Message# 158 - 9-26-2021 - Predestination vs Whosoever Will

Good morning everyone. Thank you for taking the time to listen to the message this morning. I am honored that you keep coming back to listen to a perspective - preaching from the perspective that Christ is King right now. Men's little g governments are not king. They are not Ordained by God to exist in the New Covenant World. They are in place - not because God put them there and told people to obey them - they are there because they have proven themselves - time and time again - to be rebellious - to be totally dismissive - if not downright ignorant of the fact that there is a God in Heaven that is supposed to be honored and obeyed - and they move earth to make proselytes to their evil faith - their system of belief that teaches that God Himself has mandated for people to obey them in clear violation and opposition to the very clear teachings contained in the Bible.

Before I go on - I want to you remind that Kingdom Conference 2021 - fall edition - is rapidly approaching. We still have rooms available and are praying for bodies to fill those rooms so that we can expand our fellowship with other like-minded believers. Ted will be here preaching. I will be preaching. Matthew, Paul, Jerry, Doug, Sam - all have messages either prepared or being prepared. We need to be together. The Conference is what the world calls Oct 28 through the 31st and is at the Maranatha Bible Camp and Event Center which is just outside of Springfield, Missouri. The facilities are tremendous. We really hope you can come and be with us for that weekend.

The bodies have all been neatly piled onto the street corners and they are all out of the way of the streets. So, you can get here without having to dodge all the dead bodies. What a relief that is.

I have seen so many people come out in the media promoting Trump's lethal injection and I understand why "Republican" types would have done that had Trump been the one designated to the position of ruler of the U.S. But since whoever it is running the show decided they wanted Biden to be their spokesman instead of Trump - and with the way Biden is promoting the lethal injections - I wondered why so many Trump supporters are out in the media telling people to take the lethal injections.

As Republican lawmakers rage against President Joe Biden's sweeping vaccine mandates, the Associated Press reported that religious exemptions are becoming more widely used as a "loophole" to avoid getting a COVID-19 vaccine.

Now let me stop here for just a second. Once again, I know this is hard to hear. But if I don't say the truth - I'm just as bad as the ones I'm railing against this morning. If we were living the way we were supposed to be living - and listen now - I am not picking on one person here - millions are in this boat - not just one person - but the reality is - if we are faced with needing an "exemption" - I don't care what it is - not just the Covid lethal injection - any "exemption" - we need to reexamine the way we are living because if we were living the life that the Bible teaches - we would not be asked to "provide exemptions." Exemptions are for the "we the people" of the U.S. who do not want to abide by public policy.

Living the way we are supposed to live - we are outside of every single public policy they have in place. And just like the United Nations people who are not subject to the "statues of New York city" - we aren't either.

But, for those who are still trying to "Come out and be separate" - still trying to figure that out - I still want you to know that using their "exemption form" is a bad idea.

Stay with me now. God in heaven commanded you to work. Working is not a "privilege" that some little g government gives. Working is a commandment from God and no puny little peon man anywhere is allowed to put restrictions on your work - that God Himself does not restrict. Make your own statement. Don't use their forms - their forms are traps. It's the cheese on the mousetrap. Stand on your own and make your own declarations and tell these people you will not take their lethal injection. And furthermore - as a child of God - a Citizen of the Commonwealth of Israel - it's not even any of their business what your reasons are - for rejecting the lethal injection. You don't owe them a reason why you won't take their lethal injection.

If you choose to give them one, that's between you and God. But God doesn't require you to give them a reason. If you want to create a statement testifying to the Kingship of Christ - then by all means - I'd never stand in the way - in fact - I'd help you write it if you wanted me to.

And speaking again of people who are outside the city of God - let's get back to what effeminate Robert Jeffress, "pastor" of First Baptist "church" in Dallas had to say last week.

But a Trump-loving preacher at a Texas megachurch has decreed that there is "no credible religious argument" for turning down a shot, the Associated Press said.

would also have to abstain from the use of Tylenol, Pepto Bismol, Ibuprofen, and other products that used the same cell line if they are sincere in their objection," said Jeffress in an email.

Unbelievable. He may as well be the spokesman for Planned Parenthood. Good one. And if you knew anything about the Bible, you would have been preaching against those things a long time ago, too. But he doesn't have enough Bible knowledge to fill a thimble.

Jeffress, who once suggested that he would vote for former President Donald Trump over somebody who embodies the teachings of Jesus, is one of many religious leaders who have recently opposed the use of religious exemption letters.

