Message# 161 - 10-17-2021 - Predestination vs Whosoever Will

Before we get into today's message, I want to share with you something I saw in the news this past week. William Shatner of Star Trek fame - who has already gone where no man has gone before - participated in something pulled off by the "richest men in the world." They went to space. Space travel. Of course, that's all very interesting because they accomplished this world-renown feat - this great achievement for mankind - by climbing to a reported height of - hang on to your seats now - you see - NASA - claimed to have gone to the moon - back in 1969. And, they say their journey to the moon was 238,900 miles - took several days to get there - and that was the small step for man and the giant leap for mankind. So, they supposedly went 238,900 miles to the moon back in 1969 - and Jeff Bozos and his crew climbed to a recorded height of 66 and a half miles this past week. What? 66.5 miles? Wow. That's quite an accomplishment.

In the article, Shatner made a couple of eye-brow raising comments - to say the least.

The article says:

VAN HORN, Texas (AP) — Hollywood's Captain Kirk, 90-year-old William Shatner, blasted into space Wednesday in a convergence of science fiction and science reality, reaching the final frontier aboard a ship built by Jeff Bezos' Blue Origin company. The "Star Trek" actor and three fellow passengers hurtled to an altitude of 66.5 miles (107 kilometers) over the West Texas desert in the fully automated capsule, then safely parachuted back to Earth. The flight lasted just over 10 minutes.

"What you have given me is the most profound experience," an exhilarated Shatner told Bezos after climbing out the hatch, the words spilling from him in a soliloquy almost as long as the flight. "I hope I never recover from this. I hope that I can maintain what I feel now. I don't want to lose it."

He said that going from the blue sky to the utter blackness of space was a moving experience: "In an instant you go, `Whoa, that's death.' That's what I saw."

The actor said he was struck by the vulnerability of Earth and the relative sliver of its atmosphere.

"Everybody in the world needs to do this. Everybody in the world needs to see," he said.

"To see the blue color whip by, and now you're staring into blackness, that's the thing.

The covering of blue, this sheath, this blanket, this comforter of blue that we have around, we say, 'Oh, that's blue sky.' And then suddenly you shoot through it all, and you're looking into blackness, into black ugliness."

Shatner said the return to Earth was more jolting than his training led him to expect and made him wonder whether he was going to make it back alive.

"Everything is much more powerful," he said. "Bang, this thing hits. That wasn't anything like the simulator. ... Am I going to be able to survive the G-forces?"

Hmmm. I wonder what it was, he hit?

The article concludes with:

"Today's launch is a testimony to the power of the imagination, and we should not lose sight of that power," University of Rochester astrophysicist Adam Frank said in an email.

Well, I have to tell you, I'm a little bit confused here. NASA has already been to the moon - right - 238,900 miles away. They've sent spacecraft to Mars - the "planet" that goes by the name of the Roman god of war and is often referred to as the "Red Planet" which they say is 33.9 million miles away. What's the big deal with 66.5 miles?

And further, Shatner says that when he left the blue sky of earth - everything was complete - utter blackness. What happened to the stars? What happened to the sun? No moon? No planets? No milky way? What happened to all that?

I'll tell you what happened to all that. If they truly went where they said they went and they went into outer darkness - where possibly there might be weeping and gnashing of teeth - I don't know (the Bible does dark about outer darkness) - but a good explanation for what Shatner said he experienced is that God said he put the sun, the moon and the stars in the firmament of the earth - and maybe - just maybe - they were able to travel just beyond that edge. I don't know. I can't say for sure. But if what he said was true - 66.5 miles is just beyond where God put the sun, the moon and the stars.

For those of you who may have just had your world rocked a little, take some time and research people who are saying that the moon is possibly only about 60 miles away. It's all mathematics and for the ones who claim the moon is 238,900 miles away - or the sun is 92.658 million miles away - by changing just one part of the mathmetical formula - you can make your numbers say whatever you want to. People can use math formulas to "prove" the moon is 60 miles away - and they can use their math formulas to "prove" the moon is 238,900 miles away. Of course, we know that was all settled when Neil Armstrong set his tripometer to zero before blast-off back in 1969.

