty cent paper mask?

I am still - no matter how much propaganda is released - no matter how much it's in the news - no matter what they say - I am still of the belief that no such virus even exists. I do not believe it.

“But I lost my sense of taste and smell” is what someone told me a while back. Funny thing, I did a little internet search this past week and typed in causes of losing taste and smell. As if this is something new. Just hit the scene. All of a sudden, every single illness or sickness is gone from the world - and the only thing people get sick from is the phony corona-virus.

Well, I found so much on the internet I could spend the rest of my life reading about a term I just learned of. It's called anosmia - that's the term for the loss of taste and smell. They also call another form of it, hyposmia, parosmia, phantosmia - all of which can come from the phanvirusomia - which is a virus that doesn't exist.

The number one cause for loss of smell and taste is the common cold. For elderly people, the causes of losing taste and smell, from the US Institute of Health:

Aging

Sinus and other upper respiratory infections

Smoking

Growths in the nasal cavities

Head injury

Hormonal disturbances

Dental problems

Exposure to certain chemicals, such as insecticides and solvents

Numerous medications, including some common antibiotics and antihistamines

Radiation for treatment of head and neck cancers

Conditions that affect the nervous system, such as Parkinson's disease or Alzheimer's disease.

Losing taste and smell is not some new thing that started happening in 2020 when people get sick. It's not a sign that you have some new virus that is just now occurring in the world. It's a sign that you probably have a cold, which if your immune system is down - might develop into something worse - or you are getting older - or you have lived a life with habits that have taken a toll on you - like smoking.

The quote "scientists, the doctors," etc., are considered to be the leading quote "authorities" on this phony pandemic and they are the ones leading the way against so many unGodly things taking place today - not just in America but around the world. And I'm talking about taking people's ability to work away from them. Work is the foundation of any society. Men must work. If a man does not work, neither shall he eat - that's what God said. And when men prevent other men from working - they are committing one of the most fundamental rebellions against God that they are capable of.

You don't rebel against the Law of God. But since the quote "scientist" does not find any credible evidence for the existence of God - Laws concerning working and eating can be trampled on.

Well, friends, the very fact that God said if a man will not work, neither shall he eat - is evidence that God exists. Take that fundamental Law out of society, and see how long you exist.

And while I'm on Tyson's statements, let me remind you of what I was telling you months ago. Faith, Biblical, saving faith - is not some mythical - imaginary concept as in quote "take a leap of faith." Faith, Biblical, saving faith, is a system of belief based upon the myriad of truths recorded in the Scripture and seen in nature.

The Laws of God contain the cures for every single issue in life. Whether it be crime, poor health, relationships or capital G Government. I can see that when the Laws of God and obedience to the King and His Kingdom is implemented - then what follows is health, prosperity, and peace. That's not a "leap of faith." It's reality. It's the real world as Tyson calls it. Take gold and silver away from a society - even from a Godless society - in other words - when the U.S. was invented (and I used that word intentionally) it had

learned from previous disasters that using something other than gold, silver or copper as a medium of exchange would bring about every known ruin of a society. So even when a Godless society implements God's Laws concerning money, it will bring a certain amount of prosperity.

When, even a Godless society implements the Laws of God concerning crime or better stated sin - even that Godless society will reap the benefits of implementing those Laws and will have a society with far less sin. But when those Laws are replaced with man's superior laws and statues - what you see today is the result.

When I was a kid - back in the 60s - about \$5,000 quote "dollars" could buy you one of the finest Cadillacs money could buy. Today, it's 10 times that amount or more. Why? Because man's superior ways of economy to God's - has proven again - that in fact - God's Laws are superior and man's quote "laws" lead to poverty - just like the Bible says.

The U.S. has always had a sin problem - by nature of it's very origins - it has had a sin problem - but no one can argue that it has gotten worse and worse and worse as it has aged. This is not because - as the "churchmen" have said - Bible prophecy has said this is what is supposed to happen - it's because even the trace amounts of God's Laws that were in existed at its origin have been gradually and completely eliminated. This is why sin has proliferated the way it has.