There is a Youtube channel called the Young Turks and they really should be called the Young Jerks - but I found this and I want you to hear this. This is what we are up against - in our generation. This is demon possession within the so-called "church." Listen to this. They - these Godless men that put on this podcast - this is what *they* had said about "the reverend" Robert Jeffress, "pastor" of First Baptist Church in Dallas:

Similarly, the news agency reported that the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, and The Roman Catholic Archdiocese of New York have also said that they are not in support of exemption letters, according to the AP.

Matthew sent me something a week or so ago from Facebook- I think it was about this Evangelical Lutheran "church" - it was about them "ordaining" the first transgender "pastor" - then the "Church of Satan" liked it and said, "Getting there."

One pastor in Tulsa has even said that he will sign a religious exemption letter if people donate to his church, The Washington Post reported.

anything to do with Jeffress or the James River "church" in Springfield - in addition to their open demonic possession. I wondered if money had anything to do with them opening their facilities for lethal injection clinics or their promoting the lethal injection.

I found a website called Federalpay.org that shows where the Covid Pay Check Protection fraudulent payments were sent to. You can also find this information right on the Small Business Administration website, too.

But, and I told you about this a year ago, I found the official record where Robert Jeffress and his religious business corporation applied for a received a PPP Covid Pay Check. Now this is used to pay salaries - side note - when you get the time - you might want to study the origins of the word "salary." And again, I know so much of what I say is painful to hear - for the ones who are wanting to listen -- but I have to tell you the truth - Christians should not be "salaried." I know, I know, it's to not fun to hear and believe me - it's not fun for me to say these things. Especially because I know so many of you are seeking truth, you want to live in the Kingdom of God - we all do - I know that - but brethren - we need to make some changes - and while it may seem like it's too late for some us - nothing is impossible with our God.

There is no temptation taken you that is common to man, but God is faithful, who will with the temptation also make a way of escape that you may be able to bear it.

There's not an age restriction on that promise. With the bad news that we've messed up - we're doing things the way we are supposed to - there's always good news. If we will take the steps - God will provide. He is faithful. He will do what He said He would do - if we will only obey His Word.

Anyway, the website says that demon possessed Robert Jeffress, it says

First Baptist Church Of Dallas, Texas is a non-profit organization located at 1707 San Jacinto St in Dallas, Texas that received a Coronavirus-related PPP loan from the SBA of \$2,277,135.00 in April, 2020.

Did you see this one? Do you recall the new right's hero DeSantis down there in Florida telling schools they couldn't mandate the masks? Well, there was a school district in Alachua county that defied DeSantis. DeSantis then took away the school district's funds. Then, this happened:

Biden administration awards \$150K to Florida district that resisted DeSantis ban on mask mandates

WASHINGTON — The Biden administration said on Thursday that it was reimbursing a Florida school district that lost state money for imposing a mask mandate, in opposition to a ban on such orders from Gov. Ron DeSantis, the pro-Trump Republican.

The award to Alachua County Public Schools of \$147,719 is the first in the nation. It effectively compensates for the money lost in early September. Broward County, in South Florida, also saw state funds taken away because it ordered masking in schools.

The loss in Alachua County amounted to \$13,400 a month.

Say, they lost 13.4 and Biden sent them 147,719 to replace it. Wow. That's a good gig.

Imposed in late July, the DeSantis ban led to a war of words between the strident governor and the White House, as well as an accompanying, ongoing court fight.

Alachua is the first district in the country to receive a reimbursement for following Centers for Disease Control and Prevention guidelines, as well as the advice of most public health officials.

"We should be thanking districts for using proven strategies that will keep schools open and safe, not punishing them," U.S. Education Secretary Michael Cardona said in a statement.

Cardona is in the midst of a bus tour to promote the safe resumption of in-person instruction, which was halted for much of last year in many large cities, as well as in states controlled by Democrats, who tended to be more cautious about in-person schooling than Republicans like DeSantis.

The Biden administration has insisted that regular school classes resume, but that students wear masks indoors, even if they are vaccinated.

Some Republican governors, led by DeSantis of Florida and Greg Abbott of Texas, have prevented school districts from following CDC guidance on school masking, which has resulted in thousands of students having to quarantine in those and other states

The funds to Alachua County came from Project SAFE, a federal education department fund created in September "to provide additional funding to school districts that have funds withheld by their state or are otherwise financially penalized for implementing strategies to prevent the spread of COVID-19."