All of them are lying. The only one that might be close to the truth - I think anyway - is what we heard from William Shatner this week - but there is a specific reason why this has all happened. Those who are doing everything they can to promote space travel - as in hundreds of thousands, millions and even billions of miles from earth - have an agenda. And that agenda is to destroy the credibility of the Bible. The Bible does not teach a far away moon and a far away sun. The Bible does not teach about planets. In fact, the word planets was not used in the first English Bibles. And, when the word is used - found in II Kings 23:5 in the KJV - it's from the Hebrew word meaning constellation. Which is stars. Which is consistent with the Genesis account of Creation where God created the sun, the moon and the stars - to be lights - and to tell the time and the seasons.

Turn with me this morning - this is not the message - but I want us to see this - turn to Psalm chapter 2 - let's read the whole chapter. Verse 1.

[1] Why do the heathen rage, and the people imagine a vain thing?

[2] The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against Yahweh, and against his anointed, saying,

[3] Let us break their bands asunder, and cast away their cords from us.

[4] He that sitteth in the heavens shall laugh: the Lord shall have them in derision.

[4] He that sitteth in the heavens shall laugh: the Lord shall have them in derision.

[5] Then shall he speak unto them in his wrath, and vex them in his sore displeasure.

[6] Yet have I set my king upon my holy hill of Zion.

[7] I will declare the decree: Yahweh hath said unto me, Thou art my Son; this day have I begotten thee.

[8] Ask of me, and I shall give thee the heathen for thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession.

[9] Thou shalt break them with a rod of iron; thou shalt dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel.

[10] Be wise now therefore, O ye kings: be instructed, ye judges of the earth.

[11] Serve Yahweh with fear, and rejoice with trembling.

[**12**] Kiss the Son, lest he be angry, and ye perish from the way, when his wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all they that put their trust in him.

The Bible says that God sits in the heavens. Listen:

Behold, the heaven and the heaven of heavens is Yahweh's thy God, the earth also, with all that therein is. Deuteronomy 10:14

[10] He bowed the heavens also, and came down; and darkness was under his feet.

[25] Then hear thou from the heavens, and forgive the sin of thy people Israel, and bring them again unto the land which thou gavest to them and to their fathers.

[33] Then hear thou from the heavens, even from thy dwelling place, and do according to all that the stranger calleth to thee for; that all people of the earth may know thy name, and fear thee, as doth thy people Israel, and may know that this house which I have built is called by thy name.

[35] Then hear thou from the heavens their prayer and their supplication, and maintain their cause.

[39] Then hear thou from the heavens, even from thy dwelling place, their prayer and their supplications, and maintain their cause, and forgive thy people which have sinned against thee.

God dwells in the heavens. I don't know what all that means. But I absolutely know this. There is a God - and how many times have we said this - or prayed this - Our Father in Heaven - Heavenly Father - Dear Heavenly Father - we pray this because this is what the Bible teaches. Whereever or whatever heaven is - it is in the heavens and that's where our Father sits - Mark 16

So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God.

Acts.7

[55] But he, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up stedfastly into heaven,

looked up stedfastly into heaven

and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God,

[56] And said, Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of man standing on the right hand of God.

Eph.1

[20] Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places,

Heb.8

[1] Now of the things which we have spoken this is the sum: We have such an high priest, who is set on the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens;

1Pet.3

[22] Who is gone into heaven, and is on the right hand of God; angels and authorities and powers being made subject unto him.

God is in the heavens. Christ is in the heavens. All those who have gone before us in Christ - are in the heavens. And brethren, no one is getting there in a space ship. No man is getting there without Christ.

I am the Way, I am the Truth, and no man cometh to the Father, but by Me.

All their "space travel." All their planets - and stars that are billions of light years away all that garbage is designed to do one thing - to make people doubt the credibility of the Bible - and if you can make people doubt the credibility of the Bible - then you can make people doubt the existence of God.

And if you can make people doubt the existence of God - then you can remove God's Laws from civilization and replace them with your own. That's the end game. And that's exactly what they have done. And their "indoctrination" of the masses has worked great - and millions and millions of professing "Christians" have sent their children to those indoctrination centers for the purpose of instilling doubt in the minds of those children as to whether God even exists. And for all intents and purposes they have won. Because - most of the people today do not believe there is a God - and for the ones who claim they believe there is still a God - they live their lives as if God does not exist.

And once again - where are the followers of Christ who are standing up to these liars and saying "No - what you teach is not what the Bible teaches - and let God be true and every man a liar." Until we get that backbone built back up among us - we will continue to see our generation fall farther and farther from where we are supposed to be. Because the truth is not being told.