I said all that to say this. For many years, mainly due to lack of funds, my book, The Religion of the New World Order, has been available online - for free - for anyone who wants it. And, I thought that was sufficient. The book has been getting over 200 downloads per month for quite a while. But I have been thinking that I should try to get the book back in print again. So, I've been looking at it again, making some slight revisions, and I hope to, at some point in the near future get some copies of the book printed again.

The false teaching of the "end of the world" has got to be attacked and attacked hard. It is the main problem we face - I believe. Because it denies the present day reality of the King and His Kingdom - which is the core - it's the root of all that's wrong in the world today. I believe this to be true and so many others are getting it, also.

If we can get people to begin to change their minds about futurism, I believe we can get them to realize their need for the King and Kingdom right now. Jesus, Yeshua is not a

coming King. He's not coming back here to fix everything. Things will get fixed when we obey the King and Kingdom - right now - and when His Laws, Statutes, and Judgements are again implemented on earth as they are in heaven.

Which now leads me to the place of getting to answering some of the emails that I started last week.

Last week, we revisited the concept of Satan, the devil, etc. Whatever that entity was - and by taking the whole Scripture into account - whether that entity was of supernatural origin or not - whatever it was - it was defeated. Christ foresaw its defeat while telling His disciples He saw quote "Satan as lightning fall from heaven." He told His disciples, 2,000 years ago, "Now is the judgement of this world, now is the prince of this world cast out." Paul told the first century saints living in Rome - that this Satan - whatever it was - would be crushed completely - it would be crushed completely under their feet - and it would be crushed completely under their feet - shortly.

Paul wrote in the book of Hebrews that Christ destroyed death so that as a result of His finished work - the devil - whatever that entity was - would be destroyed.

Way to go, Marcel - for writing in after the message was over last week and referring to Revelations 20:10 in regards to the quote "devil"

And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

Satan, the devil, or whatever it was - whatever it was - was defeated - in the first century.

So today - well - sorry - but the problems we face cannot be blamed on Satan, can't blame the devil, no, Flip Wilson, the devil did not make you do it.

Look at all the evil in the world today. Look at the evil little g governments - Satan is ruling them - and Satan is ruling them because God said that Satan is the present ruler - the prince of the power of the air. Sorry. No Satan. Christ defeated whatever that was - 2,000 years ago.

Our problems today can be found by looking in the mirror. We have no one to blame

but ourselves. It is the fact that - and again - I realize that most of us - you know the ones who have wanted to follow Christ - the ones of us who have tried to study our Bibles - we've longed for the truth - we've wanted no King but Jesus - I get it - we aren't the enemies of Christ here - I understand that - but in many ways - we have to admit this - we have followed false teaching that has held us back from reaching our generation for the Kingdom of Christ. We the people - are the problem. I may have gotten a little ahead of myself there. We the people is another email that I hope to get to this morning.

I want you to turn to Galatians 5 this morning. I realize that when you have been taught all your life that there is a quote "Satan" or a "devil" and someone comes along and says - "Nope, that's not Biblical." That can be a challenge to as they say, "wrap your head around."

I remember as a little child, being told about Satan or the devil in quote "church." And I can remember many times as a little kid - standing away from my bed - and then jumping in it at night - so that the "devil" didn't grab me by my legs. Funny, how I told my family that story this past week and my wife - who wasn't even raised in the quote "church" told me the same thing.

Which brings me to another point. I think I told you this story before - but I'm sure there are those listening today that have never heard it. Years ago, probably 25 or so, Teresa had been speaking at a home-birth seminar. And she had made mention - and I don't remember why it even came up in her speech - but something was said about there not being a Satan or devil. And after the speech was over, there was a woman - I'll not call her a lady - probably should have just said female - but this female nearly physically attacked Teresa and I because we were saying that there was no such thing as Satan or the devil.

This female was relentless. Really made a spectacle of herself. And finally, it dawned on me - and I said to her, "I'm sorrow we have attacked your god." This Satan or the devil - whatever it was - and the religious crowd has all sorts of answers as to what it is - and I said "is" because to them - "it" still exists - but this Satan or devil is as important to them and their cause as God Himself is. This Satan, this devil, is omnipotent - all powerful - and omnipresent. It's everywhere.