Kelly Leon, a spokesperson for the education department, said that Cardona aimed "to make awards as expeditiously as possible." End quote.

There's a direct payoff for a school district to rebel against the removal of mask mandates.

So if the u.s. "government" bribes school districts to rebel against their own "governors" - is it a stretch to think that these "churches" got their multimillion dollar "loans" forgiven as a payoff for holding the lethal injection clinics in their facilities?

Then, as if it couldn't get any better, it was reported this week that Pfizer - this is just Pfizer - not all the other lethal injection providers - Prizer made \$19 billion in quarter 2 this year - or - \$211 million dollars per day. Some known risks of their lethal injection are blood clots and cardiomyopathy. Luckily for them, they make Eliquis for treating blood clots - sales up 13% and they also make Vyndaqel to treat cardiomyopathy - sales are up 77%. Isn't this fun.

For the life of me, I don't understand why the Gospel - the Good News - that we can all become Citizens of a perfectly flawless Government - with a perfectly flawless King - with a perfectly flawless Lawbook - I don't understand why people are not running as fast as they can from people like Jeffress and running to Yeshua the Christ - the King of kings and Lord of lords.

Well, I hope some of that was enjoyable for you this morning - cause it was for me. I have to tell you it was highly enjoyable for me to call these people demon possessed. I know I'm not supposed to - I think it's supposed to "Jesus deprived" or "Spiritually Challenged" or something like that - but I just had to backslide there a little and call it just like I see it. Demon possessed. I really think that's the most accurate, most appropriate description.

In this new series of messages, predestination versus whosoever will, I want you to know that this is what I believe. I believe it is the most logical conclusion to the dilemma of reconciling predestination and whosoever will. But you need to know this is not a point of separation with me. If after hearing these messages, you don't agree, that isn't a point of fellowship with me. It's not like someone is demon possessed if they don't see this the same way I do. I just want to share the conclusions that I have come to after many years of study and from a perspective that definitely is not mainstream by any stretch of the imagination.

And, I also want to reiterate to you again, I by no means, believe that God has forsaken His Creation to sink or swim. I don't believe that at all.

I believe that God created the Heavens and the Earth and all that is in it. He created the wind and the sea, the sun, the moon and the stars. And I believe that He set them all in motion - and He does not have to micromanage those things to keep them doing what He created them to do. I do not believe that Creation - His Creation - stopped with Genesis chapter 2. He created and managed down to the very most minute detail - everything in His Creation - then set it in motion. I believe that He did this all the way through until the end of the Old Covenant World. I do believe that He managed - down to the very most minute detail everything in the Old Covenant World.

Now, interestingly enough, early on in this series, when the questions were coming in more than they are now, people were telling me they just cannot accept that God is not micro-managing in the New World also. And that's fine. But now, I'm hearing from some of those same people - that the people in the Old World *did* have their own choices. But yet, just a few weeks ago, some of these guys were demanding predestinaton and total control - but now they are advocating free will in the Old World.

I read intently everything that comes into my email. At least everything I see. Some emails are slipping by and I have told you before, if you don't hear back from me, resend it. I may not have seen it. I don't ignore anyone on purpose.

But the more I dig, the more I listen, the more I read, the more I am concluding that predestination and foreordination were for the Old Covenant World and Whosoever Will is for the New. But, with that, I am absolutely not saying that God no longer intervenes in our lives. I don't believe in that one bit. We can never - listen now - we can never let our own life experiences override the teachings of the Bible - there are coincidences.

For instance, I was listening to the radio this past week while driving down the interstate. There was something on the radio about a man named Paschal - p-a-s-c-h-a-l that was on the radio. And the exact same time the word Paschal was spoken on the radio, and that's not a common name by any stretch, I glanced over at a billboard to see the word Paschal - same spelling. That is a coincidence. That's all it is. The Bible says "time and chance happeneth to all."

But there are things that have happened in my own life - I've told you how I met Teresa. My wife of 32 years. Let me stop for just a minute, I am so saddened when I hear stories about Godly men - truly committed to the Kingdom of God and their spouses

want nothing to do with it - and in many cases - make life really hard for the ones who simply want to follow Christ - and here I am very young, in my middle 20s - pretty much given up on ever finding someone for a wife - and I'm just driving down the road one day - and I look over and see Teresa - and tell her to pull over - and she did - and we've been married for 32 years and have been on the same page with every single important issue in life. Never a disagreement on anything important. I, we, Teresa and I absolutely believe our story is the Hand of God working in our lives. I just find it nearly impossible to believe that was a coincidence. I led her to Christ, and she has been a devoted, fully immersed follower of Christ for 32 years. The story is amazing.