Stand up. Stand for the Word of God. Against everything that opposes Christ. Everything that will not bow the knee to the King and His Kingdom. Stand against it and stand for the Kingdom of Christ.

NASA - funded by the same thing that has given us the truth about Covid-19. The same people who constantly perpetuate the lie that their "vaccine" is harmless and actually saves lives. Something else happened this week.

There is a man who called himself a "flat-earther." I do not call myself a "flat-earther." The world is clearly not flat. But the Bible teaches that it is not a round spinning globe. So, I guess compared to a round spinning globe - if you said the "earth was flat" - I wouldn't argue much. But Rob Skiba - a leading "flat earther" died this past week after contracting pneumonia at one of his conferences.

The false media reported that he died from Covid-19. That was a total lie. Rob's big mistake was that he went to the hospital with his respiratory issue. The brilliant doctors put him on Remdesivir. He continued to spiral downward. They put him on a respirator

and then - guess what - he died. Their treatment killed him. Then, the fake news media reported that he died from Covid because he argued against the "vaccine."

This "reporter" (she's not a reporter, she doesn't deserve that title) who said that Rob died from Covid provided her email address. So, I sent her a brief email and called her a liar - that's what she is. She said she cited Rob's friends saying that he died from Covid. That is not true. In fact, one of Rob's friends posted a lengthy narrative on what happened and stated - from the horse's mouth - that Rob had been put on Remdesivir where he began to deteroriate - of course - then they put him on the ventilator - which is the next step in the process.

I did not receive a response from the "reporter" - but I did not let her lie just pass without resistance.

Lies are everywhere. And we need to be the voice for truth - the voice for the Good Shepherd Who does not lie. Alright, let's move on to today's message.

As many of you know, my wife, Teresa, has understood Fulfilled Bible Prophecy and the present day reality of the Kingdom for over 32 years now. Before she made her public pronouncement of her embracing the King and His Kingdom - and leaving the world and it's ways - she was taught the Scriptures - and of course - she was presented with the teachings on Bible prophecy and she embraced them - and has been a warrior for the Kingdom of Christ ever since. I thought - you know - because I'm such a great communicator - not - that she understood everything that I understand about Fulfilled Bible Prophecy because we talk about it and Scripture all the time. There's rarely a day go by that we are not discussing the Bible with each other.

But at the end of last week's message - she said - "Wow, I never really understood that until today." Well, talk about getting the air dumped out of you - I was literally blown away that I had failed in making sure she understood something that I believe is so vitally important that we all understand. For a few minutes this morning - I think we better go back over this - because it is so vitally important.

I have been trying to say - for many many years - that people in the U.S. - and around the world for that matter - have not had the Gospel preached to them. The Gospel is the only means for reaching the Son. It's the only way to get to the Father. That's the plan. It's by the preaching of the Gospel - and I'm telling you that very few people have ever heard the Gospel. Let alone, embraced it. People have been taught something from something called "church" - say it with me -"a word that should not even be in our English Bibles" - but that is where most people have learned what they believe is the truth about God, about Jesus, and for the little more advanced - about Yeshua - and if that's where people have heard what they have been taught is the Gospel - I'm sorry - that is something not found in the Bible - but rather it is folklore - it is tales - it's fairy tales - that have been handed down through the centuries and it resembles absolutely nothing of the Gospel taught by Christ and later taught and lived by the Apostles as examples for all generations to come.

I am speaking directly to the truth that if a man or woman or boy or girl - does not understand that the "the last days" was referring to the first century - that man woman boy or girl has never heard the Gospel.

Now some will again want to argue that it doesn't matter - it doesn't matter whether someone has heard the Gospel - the true Gospel or not - if Jesus wants them "saved" - then no matter what that person believes - they are or will be "saved."

I'm sorry, but I do not find any Biblical support for this line of thinking. I want you to turn with me to Acts 17. Not specifically for the verses that you hear me quote pretty much on a weekly basis - but for the things that are said at the end of the chapter. Then, we're going to get back to why I'm saying if a man woman boy or girl does not understand the phrase "the last days" they've never heard the Gospel. But before we do that - I have to set a Biblical foundation - again - for why I say what I say. Acts 17 - I believe - will do just that. Verse 1, please, mainly because I can't mention Acts 17 without reading those verses that everyone knows I love so much:

[1] Now when they had passed through Amphipolis and Apollonia, they came to Thessalonica, where was a synagogue of the Jews:

[2] And Paul, as his manner was, went in unto them, and three sabbath days reasoned with them out of the scriptures,

This is interesting. Paul went in teaching. He didn't go in that place to be taught from them. He went in to teach them.

