## Message# 164 - 11-14-2021 - I John 4 - When He comes, will He Do More?

Good morning everyone. Thank you for taking the time to listen to the message this morning. Again, I want to apologize to everyone about the mix up on the radio station, hopefully that's behind us and I want you to know it was not Sam's fault. The timing was awful. Here Sam had an audio processor go out on him and we shared the need with you - and you came through beautifully - the processor was paid for - installed and was working great - then I messed up. I felt so bad for Sam and Trish with all they had done to get that going again.

When I prepare the message for the radio - I have the file named for archiving on my website. (I have it already set for my website). But when I upload it to the radio station's servers - after the file is uploaded - I have to rename the file so the automatic scheduler sees the correct name and plays that particular audio file. Well, I'm not sure what happened because I've gotten pretty good about changing the name - but I just didn't rename the new message - so the old one played. Hopefully, that won't happen again. And again, I'm sorry that happened, and it was not Sam's fault - or failed equipment - or anything like that - it was operator error and I was the operator.

I have been receiving some really great emails from people concerning times and seasons according to the Bible. Keep them coming. Also, I am going to be contacting you this week to see if any of you would like to collaborate with each other on this project. I believe it is so important that we have this information easily available to us.

When people send me articles or photos for the website, I typically will do my own research to make sure there are second witnesses to the particular story or item to be posted. I think it's very important that we do so - because - the more things are "shared" - the more things are "linked" "tweeted" "liked" or what have you - the more likely it is that it will be seen or heard by a lot more people. And, we want truth to be shared. Truth to be "liked" or "linked" or whatever. So, I am very careful about what I say and link or post on our website.

Two weeks ago - I was in a conversation with some one and they were talking about the "supply chain" crisis. It's amazing how - and I've said this before about other things - particularly speaking about new words or phrases that are put out there and they catch on like wildfire. "Supply chain" "mandates" "pandemic" - it's almost as if there's a new

language that has taken hold over the past 2 years now. But during this conversation, the man said to me, "Biden is such an idiot, he needs to declare a national emergency and do something about this supply chain crisis."

I hope people are seeing what I have said for many years - that all these u.s. "presidents" do is pave the way for the next one. Well, yes, there is way for people to wake up. And that is when the true Gospel of the Kingdom is preached. [6] And when they found them not, they drew Jason and certain brethren unto the rulers of the city, crying, These that have turned the world upside down are come hither also;

[7] Whom Jason hath received: and these all do contrary to the decrees of Caesar, saying that there is another king, one Jesus.

Do you want to see how to turn things right side up? It's simple. Go to the book. Find the example written in it - and do the same thing. That's why the book was written. It's an example book. It's a text book. It's an owner's manual.

Do contrary to the decrees of men, say there is another King, One Jesus, and live accordingly. What's the big deal? Why is this so hard to understand?

Well, it's because the "church" and the "churchmen" have taken texts such as this one in Acts 17 - and in the margin notes of their "study Bible" they have placed the words "false accusations." They had no authority to do such a thing. They had no textual authority to do such a thing - they did it because the "church" and the "churchmen" are the religious arm of "caesar" - they are the religious arm of men's governments - and they could not have someone believing that the true Gospel is that men are to turn from the caesars, turn from men's little g governments and follow EXCLUSIVELY - King Jesus. That's why "false accusations" are in the margin notes of the Thompson Chain Reference Bible.

By asserting a lie into the margin notes of his "reference Bible" - he changed the entire meaning of Scripture and countless numbers of people believed that lie and were led away from the true Gospel. Then, they told someone that Acts 17 was false accusations - and they believed. And apart from the true Gospel - there is no salvation.

Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

None other name - that means Authority. That means King. It means Ruler. It means Lawgiver.

There is no other Authority under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

The Gospel is the Kingdom and the Kingship of Christ. The Kingdom and the Kingship of Christ was instituted in the first century - anyone who does not believe that Jesus the Christ - that Yeshua the Christ - the King - instituted His Kingdom in the first century - is not "saved."