So, no, while I believe that God chooses not to know who will accept His Son and who will not - so that Whosoever Will is truly free will - that does not mean that God does not move on our behalf. It doesn't mean that God doesn't move things into people's lives in hopes that they will be presented with the opportunity to accept Christ. I believe we have not even scratched the surface as to what God does and does not do in the New Covenant World.

But I refuse to put our current situation in this generation - with all the evil that is proliferating - I refuse to believe that it is happening because it is the "will of God." The Will of God is "thy Kingdom come, thy Will be done, on earth as it is in heaven."

There are no lockdowns in heaven. There are no vaccine mandates and vaccine passports in heaven. There's no Joe Biden or Donald Trump in heaven. King Jesus is there and He rules in the lives of all who will allow His reign - and when there's enough of His followers to make a dent in society - His reign will increase. That's what I believe.

When the Gospel - the true Gospel - not the demon possessed theology of churchianity - when the true Gospel of the Kingdom of Christ is preached and embraced by the people - it can and will spread and when His rule is in place - the people rejoice - otherwise - the people mourn.

Please turn to II Peter chapter 3 with me. We've seen this a hundred times before. In light of what we saw last week in John 3 - I believe again - we will see the introduction of Whosoever Will - once again at the end of the Old Covenant age. Verse 1. Actually, it's II Peter chapter 3, verse 1.

[1] This second epistle, beloved, I now write unto you; in both which I stir up your pure minds by way of remembrance:

[2] That ye may be mindful of the words which were spoken before by the holy prophets, and of the commandment of us the apostles of the Lord and Saviour:
[3] Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts,

Right here, we see very clearly that what is being discussed is the end of the Old Covenant age. This is from the prophecies, this is what the prophets said, the last days of the Old World. That's what the phrase the last days means. Verse 4:

[4] And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation.

Once again, His coming, when did that occur? At the end of the world, in the last days. But look at what else is said here.

all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation.

They were saying - "nothing has changed. Things are still taking place in the same manner as they always did." But those believers knew that change was coming. Peter knew that change was coming. Not yet - but very soon. At His coming, there would be major changes. But as it was, when Peter was being caused to write what he wrote - the major change had not yet taken place. And he's going to address it.

- [5] For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the Word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water:
- [6] Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished:
- [7] But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men.

Here we see there was a world - or an age - that ended at the flood - then there was an age - the one in which Peter and all those of the last century of the Old World - that was the age they were in - and that age - that world which was then - by the same Word - was kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgement and perdition of ungodly men which was going to take place at the soon coming of Christ. That time period was on those people. And Peter is explaining this. Verse 8.

[8] But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord

as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.

Now once again - this thousand years - one day - one day he says - is as a thousand years and a thousand years as one day - this is exactly the same thousand years of Revelation 20. It's the same thing. This is not a coincidence. It's the same thing. The book of Revelation is about the judgement - the day of judgement and perdition of ungodly men. It's talking about the same things - and all of this is occurring in the end of the Old Covenant world - the Old Covenant age. Verse 9.

[9] The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness;

His promise of what? The promise of His coming.

There be some standing here, which shall not taste of death, till they see the Son of man coming in His Kingdom. Verily verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass till all these things be fulfilled.

What things?

Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken:

- [30] And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.
- [31] And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

Back to verse 9:

[9] The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward,

Look at that closer. Who is the "us-ward." That's Peter and the ones he's writing to.

not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance. [10] But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the

heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.

Here again, in the end of the Old World - just like we saw last week in John 3:15-17, God is not willing that any should perish - and how do they keep from perishing - but that all should come to repentance.

Stay here in II Peter 3 and go to Hebrews 12 again. We talked about it a little bit a couple weeks ago. I want you to see it again. These are the reasons why I come to the conclusions I come to and why I am sharing them with you. Hebrews 12: verse 14.

Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:

- [15] Looking diligently lest any man fail of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble you, and thereby many be defiled;
- [16] Lest there be any fornicator, or profane person, as Esau, who for one morsel of meat sold his birthright.
- [17] For ye know how that afterward, when he would have inherited the blessing, he was rejected: for he found no place of repentance, though he sought it carefully with tears.