[**3**] Opening and alleging, that Christ must needs have suffered, and risen again from the dead; and that this Jesus, whom I preach unto you, is Christ.

Not that Jesus. Or that Jesus in another place. THIS Jesus. There are many

"Jesuses".

[4] And some of them believed, and consorted with Paul and Silas; and of the devout Greeks a great multitude, and of the chief women not a few.

[5] But the Jews which believed not, moved with envy, took unto them certain lewd fellows of the baser sort, and gathered a company, and set all the city on an uproar, and assaulted the house of Jason, and sought to bring them out to the people.

[6] And when they found them not, they drew Jason and certain brethren unto the rulers of the city, crying, These that have turned the world upside down are come hither also;

[7] Whom Jason hath received: and these all do contrary to the decrees of Caesar, saying that there is another king, one Jesus.

[8] And they troubled the people and the rulers of the city, when they heard these things.

[9] And when they had taken security of Jason, and of the other, they let them go.

[**10**] And the brethren immediately sent away Paul and Silas by night unto Berea: who coming thither went into the synagogue of the Jews.

[11] These were more noble than those in Thessalonica,

This is a little bit of a different crowd here that Paul went to next.

in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.

Alright. Stop right here for just a minute. The Bible - right here in Acts 17 tells us principally speaking - that it does matter that people receive the word. And you know what else is really interesting about this - it says with all readiness of mind.

That word comes from the Greek word which means predisposition. In other words, they were predisposed to receive the Word. They were predisposed to accept the Word. They were willing to yield their own personal beliefs, their own personal conclusions - they were predisposed to yield to the Word of God. And they searched the Scriptures daily, to see if the things they were being taught were so. That's written as an example for us.

Predisposition. Let's look at that for a minute. John the Baptist preached, Repent for the Kingdom of God is at hand. Christ preached, Repent for Kingdom of Heaven is at

hand. Today - if the message was preached in the language we understand today - it would be said,

"Repent, for the Government of Christ is at hand." Turn away from the way you've been living. Turn away from the government that you have chosen to be governed by - or in the first century - be preparing yourself to be delivered from the horrible choice of government that your fathers chose - and for the one you have continued with because that government is getting ready to be replaced by the Government of Heaven.

The King - King Jesus - King Yeshua - is getting ready to replace the Caesars - He's getting ready to replace "the kings like all the other nations."

Why is the word kingdom used? Why not just settle for something much more benign, something far less threatening - why not kurias - repent - because the synagogue is getting ready to be changed to the "church."

Kingdoms - governments - they are things that command people to live certain ways. And, their commands are typically followed up with force. Do this - or else.

The very words - "Repent for the Kingdom - repent for the Government of Christ is at hand" are some really serious words. Yet today, because we have been so bombarded and pounded with the false doctrine that the Kingdom is future - the words are actually quite benign and have basically been rendered meaningless - no power today. But that's what the Gospel is. It is the good news - that the little g governments of the world have been brought down by Christ - and we are no longer bound to them because of bad choices. Either by our fathers - or by ourselves. We can choose the Kingdom of Christ.

Subsequently, Christ taught, "But" what does that mean? It's a powerful word. It has a lot of meaning. "But you don't have to do this. But, you do have to do this. But, there are consequences, but you have a choice, the word is not just a space filler.

"But seek ye first the Kingdom of God - the Government of God - and all these things shall be added unto you."

That is the predisposition towards the study of the Word that must be properly applied in order to understand the Scriptures - as the example is shown from Acts 17. If we have approached the Scriptures from a future Kingdom predisposition - then I'm telling you - we must reexamine every single thing we ever thought we knew or hoped to be true from the Word of God. The message of a future king and a future kingdom is not the Gospel. Will or can people be "saved" in spite of that? I do not believe there is Biblical support for that in the New World. As you well know, I absolutely believe that is the case in the Old World. But I don't believe there is sufficient Biblical support in the New World. Verse 12 of Acts 17.