That's what is meant from I John where we have been reading from in our latest messages. It's time to stop sugar-coating. It's time to stop making people think they are safe - when they are not. Anyone who is not preaching the present day reality of the King and His Kingdom is lost. I did not write the book. I'm only the messenger of the book.

Did you see this, this past week? Headline.

Okay. The headline all by itself is alarming. It stinks on several levels. So these two kids were trick-or-treating and instead of getting candy - they got a lethal injection. The candy would have certainly been the lessor of two "tricks" - but instead of candy - these two kids were given a lethal injection. If that isn't bad enough, let's read the article.

A new report details how two Texas children under the age of 10 were administered full 30-microgram doses of the experimental COVID-19 injection "instead of candy" while trick-or-treating on October 31, with one immediately experiencing adverse reactions.

Two children, six and 7 years old, were illegally administered full, adult-sized doses of the COVID-19 injection "instead of candy" while trick-or-treating on Halloween, with one immediately experiencing adverse reactions, according to a report from the The Epoch Times.

The incident occurred during a Halloween gathering **at a local church** in Garland, Texas, where the city set up a vaccination center. Nurses at the event were unauthorized to inject children younger than 12 years old.

I just now noticed this, they were obviously injecting more than just these two. Apparently they were injecting children 12 and up. The article goes on but that's all we need to read. This took place at a "church." Brethren, there is absolutely no excuse for this. And you know this is not an isolated event. "Churches" all across the land are doing this. They are doing this because they are not of God. They are not of Christ. This is not a matter of making an honest mistake or not understanding the Bible - they do this because they are not in Christ.

They are the religious arm of the state. They are the ally, the friend, the equal - with those who oppose Christ. We need to not only separate ourselves from anything called "church" but we need to be telling people if they are participating in these places - they are lost. They are going to die in their sins without Christ.

And, for those of who still think it's okay to listen to these "preachers" in a quest for truth - I'm telling you - you are going to the "devil" - to find Christ. And that's not going to happen. It doesn't matter whether it's the largest "church" in the largest city in America - or the smallest "church" in rural America - the people that attend - the "preachers" that preach - are the ministers of Satan who have disguised themselves as the angels of light. The Gospel is not preached there.

Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

Turn with me please back to I John and let's start again with chapter 4. We'll read verse 1.

Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.

Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God:

And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.

Let's go over this again.

Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God:

This is a very specific "Jesus" that is talked about here. This is Jesus Christ. This is Jesus the Christ. Christ means the Anointed One. This is the King. A man must confess that the King came in the flesh. Now, if you confess that the King came in the flesh - that means it is your belief. That is your system of belief. That is what faith is. Your walk, your life will be directed by your faith - your system of belief.

Turn to James chapter 2, please. Let's begin in verse 1.

[1] My brethren, have not the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lord of glory, with respect of persons.

That's all present tense speaking from the first century.

[2] For if there come unto your assembly a man with a gold ring, in goodly apparel, and there come in also a poor man in vile raiment;

That's really interesting. But I'll have to come back to it later for sake of time. Assembly there is not "Ecclesia." The "church" thinks that's what it is - but it's not that word. It's the word for synagogue. Anyway, verse 3,

[3] And ye have respect to him that weareth the gay clothing, and say unto him, (That's a good place for "church" today).

Sit thou here in a good place; and say to the poor, Stand thou there, or sit here under my footstool:

- [4] Are ye not then partial in yourselves, and are become judges of evil thoughts?
- [5] Hearken, my beloved brethren, Hath not God chosen the poor of this world rich in faith, and heirs of the kingdom which he hath promised to them that love him?
- [6] But ye have despised the poor. Do not rich men oppress you, and draw you before the judgment seats?

Wow. Not much has changed there, has it?

[7] Do not they blaspheme that worthy name by the which ye are called?