I've had quite a few people in my life who have told me that my teaching is ridiculous because they have quote "seen the devil" or they've seen "Satan." They've had actual,

physical fights, I mean, knock-down dragouts - with this creature. So, no matter what the Bible says, no matter what Christ said - no matter that He was raised from the dead for the purpose of destroying him who had the power of death - that is the devil - they won't believe because they have had fights with the devil.

After listening to a preacher tell me this, finally I said, "You mean to tell me that of the billions of people living on this earth, you were so important to the devil, that he came to your house in the middle of the night and picked a fight with you?" Of all the people that he could be fighting with - he chose to fight with you? Wow. You are really something.

Immediately reminded me of Paul's words that men ought not to think of themselves more highly than they should. Romans 12:3.

Alright, let's get to Galatians 5, verse 19.

[19] Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness,

[20] Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies,

[21] Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

I love to hear my wife talk about this passage. She gets it and got it over 30 years ago when it was presented to her for the first time. With all that the flesh is capable of - who needs Satan? Who needs a devil?

The warning here is not concerning some Satan or some devil. Romans 7:18 says

For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: for to will is present with me; but how to perform that which is good I find not.

That's what a true follower of Christ said in warning against the flesh.

I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin.

There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who

walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh: That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.

So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.

Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh.

For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.

The flesh is the problem. OUR flesh is the problem. It's the Spirit of God that overcomes the flesh. That's why our conversation, our way of life, the things we do, the things we say - need to be Godly, Biblical in nature. We aren't to make room for the flesh. If we fill our lives with Godly, Spiritual things, we leave less room for the flesh.

There is no Satan. There is no devil. Our problems are us. Our problems are yielding to the flesh - instead of yielding to the Spirit.

But what about spiritual wickedness in high places. Absolutely, but that's not talking about the supernatural. That's talking about people - people who put themselves in high places - simply meaning positions where they believe they are higher than God.

Matthew 4, the story of the quote "devil" taking Jesus up into the mountain:

Again, the devil taketh him up into an exceeding high mountain, and sheweth him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them;

He, whatever it was, took Jesus, Yeshua up into an exceeding high mountain, and sheweth Him all the little g "governments" of the world.

But what about Ephesians 6?

[10] Finally, my brethren, be strong in Yahweh, and in the power of his might.

[11] Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

[12] For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

Our fight is not particularly with our neighbors, or friends, or family members, it's with the little g "governments" of the world who insist on keeping their rebellion to the King. The same man that wrote Ephesians was the one who was constantly in jail for preaching the Kingdom of Christ. Was it the spirit world that kept throwing him in jail? Was it the spirit world who beat him up? No, it was people that make up the little g "governments" of the world. Today, it's people that make up the little g "governments" of the world. People who have been taught by "churchmen" that they are in their quote "place" because God has ordained it to be so.

No, they aren't in their place because God ordained it - they are in their place because they are rebellious, evil men who have chosen to walk in the power of darkness and they refuse to bow their knees to King Jesus and His Kingdom. Our struggle today - is the same as Paul's was in the first century - in the first generation. That generation fought against the King and ours does, too.

[13] Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

[14] Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;

[15] And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;

[16] Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

[17] And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:

[18] Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

[19] And for me, that utterance may be given unto me, that I may open my mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel,

[20] For which I am an ambassador in bonds: that therein I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.

[21] But that ye also may know my affairs, and how I do, Tychicus, a beloved brother and faithful minister in Yahweh, shall make known to you all things:

[22] Whom I have sent unto you for the same purpose, that ye might know our affairs, and that he might comfort your hearts.

[23] Peace be to the brethren, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

[24] Grace be with all them that love our Lord Jesus Christ in sincerity. Amen.

Paul is telling us - yes - these are generational principles - telling us how to defeat the enemies of Christ. And it's - above all - taking the shield of faith - Biblical Spiritual truths to respond to the attacks of the enemy. Deflecting their ignorance of the truth with Biblical, life-changing faith.

Another response to Paul saying we don't wrestle with flesh and blood - which so many people misunderstand and then argue that Paul is talking about something supernatural - is from II Corinthians 10:3-6. Let's take a look there for a minute.