[12] Therefore many of them believed;

Therefore why? Because of the way they were predispose to believe the Word.

also of honourable women which were Greeks, and of men, not a few.

They believed what? And why does it even matter? What difference does it make what they believe? The apostles were:

Opening and alleging, that Christ must needs have suffered, and risen again from the dead; and that this Jesus, whom I preach unto you, is Christ.

They were preaching Christ. They were preaching the anointed King of Israel had come. They were preaching that the prophecies had been fulfilled - and by the way - His name was Jesus. Christ is not His last name. That is His title. This is what the apostles were preaching and this is why they would not obey the decrees of Caesar and why they preached - there is another King - Christ - Christ is King - and His name happens to be Jesus. This Jesus that was here and suffered and rose from the dead - He is Christ - He is King. That's what they believed. And these things are written the way they are to show us that belief absolutely matters. And proper belief absolutely matters the most.

[**13**] But when the Jews of Thessalonica had knowledge that the word of God was preached of Paul at Berea, they came thither also, and stirred up the people.

Call them Jews today - that's fine - there are many out there still functioning under that deception - but include anyone today that is not predisposed to the present day reality of the King and Kingdom. Anyone who is advocating for a future king and a future kingdom is in this same category today. It doesn't matter how nice they are. It doesn't matter how well dressed they are or how many people "go to their church on Sundays" - if they are not predisposed - teaching that Jesus is King - repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven came - then they are in this same category that the Bible puts the jews in - in

Acts 17:13. This is really serious business. This is not agree to disagree territory.

Christ is not a coming King. He is a King that already came. He did everything that He was supposed to do - including - quite possibly the most important - bringing down the Old Covenant age of man's rule over each other - turning that whole thing back to His Father - then His Father taking back all rule and all Authority power and might. And every soul is now to be subject to the King of kings and Lord of lords. Every soul is to be subject. And that took place in the first century. And that's what was preached in Acts 17 and that's how people must be predisposed in receiving the Word of God with all readiness - and if we aren't then we've got big problems.

And I'm saying that the reason we are in the shape we are in today - is because men have been predisposed in their approach to the Scriptures with every predisposition out there - other than the one the Bible teaches. It does make a difference what you believe. And if the Son of man - that's Jesus Christ - Jesus Christ of the first century when He is lifted up - Whosoever believeth in Him.

There's lots of Jesus's that have been lifted up. Every religion in the world has been lifting up their own version of a "Jesus." But there's only One Jesus that when lifted up - brings eternal life to those who believe on Him. And I'm telling you that if you have learned of a Jesus that is a coming king - that's been the wrong one. It is of absolute necessity that we understand the phrase the "last days" because the correct Jesus is the One Who spoke in the last days. If we believe we are in the last days, or the last days have not occurred - then Jesus - the One Who must be lifted up - has not come.

That's what I'm trying to get people to understand.

[14] And then immediately the brethren sent away Paul to go as it were to the sea: but Silas and Timotheus abode there still.

[**15**] And they that conducted Paul brought him unto Athens: and receiving a commandment unto Silas and Timotheus for to come to him with all speed, they departed.

[16] Now while Paul waited for them at Athens, his spirit was stirred in him, when he saw the city wholly given to idolatry.

[17] Therefore disputed he in the synagogue with the Jews, and with the devout persons, and in the market daily with them that met with him.

[18] Then certain philosophers of the Epicureans, and of the Stoicks, encountered him. And some said, What will this babbler say? other some, He seemeth to be a

setter forth of strange gods: because he preached unto them Jesus, and the resurrection.

Brethren, these are the college graduates of our day. These are the scientists, these are the politicians, the university professors, these are the preachers with letters behind their names, the lawyers - and we need to be ready to defend the Jesus - Jesus the Christ - just like the apostles did in the first century. And we better have the truth of God's Word firmly entrenched in our hearts and minds. It is belief - it is faith - it is the system of belief based on the Lord - the One Who is Supreme in Authority - that has the power to come against the Epicureans and Stoicks of our day. What we believe absolutely matters.

[**19**] And they took him, and brought him unto Areopagus, saying, May we know what this new doctrine, whereof thou speakest, is?

What new doctrine are they talking about? It's the doctrine of King Jesus. It's the doctrine that God has made Jesus - both Lord and Christ. It's the doctrine that the Kingdom - the Government of God was at hand. The days of the earthly kings was coming to an end. That's the new doctrine.

[20] For thou bringest certain strange things to our ears: we would know therefore what these things mean.

Again, this is why I'm telling you that the same Gospel Paul was preaching back then - is not the Gospel most people have heard today. If you preach today that this Jesus, Whom you have killed - hath God made both Lord and Christ. This Jesus is the Only Potentate - the King of kings and Lord of lords - and that means right now. The book of Revelation - which means the Revealing of Jesus the Christ as King of kings and Lords of lords - that that happened in the first century - 2,000 years ago - people look at you and say today -

For thou bringest certain strange things to our ears:

What a strange concept that you teach. That men are not supposed to obey the "government" that happens to be in place in whatever place they happened to be born in. "You actually mean that people can choose to become followers of Christ and He has a Kingdom and a Nation and men can come into that Kingdom no matter where they were born? That is really strange. We've been taught all our lives that God set up men's

governments - He set up kings and gave them divine rights over other men - and everyone is supposed to be obey the "laws of the land." If the government says to stand in line and take lethal injections - we should be the first in line - and we should open our buildings and allow the governments to set up lethal injection clinics.

If the "government" says it's okay to kill little babies - then so be it. If the "government" says it's okay for sodomites to "marry" each other - then so be it. If the "government" says they can "tax" a man's labor - then so be it. If the "government" says they can set up ponzi schemes and call them Social Security instead of Corban like Jesus called it in Mark 7 - then so be it.

And if someone comes along and says, "No, all of that is backwards. All of that is not the Will of God. That's not the way we are supposed to live - and wow - that is a strange teaching. And that's exactly where we are today. And it is the result of generations not knowing what the Bible teaches about Christ.

[21] (For all the Athenians and strangers which were there spent their time in nothing else, but either to tell, or to hear some new thing.)
[22] Then Paul stood in the midst of Mars' hill, and said, Ye men of Athens, I perceive that in all things ye are too superstitious.
[23] For as I passed by, and beheld your devotions, I found an altar with this inscription, TO THE UNKNOWN GOD. Whom therefore ye ignorantly worship, him declare I unto you.

I've been telling you for as long as you have been listening to this babbler babble - "The ignorant worship of God" does not work. Our generation is exactly like the generation of Acts 17. If we can even find people who are worshipping the One True God - they are worshipping ignorantly - and the ignorant worship of God must be replaced with the true Gospel.

[24] God that made the world and all things therein, seeing that He is Lord of heaven and earth, dwelleth not in temples made with hands;

He is the One Who is Supreme in Authority. We live in a society where OUR LAWS and OUR CONSTITUTIONS shall be the supreme law of the land.

dwelleth not in temples made with hands;

We sure have a lot of those things today, don't we?

[25] Neither is worshipped with men's hands, as though he needed any thing, seeing he giveth to all life, and breath, and all things;[26] And hath made of one blood all nations of men for to dwell on all the face of the earth, and hath determined the times before appointed, and the bounds of their habitation;

And no, absolutely not, this is not Paul telling people that God made it okay to mix the races. That is not what is being said here. It does mean that all nations are to submit to the Kingdom of Christ - absolutely - Let every soul be subject - but within the bounds of their habitation. That's what it says.

[**27**] That they should seek the Lord, if haply they might feel after Him, and find Him, though he be not far from every one of us:

That kind of shoots a small dart at those who think that men cannot choose Christ doesn't it? Read it again.

That they should seek the Lord, if haply they might feel after him, and find him, though he be not far from every one of us:

To me, that's more than just a dart. That's a pretty big bomb lobbed at those who think that it doesn't matter what man believes. If that man is going to be in Christ, then God is going to make it happen no matter what. No matter what a man believes. Belief matters, I'm telling. And proper belief matters the most. The ignorant worship of God is not sufficient.

[28] For in him we live, and move, and have our being; as certain also of your own poets have said, For we are also his offspring.

We really need to take notes here. This is what true followers of Christ are known by. Are we living, are we moving, do we have our being in Christ?

Come on now, Charlie, you can't use this to talk about licenses. This moving, this living, this having our being only in Christ - then cannot be taken practically. It's not literal. It's just figurative. God really does not expect us to have our total being in Christ. You just can't live that way - the government won't allow it. You really can't believe that God

expects us to be fully immersed into Christ in a practical, literal way.

I have not asked for permission to do this - but since I am not going to name names - I can't imagine that SHE - that SHE - will have a problem with me reading this to you. This lady has not been a follower of Christ for very long. But I want you to listen to what has happened in her life in just about a year. I haven't listened to the rest of your message yet, but will do so after this email.

I keep saying to people, what if we all just stopped paying taxes? What on earth could they actually do to us? There's no way they could lock up millions of people! I'm not sure how to handle all of this. I keep getting different opinions from different people. My friend, who truly lives in the Kingdom of Heaven, says she has gone through the whole process of becoming a

(and I don't really understand what she's talking about here)

'state citizen", birth certificate, license, all of that stuff, and she believes it's all fruitless to even do that. That we should just believe at this point in the game and have faith that God will guide us and take care of the rest.

Then I have others in the truth community talking about putting your legal name in a trust and sending back your BC, etc., ect., and saying I need to go through the whole process...it seems so overwhelming and unnecessary to me. Especially given to current state of our chaotic world. I don't even know if it will matter, seeing as we may be at war by the end of this year. Who knows?

When I responded to her I told her - as I would tell anyone - to be very careful about

listening to voices that are not Christ's. The patriot "remedies" usually end up with people going to prison. Personally, I think just walking away, consider changing your name, becoming a new person in Christ is much more simple and I believe it is the Biblical thing to do. And of course, joining yourself with other believers in Ecclesia. Back to the email.

I just want to believe and have faith and I am currently simply refusing to give another dime of my hard-earned labor to those tyrants. I have my own private business, that I put my own labor into, and I intend to keep every penny of it. Not in a selfish way, but because I don't believe in giving tyrants, pedophiles, and devil worshippers my money, and more importantly my precious time! One thing is for sure...the time is way overdue for us to stand (no more under stand!) and not comply and take decisive action and do whatever is necessary!

But - if we will not come together - we STILL have to live as Citizens of the Commonwealth of Israel among a people that hates Christ - hates His ways and hates His people. Doesn't have to be that way. We can move closer to each other like we are supposed to. Verse 29, Acts 17.

[29] Forasmuch then as we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the Godhead is like unto gold, or silver, or stone, graven by art and man's device.[30] And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:

Ok. Once again. When were the times of ignorance? The Old Covenant World. Look at what that said. God winked at. Wow. What does that mean? Some of you may not like this - and I'm chuckling when I say that - because I love it. It's 5237 in Strong's - comes from the Greek hooperido and it means to overlook - not to punish. I really like this because I have had people write to me and say, "If the people in the Old World did not have choices - then why would God punish them?" Great point. Great question. Here's your answer. In the Old World, the Bible says - there were times of ignorance that God winked at. Webster's 1828 says the act of closing the eyelids. You take what you can from this - but I know that for me - this has been a major point of doctrine - of my faith - my system of belief - because I absolutely believe that predestination was for the Old World and Whosoever Will is for the New World. And with this comes great responsibility - because now -

but now commandeth all men every where to repent:

The times were changing. I just don't think we realize how important the days were in the first century. I just don't think we realize how important it is that we know that Jesus - God's Son was sent to this earth - He literally walked this earth. There is no more that God could have given than to have given His Own Son. And to get it wrong - even after He sent His Own Son - it's no longer an excuse. Now - in the first century and since then - He will not wink at ignorance any longer - those days are over -

but now commandeth all men every where to repent:

Why?

[**31**] Because he hath appointed a day, in the which he will judge the world in righteousness by that Man whom He hath ordained; whereof He hath given assurance unto all men, in that He hath raised him from the dead.

Again. If people think that this judgement day is in the future - they are right back into the days of ignorance - but the only problem is - God no longer winks at the times of ignorance. We have a far greater responsibility on this side of the cross - on this side of the resurrection - on this side of the ascension - on this side of the return of Christ - and on this side of the Old Covenant World - in the New Covenant World. Ignorance is no longer an excuse - and ignorance is no longer accepted.

For people to say that God "saves" people whether they are ignorant or not - just does not have Biblical support. It is the skillful, rightful preaching of the Word of God - just like we are seeing right here in Acts 17 - that convicts men and women boys and girls of their need for Christ - so that when He is lifted up - Whosoever believeth in Him shall not perish, but have everlasting life.