Interesting. Same folks doing the blaspheming back then - are the same ones doing it today. And, this includes the ones playing "synagogue" - playing "church." In addition to the persecutors and the cops and the ones participating with the little g governments of the world.

- [8] If ye fulfil the royal law according to the scripture, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself, ye do well:
- [9] But if ye have respect to persons, ye commit sin, and are convinced of the law as transgressors.

I think we all realize that today - just like it was back then - all of society has "respect to persons." It's still the same. And the principle not to do that is also still in effect.

- [10] For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all.
- [11] For he that said, Do not commit adultery, said also, Do not kill. Now if thou commit no adultery, yet if thou kill, thou art become a transgressor of the law.
- [12] So speak ye, and so do, as they that shall be judged by the law of liberty.
- [13] For he shall have judgment without mercy, that hath shewed no mercy; and mercy rejoiceth against judgment.
- [14] What doth it profit, my brethren, though a man say he hath faith, and have

not works? can faith save him?

- [15] If a brother or sister be naked, and destitute of daily food,
- [16] And one of you say unto them, Depart in peace, be ye warmed and filled; notwithstanding ye give them not those things which are needful to the body; what doth it profit?
- [17] Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone.

What we have just read there is not the "liberal gospel" of the modern "church" in that "feeding the poor" is the thing that stands out most about Christ. Yes. In our Ecclesias, we need to make sure that everyone's needs are met - but what is being said here simply another way to say A + B = C - 2 + 2 = 4. He's not saying that feeding the poor or clothing the poor is how you demonstrate faith - he's speaking as an example. And ultimately concluding - if you say you are of the faith - you say you have the system of belief once delivered to the saints - then your lifestyle will evidence that. There's a ton more evidence than feeding people or clothing people - he's simply saying if you are of Christ - your life will reflect it.

- [18] Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works.
- [19] Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble.
- [20] But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead?
- [21] Was not Abraham our father justified by works, when he had offered Isaac his son upon the altar?
- [22] Seest thou how faith wrought with his works, and by works was faith made perfect?
- [23] And the scripture was fulfilled which saith, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God.
- [24] Ye see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only.
- [25] Likewise also was not Rahab the harlot justified by works, when she had received the messengers, and had sent them out another way?
- [26] For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

All he is concluding here is that if you are confessing that Jesus Christ came in the flesh - your life will reflect that. Again now, this is not works for salvation. It's just a matter of fact - the way you live is because of what you believe. Your faith - your system of belief - dictates the way you live.

This is why it is such a problem when people constantly say, "Jesus is my King" but everything in their life says something else or someone else really is their king. Whoever's laws you obey - whoever you answer to - whoever you pay taxes to - that's who your king is.

Now stay with me. We are in a Godless, wicked, rebellious generation. All of us - in every part of this world today - and I realize that no matter how hard we try - there is a possibility that some of what God gives us - is going to end up in the hands of another "king." I get that. But as long as we are doing everything we can to separate ourselves to our King - Come out from among them and be separate - God is merciful to us and forgives our sins. If Christ is our King - and we are doing all we can to live according to His Kingship - then He is faithful and just to forgive our sins and cleanse us from unrighteousness. That's not an excuse to stay. That's not saying that we are allowed to stay in the world - not by any stretch of imagination - we are to seek freedom in Christ - come out from among them and separate - that's what our calling is - and we know that we have the spirit of God when that's how we are living our lives. That's what our focus is in our lives.

Back to I John chapter 4, please, verse 2.

Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God:

Alright. Now we have just seen that the confession without the action is dead. And, I'll add this - confession that Jesus is the Son of God - is also addressed in James chapter 2.

Many believe that "Jesus" is the Son of God. Ok. But so did the "devils." The "devils" believed that - and they even trembled at it. But it is the confession that Jesus - the Son of God - is the King and that He came in the flesh in the first century - and then - the confession shows that it is real because a life that is lived with Christ as King is the proof.