[3] For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh:

[4] (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)

[5] Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

[6] And having in a readiness to revenge all disobedience, when your obedience is fulfilled.

He's saying that we don't pick up guns or swords or knives and fight this battle according to the flesh. It is a spiritual battle and it indeed is affecting our flesh - but it's not a battle where earthly weapons are used. We are argue with the Word of God and - and this is where we are lacking in my opinion the most - by our obedience - God will then take up the fight and revenge disobedience. But He does this when we are obedient.

Another email that came in that I wanted to discuss was interesting. The guy who emailed me was asking about resistance to evil when the evil could very well be the judgement of God. And I understand exactly what he was saying. Here is what he asked:

"I have to say that I've been wrestling with this for some time now as to whether "resistance" or taking a stand is actually resistance to what may be God's judgement. Or whether taking a stand and resisting is a part of God's judgement. Any thoughts on this? In any case, I figure I best be certain of who and what I stand for."

Here is my response:

"Resistance and rebellion is not normally a good thing. Especially for followers of Christ.

Let me clarify. If a man claims to be a U.S. citizen – there is actually quite a bit to "rebel"

against in regards to the “government of the U.S.” But a much better option to rebellion – is conformation – and that is conforming to the Kingdom of Christ. A change of citizenship is what is needed – not rebellion. Now, in that regard, if conforming to the Kingdom of God is considered rebellion by those in the U.S. – then so be it.

The man who sent me this email had also sent a copy of Dave Daubenmire's latest article called “We the People.” And Dave was doing what he normally does - in ranting and raving about the U.S. little g “government.” I get it. There's a lot to rage about. But then again, I don't know what people should expect from a Godless, rebellious little g “government.” They declared - almost from the day of their inception - “The United States government is not in any sense founded on the Christian religion.” So what do people expect?

Tyranny? Corruption? Lawlessness? What else should someone expect from a little g “government” that was born out of rebellion to the King of kings and Lord of lords?

My response continues.

Because “citizens” of the U.S. do not obey Canadian “laws” or Russian “laws” does that make them resistors to the Canadian or the Russians? Of course not. They are not subject to Canadian or Russian “laws.” So, claiming citizenship exclusively in the commonwealth of Israel means we have chosen to conform to God’s Laws and obedience to His Laws cannot in any way be considered as “resistance” or “rebellion” to other “country’s” laws. That is a much better place to be in.

Which brings me to Daubenmire and his article. I’ve tried to reach out to Dave several times but have only received very limited responses from him. First of all, he’s a flaming futurist. So, he has no credibility as far as I am concerned. He is also a CONstitutionalist – a “churchman” – too.

His appeal is that he resonates a message of rebellion because the U.S. “government” and most of society does not function the way he thinks it should. Which in some of his messages, is correct. But what he is missing so badly is that the “government” and society is doing exactly what should be expected from a godless government and a godless society.

And, his concept of “We the People” is exactly what the problem is. Society and the “government” is exactly what “We the People” would be expected to produce. “We the

People” are not inherently good. We are the problem. Godly Government is Government of God, by God and for God. The “people” are not consulted. The “people” do not have a vote, they do not have a voice. There is One Lawgiver – James 4:12.

“We the People” are what we should be separating from. Come out from among them and be separate. “We the People” is not the answer – it is the problem.

I probably should have said, the concept of “We the people” is what we should be separating from. “We the people” should also be looked at as, “We the flesh...”

Dave is close in his references to “consent of the governed” but his solution is still man’s little g “government” – i.e, the false “original intent of the founders.”

Consent of the governed should be what we, as followers of Christ demand – and that should be that we ONLY give our consent to the King and His Kingdom – and no one else. In Dave’s second to the last paragraph, his solution is:

“We, The People are awakening from a four-decade slumber. Government of the people, by the people, and for the people shall not perish from the earth.”

David, THIS IS THE PROBLEM. This is the ROOT of the problem. “We, the People” is the broad way that leads to destruction. The answer is – like I said above – Government of God, by God and for God – period. When it’s up to “the people” – it will just be a matter of time before it’s all messed up!

Last, even though I opened up my answer to you that resistance and rebellion is not the correct state of mind – rebellion and resistance to evil – is always better than conforming. The judgement of God on the U.S. is a matter of reaping and sowing. They have sowed the wind and they will reap the whirlwind because of their rebellion.

We better do whatever we can do to be faithful to the cause of Christ. Obedience to God is ALWAYS what is expected. (I Samuel 15:22 – an everlasting principle).

Do I believe that God is getting ready to lower the boom on the U.S.? As in Sodom and Gomorrah revisited? No, I do not. America is getting ready to have the boom lowered because America was born out of rebellion to the King - and America has sown to the wind - and will reap the whirlwind. America does not need God to quote “lower the boom.” America is committing suicide. America is killing itself just fine and does not

need the intervention of God to speed it along.

The reality is, for those of us alive right now - we should be pleading with God not to quote "lower the boom." Have we forgotten that we live here, too, and what the fire and brimstone that overtook Sodom and Gomorrah was not selective. It consumed them all.

What we should be doing is doing everything we can to get America to repent - one by one by one - if that's what it takes. Collectively, it sure doesn't look good for America - but we should absolutely be trying to turn as many to Christ as we can by our exclusive obedience to citizenship in the commonwealth of Israel - the ONLY God ordained Government in the world today.

Whether anyone, or no one else lives in the commonwealth of Israel with us - we need to remain faithful. The principle that disobedience is revenged when our obedience is fulfilled is a lasting, multi-generational promise and principle. It has to be. Obedience to God is a theme from cover to cover. No matter what anyone else is doing - and for the most part - it is a small group of people - maybe even an individual - but the principle is to remain faithful and do right no matter what everyone else is doing.

In closing, turn with me to I Samuel chapter 15 and we will begin in verse 1.

[1] Samuel also said unto Saul, Yahweh sent me to anoint thee to be king over his people, over Israel: now therefore hearken thou unto the voice of the words of Yahweh.

[2] Thus saith Yahweh of hosts, I remember that which Amalek did to Israel, how he laid wait for him in the way, when he came up from Egypt.

[3] Now go and smite Amalek, and utterly destroy all that they have, and spare them not; but slay both man and woman, infant and suckling, ox and sheep, camel and ass.

[4] And Saul gathered the people together, and numbered them in Telaim, two hundred thousand footmen, and ten thousand men of Judah.

[5] And Saul came to a city of Amalek, and laid wait in the valley.

[6] And Saul said unto the Kenites, Go, depart, get you down from among the Amalekites, lest I destroy you with them: for ye shewed kindness to all the children of Israel, when they came up out of Egypt. So the Kenites departed from among the Amalekites.

[7] And Saul smote the Amalekites from Havilah until thou comest to Shur, that is

over against Egypt.

[8] And he took Agag the king of the Amalekites alive, and utterly destroyed all the people with the edge of the sword.

[9] But Saul and the people spared Agag, and the best of the sheep, and of the oxen, and of the fatlings, and the lambs, and all that was good, and would not utterly destroy them: but every thing that was vile and refuse, that they destroyed utterly.

[10] Then came the word of Yahweh unto Samuel, saying,

[11] It repenteth me that I have set up Saul to be king: for he is turned back from following me, and hath not performed my commandments. And it grieved Samuel; and he cried unto Yahweh all night.

[12] And when Samuel rose early to meet Saul in the morning, it was told Samuel, saying, Saul came to Carmel, and, behold, he set him up a place, and is gone about, and passed on, and gone down to Gilgal.

[13] And Samuel came to Saul: and Saul said unto him, Blessed be thou of Yahweh: I have performed the commandment of Yahweh.

[14] And Samuel said, What meaneth then this bleating of the sheep in mine ears, and the lowing of the oxen which I hear?

[15] And Saul said, They have brought them from the Amalekites: for the people spared the best of the sheep and of the oxen, to sacrifice unto Yahweh thy God; and the rest we have utterly destroyed.

[16] Then Samuel said unto Saul, Stay, and I will tell thee what Yahweh hath said to me this night. And he said unto him, Say on.

[17] And Samuel said, When thou wast little in thine own sight, wast thou not made the head of the tribes of Israel, and Yahweh anointed thee king over Israel?