To me, this is the greatest hope mankind has today. We can preach Christ and His Kingship and His Government. Men and women boys and girls can have a choice to embrace this King, to embrace His Government - to come out from the kingdoms of the world - and follow the King - follow the King's Father's Laws, Statutes, and Judgements and the land can be healed. The people can be healed. The people can rejoice and live in peace and prosperity because that's what happens when people live according to the Will of God on earth as it is in heaven. I can't imagine why people cannot see the hope in the Gospel of the Kingdom. The world - our world - could be turned upside down - and in a relatively short period of time - if we first believed - then lived according to the teachings of Acts 17.

[**32**] And when they heard of the resurrection of the dead, some mocked: and others said, We will hear thee again of this matter.

It's the same thing today. Some here the Gospel and they mock. Others hear and want to hear more.

[**33**] So Paul departed from among them.

[34] Howbeit certain men clave unto him, and believed: among the which was

Dionysius the Areopagite, and a woman named Damaris, and others with them.

At the end of the message last weekend, Teresa said, "I get it. I see what you are saying. If a man believes that the last days are anything other than the first century - then Jesus was not the Messiah."

Yes. That is what I have been saying for more than 35 years. If we don't understand the phrase "the last days" - and Hebrews 1 says it as clearly as anything can be said in the Bible - then Jesus is not the Messiah. To not understand prophecy is to be in the same belief system as the jews. The jews' are looking for their messiah to come.

Today, all those who believe that Jesus is coming again - are actually veiled jews. It's got a little bit of a twist - but it's judaism. The Baptists, the Catholics, the Assemblies of God, the Methodists, their "Jesus" that is "coming again" is not the Jesus, the Yeshua the Christ. The Jesus Christ of the first century came to be King. He did every single thing He was supposed to do. He fulfilled every single prophecy. He abolished death. He put down all rule and authority. He did every single thing the Promised Messiah was supposed to do.

The jews say that Jesus was not the Messiah because Jesus did not fulfill all the prophets. They reject Him completely. The rest of the world's religions deny Jesus also because they say He has unfinished work to do and He must come back here to complete it. It's the same thing. It's a slightly different twist, but ultimately it's the same thing.

The jews are waiting for their promised king to come - and the Baptists and all the rest of them are waiting for their promised king to come. They all have their faith in a "jesus" or a messiah that is not the One the Apostles taught.

Whatever this modern jesus is - it's not the Jesus Christ of the Bible. It is the ignorant worship of God and today - God will not wink at - He will not turn a blind eye to - He will not put off punishment of - it doesn't work that way in the New World.

All that has been given to understand the Gospel has been given. If we have a predisposition towards the Scriptures that the King came, the King did all He was supposed to do - and now He sits in the heavens ruling and reigning over the lives of all who will allow His reign - then we will be led into truth. Matthew 6:33.

But ----in conclusion - turn to I John chapter 1. I have plans to dig much deeper into the whole book of I John - but I don't know when. But in conclusion today, I John chapter 1, verse 1.

That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, of the Word of life;

This is the Jesus of the first century.

[2] (For the life was manifested, and we have seen it, and bear witness, and shew unto you that eternal life, which was with the Father, and was manifested unto us;)

[**3**] That which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have fellowship with us: and truly our fellowship is with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ.

And we had better know whether His Son is the King of kings and Lord of lords right now - or is He is merely a coming king. We can't have it both ways. We better get this right. And sadly, you and I both know it - the world does not have this right. Ninety nine point 999 percent of the world today - does not have this right.

[4] And these things write we unto you, that your joy may be full.

[5] This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.

[6] If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth:

I'm telling you that the ignorant worship of God doesn't cut it. God doesn't excuse it and neither can we. He is not a coming king. He is not coming back here to do anything. The Promised Messiah came in the first century just like the Bible says. Just like the prophets prophesied. He did every single thing He was supposed to do. There is nothing left for Him to do. He is King now - and it's the responsibility of every living, breathing creature to conform to His Kingdom - right now.

[7] But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

What cleanses us? Prior to the cross - it was the H2O water baptism of the Old Covenant World that "washed away sins." In the New Covenant World - it is the katharidzo - that cleanses, that purifies, that purges and makes pure.

The Jesus Christ of the Bible - the One Who saves - He spoke in the last days. If we do not believe that the last days have already occurred - then we are not believing in the Jesus Christ of the Bible.