Again, listen, this is not salvation by works. The life will bear out the faith. If we believe something - we will live it. That's what James is saying. He's not saying that works is what saves. He says the confession that Jesus is King will be proven to be a true confession because the lifestyle will bear it out.

Hereby know ye the Spirit of God:

Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God:

The confession is genuine because the life that is being lived proves that we truly believe what we say we believe. That's what this means.

This is what I'm trying to say. The spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ is King - that He came in the flesh in the first century - listen - there is no possible way this confession can be for a king to come. This is the confession that the King came - He came in the flesh - and at that point - the only Jesus Christ there was - was the One that came in the flesh in the first century.

The "church" and the "churchmen" have never taught leaving citizenship with the world behind - leave the kings of the earth behind - and exclusively follow King Jesus. That's not what they teach. They teach a coming king. Someday - The King is Coming - The King is Coming - I just heard the trumpet sounding - and now His face I see - Oh The King is Coming - and when the King comes - He will set everything straight.

No. The King came. The King did everything He was supposed to do. It's been the responsibility of every living breathing creature to conform to His Kingship and His Kingdom - exclusively - since the first century when the King came in the flesh. And any one, any spirit that teaches that a king is coming in the flesh - in the future - is not of God. Plain and simple. Put it on the record. Write it on the table for all to see.

Now, I have known men that have confessed and lived that Jesus Christ the King came in the flesh - but they mistakenly believed (and I say that past tense) because at least through this minute - I have never encountered a man who is living with Christ as King right now - and I mean - no contracts with men's little g governments - no taxes - no licenses - no birth certificates - they are living as Citizens of the Commonwealth of Israel - I have never encountered a man to this day - who is living that way - when presented with the truth of Fulfilled Bible Prophecy - they did not - almost immediately embrace that understanding. I have never - to this day - not seen a man who was living with Christ as His sole King - not eventually embrace Fulfilled Bible Prophecy.

If a man has confessed that Jesus the King came in the flesh in the first century - and that man's life is bearing that confession out - if he still preaches some form of futurism - that man is not an antichrist. He just needs some Biblical tutoring. He needs some direction. But that man is not antichrist.

But the man that says "Oh yes, Jesus is King, the Son of God, came in the first century" but that man is still living as a citizen of the world - then without apology - I have to tell that man he is without Christ. His confession - his faith - without works - is dead.

That's not works salvation. The true confession will be proven by the lifestyle. We live what we believe. We can't say one thing and live the other - that's what James is saying.

Turn with me please to John chapter 7. I want to get more into this Jesus Christ. Let's begin in verse 1. This is what I was talking about in the email where I said I was going to show you something very powerful, something I had not notice before.

- [1] After these things Jesus walked in Galilee: for He would not walk in Jewry, because the Jews sought to kill Him.
- [2] Now the Jews' feast of tabernacles was at hand.
- [3] His brethren therefore said unto Him, Depart hence, and go into Judaea, that thy disciples also may see the works that Thou doest.
- [4] For there is no man that doeth any thing in secret, and he himself seeketh to be known openly. If Thou do these things, shew Thyself to the world.
- [5] For neither did His brethren believe in him.
- [6] Then Jesus said unto them, My time is not yet come: but your time is alway ready.
- [7] The world cannot hate you; but Me it hateth, because I testify of it, that the works thereof are evil.
- [8] Go ye up unto this feast: I go not up yet unto this feast; for My time is not yet full come.
- [9] When He had said these words unto them, He abode still in Galilee.
- [10] But when His brethren were gone up, then went He also up unto the feast, not openly, but as it were in secret.
- [11] Then the Jews sought Him at the feast, and said, Where is He?
- [12] And there was much murmuring among the people concerning Him: for some said, He is a good man: others said, Nay; but He deceiveth the people.
- [13] Howbeit no man spake openly of Him for fear of the Jews.
- [14] Now about the midst of the feast Jesus went up into the temple, and taught.
- [15] And the Jews marvelled, saying, How knoweth this man letters, having never learned?
- [16] Jesus answered them, and said, My doctrine is not Mine, but His that sent me.
- [17] If any man will do His will, He shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of

God, or whether I speak of myself.