[18] And Yahweh sent thee on a journey, and said, Go and utterly destroy the sinners the Amalekites, and fight against them until they be consumed.

[19] Wherefore then didst thou not obey the voice of Yahweh, but didst fly upon the spoil, and didst evil in the sight of Yahweh?

[20] And Saul said unto Samuel, Yea, I have obeyed the voice of Yahweh, and have gone the way which Yahweh sent me, and have brought Agag the king of Amalek, and have utterly destroyed the Amalekites.

[21] But the people took of the spoil, sheep and oxen, the chief of the things which should have been utterly destroyed, to sacrifice unto Yahweh thy God in Gilgal.

[22] And Samuel said, Hath Yahweh as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of Yahweh? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams.

[23] For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of Yahweh, he hath also rejected thee from being king.

[24] And Saul said unto Samuel, I have sinned: for I have transgressed the commandment of Yahweh, and thy words: because I feared the people, and obeyed their voice.

We now seem to be entering one of the most somber states I've seen in the U.S. in my entire life. Today, they say the vaccines are not going to be mandatory. Of course, they wouldn't be so brazen, I don't think. At least not yet. But when the vaccines do not wipe out the phony pandemic - how could it wipe out something that doesn't even exist - they keep whipping the people into a frenzy until they try to make it where someone cannot enter a store - or if they do manage to get inside - the purchase will not complete unless a vaccine proof is shown.

We are at this point in time because God's people - those who should have been obeying the command to Come out from among them and be separate - was not obeyed a long long time ago. There has been virtually no resistance against these people - virtually none. Everything they have said to do - most all the people have complied.

“Oh, there's no way I'm taking that vaccine.” Yeah. I hope so, but we'll see.

If we have not resisted - or rather obeyed is what should be said - when it was easy to do so - I doubt that many will resist - or obey - when it is much harder.

Never in the history of the U.S. has it been - be one of us - or die. But times, they are a changing.

We should have been citizens of the commonwealth of Israel a long long time ago. We should have been demonstrating our obedience to the King a long long time ago. It was much easier then.

The great thing about our King...the great thing about our God...He is always ready to forgive us. Isaiah 50

[1] Thus saith Yahweh, Where is the bill of your mother's divorcement, whom I have put away? or which of my creditors is it to whom I have sold you? Behold,

for your iniquities have ye sold yourselves, and for your transgressions is your mother put away.

[2] Wherefore, when I came, was there no man? when I called, was there none to answer? Is my hand shortened at all, that it cannot redeem? or have I no power to deliver? behold, at my rebuke I dry up the sea, I make the rivers a wilderness: their fish stinketh, because there is no water, and dieth for thirst.

[3] I clothe the heavens with blackness, and I make sackcloth their covering.

[4] Yahweh hath given me the tongue of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to him that is weary: he wakeneth morning by morning, he wakeneth mine ear to hear as the learned.

[5] Yahweh hath opened mine ear, and I was not rebellious, neither turned away back.

[6] I gave my back to the smiters, and my cheeks to them that plucked off the hair: I hid not my face from shame and spitting.

[7] For Yahweh will help me; therefore shall I not be confounded: therefore have I set my face like a flint, and I know that I shall not be ashamed.

[8] He is near that justifieth me; who will contend with me? let us stand together: who is mine adversary? let him come near to me.

[9] Behold, Yahweh will help me; who is he that shall condemn me? lo, they all shall wax old as a garment; the moth shall eat them up.

[10] Who is among you that feareth Yahweh, that obeyeth the voice of his servant, that walketh in darkness, and hath no light? let him trust in the name of Yahweh, and stay upon his God.

[11] Behold, all ye that kindle a fire, that compass yourselves about with sparks: walk in the light of your fire, and in the sparks that ye have kindled. This shall ye have of mine hand; ye shall lie down in sorrow.

And Isaiah 59, another call to repentance,

[1] Behold, Yahweh's hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear:

[2] But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear.

Time to repent. Resist, rebel? No. Time to repent and turn back to the God of our fathers and claim citizenship in the Only God ordained Government in the world today.