When I compare this with II Peter 3, I believe there needs to be a reckoning. We need to understand this. Esau, sought for repentance carefully - full of care - concern - with tears - but he was rejected. He found no place of repentance. Esau tried to repent, but he was rejected.

But in II Peter 3 - and I think it is very important that we see this, look again, please II Peter 3. Verse 9:

[9] The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to **us-ward**, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

When I read this, I don't see Esau here.

I see this as those saints living at the time Peter was writing. They were in the end of

the Old World standing there looking at the New World. Something is different between the days of Esau and the days of Peter. Esau denied his birthright. Peter denied Christ - three times Peter denied Christ - but he was forgiven. Esau - the Scriptures say - before he was even born - not ever having done any good or evil - Jacob have I loved, Esau have I hated. Something has changed.

I believe Whosoever Will is one of the greatest changes to occur in the New World. I believe that if Esau, just like Peter, had been living in the same days as Peter - he could have repented and have been forgiven. And I still say - even if I'm the only one who understands what I'm trying to say - and I know I'm not because Teresa and others are telling me they are seeing it the same way - but Whosoever Will provides the greatest hope that we can have to turn our generation around for the Kingdom of Christ.

God is not willing or wanting - nor has He planned for our generation to commit suicide and friends - when they do - if we are not in Ecclesia - it's going to rain hard on us just like it is on them. But God is not willing - it is not His Will for us to be destroyed. It was His Will to destroy Sodom and Gomorrah. But that happened as an example to all the generations in the New World. He doesn't want to see our generation destroyed. He doesn't want to see our lives in misery. He doesn't want us to go through the things that seem to be coming at us full speed.

Jeff sent me a video this past week of what the maniacs in the World Economic Forum have said. This was a video they put out - "This is what your lives are going to look like." That's not the Will of God. That's not what He wants. In this Whosoever Will world - we can preach the Gospel - the Kingship of Christ and a turning to His Father's Laws - and people can repent.

He will heal our land if people will repent and turn from their wicked ways. That's what He wants. What the World Economic Forum is not what God wants. And it doesn't have to be that way. Anyone can come and drink from water of life, freely.

One of the reasons why I want this message to go out far and wide is because I see and hear so many people sitting on the sidelines of life just saying, "God is in control, it's all happening just like He wants it to." Well, tell that to the millions of people killed in Russia barely a hundred years ago. Tell that to so many others around the world that were just massacred because of the whims of wicked men. That is not the Will of God. It happens because people refused to heed the warnings. They refused to see what are such obvious signs of danger and they were caught in the trap that all you should do is

sit back and watch the show because Jesus is going to ride in at the last minute and rescue us.

Brethren, that's not going to happen. We are the reason we are in the shape we are in. I know that we are doing all we can to warn people and preach to people - and we need to keep on more than ever - but none of this is God's fault. This is not God's Will.

We are in a Whosoever Will world - but in order for Whosoever Will to occur - the Son of man must be lifted up. The King of kings must be lifted up. He must be the King in our lives so that others will see that they too, have a choice, to embrace the King.

When the King is lifted up - and He's lifted up by us - when we live the way He wants us to live - no matter what comes against us. No matter what threats there are against us - when we obey the King and demonstrate to a godless world - a Yahwehless world that there is another King, One Jesus - when He is lifted up He will draw men to Him.

But we are the ones doing the lifting. We lift Him up through our preaching, through our living. If we would obey and begin to build Ecclesia - His Kingdom - He would be lifted up in a generation that despises Him. In a generation where the supposed "pastors and preachers" openly declare that they prefer godless infidels over King Jesus.

We are not in a world where God is micro-managing the affairs of men to the point where all we should do is sit around and wait. Just settle into life, keep the grass mowed, keep the bills paid, and watch God move. We are in a world where God gave men an owner's manual and said, "Here, read this, believe it, trust it, and live it. If you do this, you shall live. If you receive my Son, I'll give you water that you will never thirst again. But if you refuse and rebel, you shall surely die."

Those are the choices. We have the free will to choose one or the other. A man can look upon Jesus, can look upon Yeshua Christ the King - just like so many did as examples shown in the Scriptures - and can choose to embrace the King and follow the Shepherd.

I hope, if nothing else, I've stirred you to look further and deeper into what I've been saying. And, like I said, if you think this preacher has missed it - well - I'd sure like to have more Biblical support for that conclusion.

There's still more. So, here's to hope that we will all be back again next week to study to

shew ourselves approved unto God, workmen and women that need not to be ashamed rightly dividing the Word of truth..