- [18] He that speaketh of himself seeketh his own glory: but he that seeketh his glory that sent him, the same is true, and no unrighteousness is in him.
- [19] Did not Moses give you the law, and yet none of you keepeth the law? Why go ye about to kill me?
- [20] The people answered and said, Thou hast a devil: who goeth about to kill thee?
- [21] Jesus answered and said unto them, I have done one work, and ye all marvel.
- [22] Moses therefore gave unto you circumcision; (not because it is of Moses, but of the fathers;) and ye on the sabbath day circumcise a man.
- [23] If a man on the sabbath day receive circumcision, that the law of Moses should not be broken; are ye angry at me, because I have made a man every whit whole on the sabbath day?
- [24] Judge not according to the appearance, but judge righteous judgment.
- [25] Then said some of them of Jerusalem, Is not this he, whom they seek to kill?
- [26] But, lo, he speaketh boldly, and they say nothing unto him. Do the rulers know indeed that this is the very Christ?

This man, this Jesus, is the Christ. He was the Promised Redeemer. He was the Saviour - and as Nathaniel said - He is the King of Israel. That's what Christ was. That's what Christ means. The text leads us to think that they might not have even realized at that time that they were talking to Jesus of Nazareth. The things He was saying to them were leading them to think that He was the Christ - He was the Anointed One of Israel. This was the King. Christ is not His last name. They didn't even use last names back then.

Side note - there's something here. Here's another example. We probably shouldn't be using last names either. He didn't have a last name - but if he did - Jesus of Nazareth would be more accurate in terms of our evolutionized way of thinking. And I say that because we have evolutionized ourselves to the point where people have first name, last name, middle initial and a uniquely identifying number. We aren't living the way people did when the faith was once delivered to the saints.

"Oh Charlie, come on. That's extreme. That's just taking it far too literally." Well, you can think what you want - but if we are in the dire straits that we know we are in - and we see examples for how to turn things right side up - I don't know why we would not look closer. Because the way we've done things most certainly isn't the right way. At

least it certainly has not worked out well, has it?

[27] Howbeit we know this man whence He is: but when Christ cometh, no man knoweth whence He is.

They were not looking for Jesus, necessarily. They were looking for the Messiah. The King. They were looking for Christ. This is what John is talking about in I John. It's Jesus the King. It's Jesus Christ - Christ is the title - it's not the last name. This is Who they were looking for. They were looking for their King, their Saviour, their Redeemer - their CHRIST.

[28] Then cried Jesus in the temple as he taught, saying, Ye both know me, and ye know whence I am: and I am not come of myself, but he that sent me is true, whom ye know not.

Now look what the inspired text is doing. It is identifying that Jesus is the Christ. This Jesus that came in the first century - in the flesh - this Jesus is the Christ.

- [29] But I know Him: for I am from Him, and He hath sent Me.
- [30] Then they sought to take Him: but no man laid hands on Him, because His hour was not yet come.

Interesting. They wanted to take Him. They were apparently, seemingly, "choosing" to take Him. But it didn't happen. Why? Because they really did not have a choice in the matter. All these events, including the people involved, all of it was planned before the foundation of the world - and they had no choice in the matter. They could have wanted to take Jesus Christ a million times over - and they could not have done so - because it had already been planned and they did not have a choice in the matter.

[31] And many of the people believed on Him, and said, When Christ cometh, will He do more miracles than these which this Man hath done?

Wow, is that cool! I've never seen that like that before. So you believe that Jesus Christ came in the first century - and He is coming again? What for? Because when he "comes again" He's going to do more than what He already has done? Oh man. That gives me chills. There is nothing more for Him to do. He did all that He was supposed to do.

Look at the principle here in verse 31. The believers were telling the unbelievers that

the Jesus Christ that came in the flesh in the first century - did ALL that He was supposed to do. He cannot do anymore a second time than He did the first time. When He came the first time. He did all He was supposed to do.

Look at the principle here in verse 31. The people that believed on Jesus as the Christ at that time - were telling the unbelievers - so you believe that the Christ is yet to come - when your Christ comes - is He going to do more than what this Christ has done? Jesus the Christ that came in the flesh - in the first century - did all that He was supposed to do - He fulfilled all that He was supposed to do - and no other Christ that comes in the future can do anything more than what this One has already done. That's the principle here.

I'm telling you brethren, it is the jews who say that Jesus did not fulfill the prophecies so He was not the Messiah. That's why they are still claiming their messiah has not yet come. And that's what the discussion was about among the Jewry here in John chapter. You say that this man is not the Christ? How so? What possible Christ could yet be coming that could do more than what this One has done? That's what's being said here. For people today to say that Jesus from the first century did not do all that the Messiah was supposed to do - to say that king Jesus is coming back to this earth to finish something He left undone - is to deny that Jesus Christ came in the flesh in the first century.

For us to say there is unfinished work of the Messiah - we are preaching the jews' religion. For the ones who truly believed on Jesus Christ - they said - there is nothing more for Him to do. Wow, is that awesome?

- [32] The Pharisees heard that the people murmured such things concerning Him; and the Pharisees and the chief priests sent officers to take Him.
- [33] Then said Jesus unto them, Yet a little while am I with you, and then I go unto Him that sent Me.
- [34] Ye shall seek Me, and shall not find Me: and where I am, thither ye cannot come.
- [35] Then said the Jews among themselves, Whither will He go, that we shall not find Him? will He go unto the dispersed among the [nations], and teach the [nations]?
- [36] What manner of saying is this that he said, Ye shall seek me, and shall not find me: and where I am, thither ye cannot come?
- [37] In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If

any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.

[38] He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.

Friends, this is the baptism of Christ. This is what a man must be fully immersed into. The baptism of Christ that John spoke about - this is it. It's believing that Jesus is King - that Jesus is the Christ - it's confessing that Jesus Christ the King came in the flesh - then proving that confession is real by living

contrary to the decrees of Caesar, saying that there is another king, one Jesus.

This is what it means to be baptized into, to be fully immersed into Christ. Brethren, I know lots and lots - and there are millions upon millions who have been wettened - in one form or another - but they are not fully immersed into Jesus Christ, the Son of God, the King of kings that came in the flesh in the first century. They have immersed themselves in H20 water - but are immersed into the CONstitution. They are immersed into following the decrees of "caesars" - they are immersed into following the "laws, statues, and treaties made in pursuance of the CON" - they are immersed into "churchianity" and no matter how much H20 they've had sprinkled, dipped or poured onto them - they have never been fully immersed into the faith - the system of belief - that Jesus Christ the King came in the flesh.

- [37] In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.
- [38] He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.
- [39] (But this spake He of the Spirit, which they that believe on Him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)

The Old Covenant World had not yet ended. There was still more work for the Messiah to do at that time. The "whosoever will" of the New Covenant World was not quite ready to be unveiled. Go back to Matthew chapter 3 for just a minute. Listen to John the Baptist in verse 10.

- [10] And now also the axe is laid unto the root of the trees: therefore every tree which bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire.
- [11] I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but He that cometh after

me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: He shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:

The baptism of Christ is not the same as the baptism of John. The water that John the Baptist baptized with was not the same water that being fully immersed into Christ is. John's H20 water was a picture, it was a type, it was a shadow of the Living Waters that would flow out of the belly of Christ. That's what Christ - that's what Jesus the Christ - the King - was telling them. John plainly said - "Look all I'm doing is baptizing you with H20 - this is water baptism for the remission of sins according to the Old Covenant Way - but there is One coming after me who is going to change what it means to be fully immersed."

Again, friends, we know countless numbers of people who have been H20 water baptized - but they are no more fully immersed into King Jesus than the man in the moon. I'm telling you again - how concerned I am that the true Gospel of the Kingdom of Christ has not been preached in the world for many years now - and people that think they are "saved" because they have "believed in a jesus" or they have been baptized into a "jesus" have been deceived. The confession is not true and the testimony of the way our generation lives bears that out.

Of the countless numbers of people who claim to have been baptized into Christ - where are they? Where are the men, women, boys and girls who do contrary to the decrees of caesar, saying there is another King, One Jesus?

Where are the people who confess that Jesus the King came in the flesh in the first century - and their lives bear out that confession? There should be millions and millions of them. Where are the "preachers" today that preach that there is another King, One Jesus, and they demand that the life should reflect the confession? Where are they?

I can't find many. But I can surely find a whole bunch of them that say, "Jesus is king, Jesus is king - but pay your taxes on April 15. Send your kids to the military to support the CON. Take the lethal injection - if you don't you don't love your neighbor."

Matthew sent me this this week. It's a couple of "tweets" from Franklin Graham, the mantle passed leader of the evangelicals. On what they call October 21 at 7:18am, Franklin Graham tweeted:

"Just a suggestion to Facebook and Twitter. Instead of censoring and trying to

determine what is true and false, why don't you just let people debate their points on these public forums?

I'm fully vaccinated with a booster - and I'm glad I took it! However, there are others who feel just as strongly against taking the vaccine. Even though I don't agree, I respect their right to their opinion. Don't you think it is better to encourage debate rather than censorship? Through debate we all learn and will be better for it."

Then on the 10th of what they call November - just a couple weeks later - here's another tweet from Graham.

"Yesterday I underwent a specialized heart surgery at Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota. I had developed constrictive pericarditis, which is inflammation and hardening of the sac around the heart that compresses the heart and prevents it from working."



Oh how I had things to say about that. Then, thank you very much for following that up, Matthew with, Proverbs 24:17-18 -

Rejoice not when thine enemy falleth, and let not thine heart be glad when he stumbleth:

[18] Lest Yahweh see it, and it displease him, and He turn away his wrath from him.

So I just about had to bite my tongue off and not say wanted I wanted to say. I just wonder how many people saw Graham's tweet about being glad he took the lethal injection (explanation point!!!) - then they went out and did it. But, unlike Graham who has received who knows how much funding from the naive - how many of them got sick

or even died because they couldn't afford to go to such a high dollar facility as the Mayo Clinic. The poor schmucks just have to take what they can get. This is disgusting. I have no sympathy for this whatsoever.

Fret not thyself because of evil men, neither be thou envious at the wicked; [20] For there shall be no reward to the evil man; the candle of the wicked shall be put out.

Back to Matthew chapter 7. Who is this Jesus?

- [40] Many of the people therefore, when they heard this saying, said, Of a truth this is the Prophet.
- [41] Others said, This is the Christ. But some said, Shall Christ come out of Galilee?
- [42] Hath not the scripture said, That Christ cometh of the seed of David, and out of the town of Bethlehem, where David was?
- [43] So there was a division among the people because of Him.
- [44] And some of them would have taken him; but no man laid hands on Him.
- [45] Then came the officers to the chief priests and Pharisees; and they said unto them, Why have ye not brought Him?
- [46] The officers answered, Never man spake like this Man.
- [47] Then answered them the Pharisees, Are ye also deceived?
- [48] Have any of the rulers or of the Pharisees believed on Him?
- [49] But this people who knoweth not the law are cursed.
- [50] Nicodemus saith unto them, (he that came to Jesus by night, being one of them,)
- [51] Doth our law judge any man, before it hear him, and know what he doeth?
- [52] They answered and said unto him, Art thou also of Galilee? Search, and look: for out of Galilee ariseth no prophet.
- [53] And every man went unto his own house.

The jews did not accept Him as Christ back then. He told them He was Christ. He made it clear. He put it on the record. He laid it on the tables for all to see.

This Jesus was the Christ. He was the King. He came in the first century - in the flesh. This is the Gospel and anyone who does not believe this is not saved. And anyone who teaches contrary to this is teaching the spirit of antichrist.

I did not write any of this. This is not - if you don't believe like Charlie Steward believes - this is the Word of God. I'm not going to make apologies for it. That's why we are in the shape we are in. We don't want to tell it like it is because we don't want to hurt someone's feelings, we want to be liked by everyone, not hated, I get all that. But this is the truth and it has to be said.

## I John 4:3

And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.

Is a man's life bearing out his confession? What a man believes about Bible prophecy is not what matters - most - it is the implications of what a man believes about Bible prophecy that matters the most.

Take Bible prophecy completely out of the equation. The Bible still teaches that Jesus Christ - Yeshua the King - came in the first century and preached, "Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand." He preached for all men to come out of the sheepfold that is the world and follow Him. Pilate himself wrote above the head of Jesus Christ when He murdered Him, "He said He is the King of the Judahites."

There's no excuse - take Bible prophecy out of the equation if you want to - there's no excuse for people to fail to confess and then live as if Christ - Jesus Christ - is the Only King.

But they don't confess and they don't live - because they've been lied to - they've been made comfortable in their allegiance to the world - because the Bible has been twisted into a lie by men who are agents of the state.

And, the biggest way they have been successful in leading people away is through their false doctrine of futurism. "You can believe that He is King. Yes. Believe that. Encourage that. But it's not time to live that confession. He is a King to come. And when He comes - He will force - with a rod of iron - He will force through threats of death - every man to live according to His Kingship - later - at that time."

So until then, accept the fact that you are in slavery. Accept the fact that the beast system is alive and well and all men are supposed to bow to the beast - accept the fact

that Bible prophecy is the reason for all this madness and not only is there nothing you can do about it - there is nothing you should do about it - because to resist the fulfillment of Bible prophecy would be to resist God Himself.

Futurism is the reason - futurism in any shape or form - is the reason why people confess - but refuse to live - that Jesus Christ is King - right now.

Futurism says exactly what the jews said in John 7 - so if this man Jesus is not the Christ - He is not the King right now - what could another Christ possibly do - that is more than what this One has done?

Yes. It is the jews' religion that says Jesus of Nazareth did not fulfill all the prophecies when He came in the flesh the first time. This is what John is trying to get us to see in I John and particularly in chapter 4. If a man does not believe - if a man does not confess - and his confession is not borne out in his lifestyle - that Jesus Christ came in the flesh - in the first century - that man is lost. If a man believes that Jesus of Nazareth did not fulfill all that the Messiah was supposed to fulfill - then that man is on the side of the jews who were saying that Christ was still to come. That Christ had more to do than what Jesus in the first century did.

Ultimately, God is a spirit, and they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth. As I have pointed out many times before, the ignorant worship of God is no excuse. In our time, possibly more than at any other time in history - I believe that's true. We have literally at our fingertips - the most access to the Word of God than any generation that has ever lived.

But just as the jews did in John 7, many are still making the same mistake today.

When Christ cometh, will He do more miracles than these which this Man hath done?

So you believe that Christ is coming as the jews say? Or coming again, as the "churchians" say? If that's so, will He do more than what Jesus did in the first century?

Brethren, that truly is the jews' religion. Understand the jews' couldn't care less that you say that He is a coming Messiah. They KNOW that saying He is coming again is a denial that He truly came in the flesh in the first century.

The confession that Jesus Christ - that Jesus the King, the Anointed One - that confession - then living a life consistent with that confession concludes:

Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God:
