San Francisco's Police Commission voted 4-2 this week to place limits on what circumstances police can pull over drivers in an effort to cut down on police disproportionately targeting people of color. Called the "pretext stop" policy, the new rule limits police from primarily stopping drivers over nine different low-level offenses, like failing to display registration tag or failing to use a turn signal, Axios reports. Low-level traffic stops are often used by police as fishing expeditions targeting a disproportionate amount of people of color.

They should do away with all their "fishing expeditions" not just these.

In San Francisco, for instance, Black people make up five percent of the population, but account for 19 percent of all traffic stops made in the city, Axios reports. Countless studies reinforce the trend of pretextual stops disproportionally affecting people of color while such stops do little to cut down on crime, as reported in the New York Times.

"There are a cluster of low-level traffic stops that are just not yielding any public safety benefit for the city," Commission Vice President Max Carter-Oberstone told the San Francisco Standard. "But they do take up a lot of time and they do cost a lot of money and by curtailing those stops we can reallocate all of those law enforcement resources to other strategies that we know are effective."

The article continues but I'll not keep going. The link is in the transcript if you want to read the whole thing.

I don't care what their "pretexts" are. I don't care if they claim to be doing this because it "unfairly targets blacks" or a little closer to the truth "[it] costs a lot of money and by curtailing those stops we can reallocate all of those law enforcement resources to other strategies that we know are effective..."

It's always about the money. I don't care what they claim their "pretexts" are for doing away with such stops, but I for one, am glad to see it. Even though these men's little g "governments" have no power or Authority to even exist, at least seeing them take a step towards leaving people alone unless they committed an actual sin - or crime as they call it - I'm all for it.

We know that no one is allowed to organize themselves and call it a "government" unless they are operating under the Authority of King Jesus - but even when these people do what they claim they are doing - I'm still glad to see things like this happen. I was getting ready to call this rare, but I think I need to see I don't think I've ever seen something like this happen before.

If these ungodly associations would direct their resources to exclusively punishing evildoers - those that violate the Laws of God - simple - no murder, no stealing, no perjury - it might be a little hard to speak against them.

One of our brethren was traveling down the road the other day in Missouri. One of those places I told you were dominated by churchianity - in that they believe that god is the state - he was minding his own business. Wasn't even violating their "statues" as far as his rate of speed is concerned - and one of their hired guns decided that he wanted to pull our brother over to the side of the road - under a threat of violence. Which brings me to a bit of a side-step. Matthew sent me a link to a video that I am going to post here for you to look at. I don't know if the guy is a follower of Christ - I'd probably be inclined to believe not - simply because in the video - I don't see or hear any reference to Christ - but the guy is giving a video directed to people that do not believe men's "governments" are violent. It's actually ridiculous that people don't know this and someone would have to tell them. But you know the land is filled with this dissociative psychosis. The simple fact that when they decide to "pull someone over" the bright, flashing lights come on. "Which means, pull over or something really bad will happen to you."

So, under a threat of violence, our brother pulls over to the side of the road. The "pretext" for this harassment? The cop tells our brother that he witnessed his car touch the white line on the side of the road. Liar. I don't believe that for a second. But worse than that - so what. So what if his tire touched the white line. Who did that hurt? Where's a victim? Where's the damage? This is outrageous. And I'm telling you - listen to me now - this "righteous cop" who for whatever reason thought he would harass someone who was simply traveling home from a hard day's work - listen to me now - his actions could very well rise to the level of kidnapping in the eyes of God. Detaining someone without a cause - and that cause must be for violating the Laws of God - I'm telling you - standing there on the side of the road with a gun on your side - and you put handcuffs on someone who has not violated the Laws of God - you are committing a capital offense in the eyes of God and God is not going to hold someone guiltless of this because they are wearing a certain uniform and can hide behind the concept of something called "immunity."

Friends, no one is immune from the consequences of violating the Laws of God. If you are listening to my voice today and you are a cop and you do this to people - I'm telling

you - you are committing a capital crime - a capital sin - worthy of death in the eyes of God and you need to repent for what you have done and stop doing it. Which more than likely means quit your "job" and start doing honest labor like the rest of us.

So, hopefully, in San Francisco, at least, people are not going to be harassed for - as they said - "low-level offenses." And of course, these are "low-level offenses" according to their "statues."

Under God's Law - there are no "low-level offenses." For instance, under God's Law am I required to use a turn signal on the road? No. I am not. But what if my failure to use a turn signal causes damage to someone else on the road and it's my fault for causing the damage because I didn't use a turn signal. Is that violating of God's Law? Absolutely. You better believe it is. And a judge - that was judging according to the Laws and Perfect Will of God - would adjudicate that way. There are no "statutes" in God's Laws that pertain to would-be, could-be, might-be "crimes." God's Statutes come into play when there is damage done and not until. Man is free to do whatever he wants to do in life - but he is not free to violate the Laws of God.

And, for those who believe that God gave man the power or Authority to expand the Laws of God to include whatever statue they want to erect - they are terribly mistaken. Please remember what we saw a couple weeks ago from Deuteronomy chapter 4, verses 1 and 2. Listen again:

[1] Now therefore hearken, O Israel, unto the statutes and unto the judgments, which I teach you, for to do them, that ye may live, and go in and possess the land which the LORD God of your fathers giveth you.

[2] Ye shall not add unto the word which I command you, neither shall ye diminish ought from it, that ye may keep the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you.

This is so crystal clear. You shall not add to what I told you. The God of the "Old Testament" speaks only of His Laws, Commandments, Judgements, and Perfect Will for His Creation. We see this everywhere we look in the first 39 books of the Bible. Then, somehow, God sends His Only begotten Son to physically walk and talk among the people - and He tells Jesus to tell people that the God of the Old Testament has completely changed His mind on people obeying Him exclusively. That has to be the most ridiculous thing I've ever heard. My Statutes, My Statutes, My Statutes. That's all we see from the Revealed God of the Bible.

Friends, if the first 39 books have no value to us beyond just the cute little bedtime stories about Adam and Eve and an apple, or Noah and a big flood, and Jonah and a whale, or David and a giant - if we do not understand that all of what was written was to show us the way God wants His people to interact with Him - then we really should just take those first 39 books and rip them out and throw them away. Then, while we're at it, maybe we should throw away Matthew Mark Luke and John - because those books are filled with Jesus telling the people that they were to obey God, obey His Commandments, forsake the traditions of men, and many other such like things you do, we may as well throw those books out as well. And, I guess, we should just go ahead and throw the rest out, too, and just keep a twisted perversion of Romans 13 in the Book, and a twisted perversion of I Peter chapter 2 in the Book. In fact, let's just go straight to verse 13 and forget reading 1-12 of I Peter 2. The only way someone can conclude that Romans 13 or I Peter 2 is telling people that God now commands people to disregard His Laws, Statutes, Commandments and Judgements, is to throw the entire Book away - and keep only 7 verses from the rest of the Book - taken out of context.

When we read the first 39 books of the Bible and we see over and over and over that God commands obedience - exclusively - to His Laws and Statutes - there is - or should be - no possible way to see Romans 13 or I Peter 2 as anything other than an agreement with what God has always commanded for His Creation.

It is beyond amazement. There are no words to explain, no words to comprehend, how people can say their lives are "governed by the "Revised Statutes of Missouri" or the "Nebraska Revised Statutes" or "The United States Statutes at Large."

The only way this has happened is for men and women boys and girls to take that Book - that so many of them call - The Word of God - and just complete disregard it as nothing more than a collection of children's bedtime stories.

Turn to Leviticus chapter 26 this morning, please and let's begin in verse 1. Let's get some more of the God of the "Old Testament." Hear the Word of the Lord this morning.

[1] Ye shall make you no idols nor graven image, neither rear you up a standing image, neither shall ye set up any image of stone in your land, to bow down unto it: for I am the LORD your God.

I went online and did a search for "how many statues are there in Washington, D.C.?" I'm talking statues - in addition to their "statutes" - which are also statues. In The National Statuary Hall Collection in the United States Capitol Building is comprised of statues donated by individual states to honor persons notable in their history. The entire collection now consists of 100 statues contributed by 50 states. CBS News reports that in Washington D.C., alone, we're not talking about all the states, just Washington D.C., there are more than 160 statues and memorials scattered throughout the city.

In South Dakota, they took the whole side of a mountain and carved the images of mere men into the mountain. The Smithsonian Magazine has reported that they believe there are more than 50,000 monuments and statues in the U.S. But, of course, none of that can be what God is talking about here in Leviticus 26. He is only referring to little tiki gods carved from elephant tusks in the deepest, darkest jungles of Africa. Verse 2.

- [2] Ye shall keep My sabbaths, and reverence My sanctuary: I am the LORD.
- [3] If ye walk in My Statutes, and keep My Commandments, and do them;

And once again. I guess this is my problem, if you want to call it that. I'm just simplistic. I had a "judge" tell me one time that my problem is that I see things strictly in black and white. The Scriptures, when using the word statutes - tell us - as plainly and clearly as anything there is in the Bible - that men are to obey the Statutes of God. How people that call themselves Christians or followers of God, or followers of Christ, or Bible believers - fill in the blank - how they are not just terrified by the use of the word "statute" by men when they define their "body of law" - I just don't get it.

And if that simplicity, of just reading the Word of God and then applying it in my life, if that causes me to have conflict with the people who have hijacked the word Statute and taken it to themselves - then I guess that's just the way it has to be. And, when I stand before God and if I am wrong about my simplistic beliefs - then He'll have to pronounce me guilty for teaching and preaching that men were to obey Him exclusively and not obey their own statues. If that is wrong - then guilty - I am 100% guilty.

We are to obey exclusively - the Statutes of God - and when someone presents us with their "statues" - and especially when they call them "statutes" - that should be a dead give-away that we are not dealing with people who have yielded themselves to the God of the Bible. Verse 4.

[4] Then I will give you rain in due season, and the land shall yield her increase, and the trees of the field shall yield their fruit.

[5] And your threshing shall reach unto the vintage, and the vintage shall reach unto the sowing time: and ye shall eat your bread to the full, and dwell in your land safely.

[6] And I will give peace in the land, and ye shall lie down, and none shall make you afraid: and I will rid evil beasts out of the land, neither shall the sword go through your land.

[7] And ye shall chase your enemies, and they shall fall before you by the sword.[8] And five of you shall chase an hundred, and an hundred of you shall put ten thousand to flight: and your enemies shall fall before you by the sword.

[9] For I will have respect unto you, and make you fruitful, and multiply you, and establish my covenant with you.

[10] And ye shall eat old store, and bring forth the old because of the new.

[11] And I will set my tabernacle among you: and my soul shall not abhor you.

Now watch this.

[12] And I will walk among you, and will be your God, and ye shall be my people.

Did that verse set off any bells or whistles for you? It certainly did for me. Keep your finger here. For those who think that what I am saying or what I've been teaching concerning the Statutes of God is just "Old World theology, it's Old Testament" and has no relevance in the New Covenant, turn to II Corinthians chapter 6. Let's begin in verse 14.

[**14**] Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?

[15] And what concord hath Christ with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel?

[**16**] And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for ye are the temple of the living God; as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

He's quoting Leviticus 26.

[17] Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord,

and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you,

He's speaking in the first century - but quoting Leviticus 26.

[**18**] And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.

This is demonstrating again, that what the God of the first 39 books of the Bible wanted for those people - is the same thing He wants in the last 27 books. Verse 14.

Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?

It's called the United States of America.

Webster's 1828 defines yoked this way.

YOKED, participle passive Confined in a yoke; joined; coupled.

I realize that we all live on a very large piece of ground that men have called America. And that's fine. But to voluntarily join an association that calls itself "united" - for the follower of Christ - I don't get it. I don't understand. I guess it's that dissociative psychosis thing again. They can say the word "united" a thousand times - but in the end - it doesn't really apply to them. It doesn't mean that united means locking arms with the homosexuals, the alcoholics, the gamblers. By their voluntary association with "We the People" - they are absolutely destroying the teaching of the Bible which tells Christians - true followers of Jesus Christ:

Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers:

This is not a suggestion. This is not a children's bedtime story. This is the Word of God, this is "Thus saith the Lord." And we need to - if it takes our entire life - our entire life should include all we can to make sure we are not unequally yoked together with unbelievers." Especially - especially - when we were born into a world of deception that has done all it could do - from infanthood on up - to train us into believing that being united together with unbelievers is what God actually wants us to do.

What we are reading in II Corinthians chapter 6 is the same thing we read in Leviticus chapter 26. It's the same thing spoken hundreds years apart - because the God of Leviticus 26 is the same God of II Corinthians chapter 6. We don't have a schizophrenic God. We don't have a God that commanded obedience to Him in the "Old Testament" and then obedience to mere men in the "New Testament." It's the same God and He expects and demands the same things from every one - from generation to generation - with the exception of the obvious - no more animal sacrifices - no more "baptisms" in physical water, no more physical circumcisions and a few other minor details. But as far as the Statutes of God Governing the way we live - that's still in place. Now go back to Leviticus chapter 26 verse 13.

[**13**] I am the LORD your God, which brought you forth out of the land of Egypt, that ye should not be their bondmen; and I have broken the bands of your yoke, and made you go upright.

This is amazing how this pertains to the Christian life today. We are not supposed to be other men's bondmen. We are not supposed to be slaves of other men. In the Old World - God clearly told the children of Israel - I broke the bonds of your slavery in Egypt. Slavery is not what I want for my people. I want my people to be slaves of no one. They are to be free. This is what God did for the children of Israel. And today, it is not right for one man to tell another man how to live his life. God does that! God tells men how to live their lives. It's called His Statutes, His Commandments, His Law and His Perfect Will.

We know the rest of the story. After a while, they forgot how God had delivered them. They went right back into slavery and bondage to men again. Why? Because they forsook the Laws and Statutes of God. At the end of the Old Covenant World - God sent His Son to once and for all provide a way our of bondage and slavery. Jesus Christ broke the bonds of slavery. Jesus Christ broke the bands of the yoke - not just for the children of Israel - but for everyone who will call Him King and follow Him out of the world - the systems they have established to enslave people.

Today, we live in a world where "government" thinks they own everything - including - and especially - the people.

I'll never forget - as long as I live - and I wish I could get this burned into the minds of everyone that will ever hear my voice - I stood before one of their "judges" one day and the "judge" said to me - "For every proceeding in this trial from this point forward, your

name is 'so and so.'" It was a name that was not mine. It was a name that my wife didn't call me. It was a name my children didn't call me. It was a name that was different from my wife and different from my children. I even had provided the "court" with statements from my own parents - stating - "This is our son, and this is his name."

Yet, this "judge" who had never known me, had never seen me before, decided that he was going to be one that told me what my own name was. I was more than 50 years old and some man was coming into my life telling me that my name was something other than what I said it was? That's just the stupidest thing I've ever heard of. I guess there's two of those today. But that's because they are functioning under this false illusion that own people. And if they own people, then just like their cattle, they can punch a hole in someone's ear and put an ear tag in it and that's what they'll be identified by - whether the cow says something different or not.

Well, friends, I have news for them and everyone else. I do not belong to them. I have never done anything in my life that says I belong to them. Keep your finger here in Leviticus 26 and turn to I Corinthians chapter 6. Paul, speaking to those who claimed to be Christians in the first century. Don't you know this? Don't you realize that this happens when you are a follower of Jesus Christ? Verse 19:

[19] What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?[20] For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

Which belong to God.

How do you not know this? How do you not know that you belong to God now? You are to glorify God in your bodies. You do not belong to me. You belong to God. Why would this need to be said? Because the war over men thinking they own another men has gone on for thousands of years. It's always been that way and I guess it always will be. For the follower of Christ - we are to yield our bodies to NO ONE except for the God of the Bible and His Son, King Jesus.

While we are here, I want to mention something briefly. There is another principle here that needs to be brought out. For those of you who have tattoos on you from your past - nothing you can do about that now. But, don't you dare put another one on your body. And for those who do not have tattoos - don't you dare get one. Your body is not

your own. You do not own your body to the extent you can do anything you want to with your body. God owns your body and we are to glorify Him with our bodies. Our bodies are the temple of God and they are not our own to change the way God created them.

Turn over a page to chapter 7. Look at verses 21-23.

[**21**] Art thou called being a servant? care not for it: but if thou mayest be made free, use it rather.

There are times in the economy of God where someone might be forced into being a servant. For instance, if you damage someone's property and do not have the ability to pay for the damages right then. I do not believe this means that you then would be forced onto a plantation and work exclusively for the one you damaged until the payment is made. I don't believe that's what that means. First of all, that could put an unnecessary burden on the one you damaged. If this means you are supposed to leave your family and work as a slave for the one you damaged, then that means the one you damaged would be responsible for feeding you, providing for your well-being, etc., and maybe even for your family, too. That's not always practical - in fact - in today's world - it would rarely be practical.

You would more than likely be under some sort of repayment plan where you had to pay so much until the repayment was made. But if you find yourself in a situation like that, do all you can to get out from under that situation. Get the repayment taken care of fast as you possibly can and get out from under that burden of servant-hood. Care not for it. Freedom is far more preferred for the follower of Christ. Why? Verse 22.

[22] For he that is called in the Lord, being a servant, is the Lord's freeman: likewise also he that is called, being free, is Christ's servant.[23] Ye are bought with a price; be not ye the servants of men.

Remember, no man can serve two masters. Christ has redeemed us. Christ has made us free. We were purchased by Him with the greatest cost a man ever gave.

Therefore - be not ye the servants of men.

Do not let another man lay claim to you. Friends, I just don't understand why people cannot see this. It is so simple. It's so clear. Just because a man claims to be

"government" that does not supercede these Words that the followers of Christ are supposed to live by.

We need to understand how simplistic the Gospel is. We need to understand how the Gospel is not hard. When people try to convince us that we are supposed to be servants of men, we are supposed to be in bondage and slavery to men, we are supposed to submit to men's little g "governments" - those ideas and concepts are called the "wiles of devils" and we need to know that's what it is and stand against them in the Authority - in the Name of Jesus Christ the King.

Turn back to Acts chapter 20, please. Begin reading about Paul in verse 27. Verse 27, in my opinion, is one of the most important principles that we need to understand about our purpose and what God wants for His people.

[27] For I have not shunned to declare unto you all the counsel of God.

If we do not understand the first 39 books of the Bible - where God made it abundantly clear that man's whole existence is supposed to be focused on His Laws, His Statutes, His Commandments and His Perfect Will which is what all the counsel of God is - then we will completely miss the meaning of life. We'll miss on what God wants for us and how He wants us to live - and we will be reduced to mere slaves that obey the whims of men - by what they call their "governments."

[**28**] Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the people of the Government of God, which He hath purchased with His own blood.

I hope we see the awesomeness of this statement. I'm afraid that most people don't see it - because most people toss around the phrase "Jesus died for me" - and they never even think for a minute the implications of that statement.

[29] For I know this, that after my departing shall grievous wolves enter in among you, not sparing the flock.

[**30**] Also of your own selves shall men arise, speaking perverse things, to draw away disciples after them.

[**31**] Therefore watch, and remember, that by the space of three years I ceased not to warn every one night and day with tears.

[32] And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace,

which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified.

So Jesus purchased us, He owns us, the price He paid was His Own blood - but most people live their lives according to the dictates of men and the truth is - the "blood of the men who died in the U.S. military" is far more precious and valuable than the blood of Jesus Christ. You know and I know it. The blood of all the militaries of all of men's little g "governments" is priced far above the blood that Jesus Christ shed.

The reality is that all the blood those men have shed in all their countless numbers of wars that have fought in order to dominate men into submission - all of that blood is not as valuable as one blood droplet that came from the body of Jesus Christ when those evil men executed Him in the first century.

And again, the phrase "Jesus died for me" has been tossed around millions, maybe even billions of times by people and I dare say that not one out of a million that's ever even considered what that means.

"Jesus died on the cross." What does that mean? Do people ever consider - beyond the idea that Jesus was the sacrifice. Jesus died on the cross for the sins of many. Will you think about this for a minute, please?

Does anyone ever ask the question - who killed Jesus? Do they ever ask the question, why they killed Jesus? Does anyone ever ask those questions from the point of view of the people who actually put Jesus on trial? From the point of view of the people that actually punched Him in the face? Pulled out His beard? Forced a crown of thorns into His head? Then, took His hands and His feet and nailed them to a wooden cross and then plunged that cross into the ground, then mocked Him and ridiculed Him until He took His final breath. Then, they took a spear and plunged it into His side to make sure He was dead?

Friends, Jesus was executed by the state. If you were to go online and find a list of people executed by the state. You'd would see the names, John Wayne Gacy, Ted Bundy, Gary Gilmore. You'd see Timothy McVeigh. You'd see people accused of murder. You'd see people accused of sedition and treason. I found a list of people executed by the state for all the many things, including the things I listed - and - in the lists that I looked at - right along with all these other names - is the name - Jesus.

But it was the plan of God for Jesus to die for the sins of the world. Yes. I understand that. But why that way? Why not dying valiantly in a battle? Why not simply of living a long life of perfection, then dying of old age? When the Roman soldiers were beating Him and nailing Him to the cross - do you think they were saying among themselves - "This is the plan of God for this man to die for the sins of the world." Do you think they were saying among themselves, "What we're doing to this Jesus is so that the system of sacrificing animals would end. We are killing this Jesus as a sacrificial lamb so that we don't have to do this to anyone else. This Jesus is paying for the sins of the whole world."

Do you really think that's what the Roman soldiers had in mind when they did what they did?

I've told you before, through the years, I've often asked the question to people, "What were the charges brought against Jesus at His trial?" And, of the people I have asked that question, not only have I never received the correct Biblical answer, but most people never even provided an answer. They had never thought of that, because all they have ever had put into their mind, was that "Jesus died for their sins."

They've never considered the fact that Jesus was arrested by the cops. He was placed into handcuffs. He was interrogated. He was mercilessly beaten. He was accused of taxevasion - those were the official charges in His case. He had a trial. Just like today. He had a trial. There was a prosecutor. There were witnesses. There was a judge. He had a trial. He was found guilty. And He was executed by the state as a common criminal.

That's how Jesus "died for your sins." He was hung between two other accused common criminals. Two thieves. That's how Jesus "died for your sins."

The Roman soldiers - the cops - the prison guards - the ones who were employed by the department of corrections - carried out the sentence that was brought down against Jesus - which was the death penalty. He "died for your sins" - by being executed by the state.

Why? Again, we know the ultimate plan. We know that He had to die. But why did He die the death of a criminal? He was executed by the state. Just like Ted Bundy was executed by the state. Jesus Christ was charged, tried and convicted by the state. And He was executed by the state - and people love the idea that "Jesus died for their sins" - but the who, what, when, where and why means absolutely nothing.

The state executed Jesus because the state did not like how Jesus lived, how He preached and how He told others they were to live. From the state's perspective - listen to me - not from God's perspective - from the people who executed Him - He was a criminal to their "government" and that's why they killed Him. They didn't kill Him because they were willing participants in the plan of God to have Jesus "die for the sins of the world."

Jesus was executed by the state because Jesus taught men and women, boys and girls, and then lived His life exclusively obeying the Laws, Statutes, Commandments and Perfect Will of His Father. He taught and lived that men are to obey His Father's Commandments. They are not to obey their traditions. They are not to obey their statues. They are to obey God and God alone. The God of the Bible and His Laws and Statutes were to be what Governed their lives. Dictated to them how to live - what to do and what not to do.

The religious arm of the state hated Him for this and the religious arm of the state convinced the state that Jesus taught against Caesar. That Jesus taught against men obeying men's little g "governments" and that Jesus had committed tax fraud which rose to the level of sedition - and they condemned Him to death. And Jesus was executed by the state as a common criminal - and to this death - his name is listed right alongside names such as Ted Bundy and John Wayne Gacy.

Please don't misunderstand me. I'm not saying that Jesus' "crimes" against men's "governments" were the same as Bundy and Gacy. I'm not saying that at all. I'm simply trying to get people to understand that Jesus "died for their sins" - and the method by which it happened was as a common criminal, hung between two thieves.

Of all the ways that God could have had His Son die - why was it this way?

Before His death, Jesus told people in order to be His follower, they, too, had to take up a cross and follow Him. The cross was a symbol of execution by the state.

When you tell people that you will live exclusively by the Statutes of God - and not according to the statues of men - they will - in some cases - treat you as badly as they would treat someone who committed a murder. And that's exactly what they did to Jesus Christ. Jesus was guilty of nothing. Jesus never violated the Laws of God. Yet - when it came time for Him to die - Jesus died the death of a common criminal.

Jesus gave His life for living according to His Father's Laws and Statutes. And that is exactly what the follower of Christ is supposed to be willing to do today. Why? Because the only way to life and peace and joy is to obey the Statutes of God.

You might say, "Well, not today. You live according to the Laws and Statutes of God today and it's going to be nothing but hassle, maybe jail, maybe worse."

We cannot help the times in which we were born. We were all born into a time where men have gotten it all wrong. Just like the time of Christ. Those people were born at a time where men had gotten it wrong. Jesus came to show the way. His disciples that followed Him were there to show others the way. No matter what the consequences were - they obeyed the Father's Will.

We are required to do the same. We were born into a world where few have gotten it right. We are called to be light and salt.

Teresa and I realized many years ago, we no longer live for ourselves. We live the way we live - number one - because it's the right thing to do - to follow Christ - but also - to be a testimony for those coming behind us. We live for our children and for our grandchildren.

I preach the way I do in hopes that people will hear and they will obey the teachings of the Scripture. That by obeying the teachings of the Scripture, their lives will be better than what ours were. That by obeying the teachings of the Scripture, the enemies of God will be held back so that those who want to live according to the teachings of God might have it better than we did. Go back to Leviticus chapter 26. Pick back up with verse 14.

[14] But if ye will not hearken unto Me, and will not do all these Commandments;
[15] And if ye shall despise My Statutes, or if your soul abhor My Judgments, so that ye will not do all My commandments, but that ye break My Covenant:
[16] I also will do this unto you; I will even appoint over you terror, consumption, and the burning ague, that shall consume the eyes, and cause sorrow of heart: and ye shall sow your seed in vain, for your enemies shall eat it.

This is where we are today. We are in the condition we are in because the people have set up their "Revised Statues / statutes" everywhere. They have refused to hearken to the simple Words of God and they have set up their own statues everywhere.

[**17**] And I will set my face against you, and ye shall be slain before your enemies: they that hate you shall reign over you; and ye shall flee when none pursueth you.

I've heard this my whole life. "Why do we not see the hand of God like they did in the Bible?" Well, my answer is this. "We do see the hand of God - and it's against us. Nearly every single person in this world today has chosen to live according to the statues of men. When this happens, God tells us what He does. I don't understand why there are not more people that see this."

Is it because it's just so simple that people won't believe it because of the simplicity? Maybe. I think the bigger reason is because of the deception. It begins with that thing called "church" - which again - I'm telling you - if whoever you are listening to concerning the Word of God - has not understood that that word - and that concept should not be in our Bibles - in our lives - then you better be careful about what you are hearing.

There is a movement among people that are refusing to yield themselves to the Scriptures because they say things like, "The early 'church' fathers did not teach...." for instance, Fulfilled Bible prophecy, among other things. Whenever you hear the word "church" every alarm bell and buzzer you have should be going off to alert you that truth is in jeopardy. It should be no surprise at all that the teachings of the "church fathers" do not agree with the clear teachings of Christ. Verse 18:

[**18**] And if ye will not yet for all this hearken unto Me, then I will punish you seven times more for your sins.

[**19**] And I will break the pride of your power; and I will make your heaven as iron, and your earth as brass:

[20] And your strength shall be spent in vain: for your land shall not yield her increase, neither shall the trees of the land yield their fruits.

[21] And if ye walk contrary unto Me, and will not hearken unto Me; I will bring seven times more plagues upon you according to your sins.

[22] I will also send wild beasts among you, which shall rob you of your children, and destroy your cattle, and make you few in number; and your highways shall be desolate.

[23] And if ye will not be reformed by Me by these things, but will walk contrary unto Me;

[24] Then will I also walk contrary unto you, and will punish you yet seven times

for your sins.

What is this? What is the foundation of all this judgement? Verse 3:

If ye walk in My Statutes, and keep My Commandments, and do them;

That's what all of this about. Verse 25.

[25] And I will bring a sword upon you, that shall avenge the quarrel of My Covenant: and when ye are gathered together within your cities, I will send the pestilence among you; and ye shall be delivered into the hand of the enemy.[26] And when I have broken the staff of your bread, ten women shall bake your bread in one oven, and they shall deliver you your bread again by weight: and ye shall eat, and not be satisfied.

[27] And if ye will not for all this hearken unto Me, but walk contrary unto Me;[28] Then I will walk contrary unto you also in fury; and I, even I, will chastise you seven times for your sins.

No doubt some will say after hearing this message - "but Jesus died for our sins." Yes. Agreed. But He did not die for our sins so we could continue living in sin. Jesus did away with the animal sacrifices. Jesus did away with the physical "baptisms", Jesus did away with the physical circumcisions - but He did not do away with the way God said He wants people to live their lives. Jesus did not do all that He did so that men would forsake the Laws of God concerning murder, theft, perjury, etc., and create their own statues. Statues that in many times say the exact opposite of what God's Statutes say.

[**29**] And ye shall eat the flesh of your sons, and the flesh of your daughters shall ye eat.

[**30**] And I will destroy your high places, and cut down your images, and cast your carcases upon the carcases of your idols, and my soul shall abhor you.

[**31**] And I will make your cities waste, and bring your sanctuaries unto desolation, and I will not smell the savour of your sweet odours.

[**32**] And I will bring the land into desolation: and your enemies which dwell therein shall be astonished at it.

[**33**] And I will scatter you among the heathen, and will draw out a sword after you: and your land shall be desolate, and your cities waste.

[**34**] Then shall the land enjoy her sabbaths, as long as it lieth desolate, and ye be in your enemies' land; even then shall the land rest, and enjoy her sabbaths.

[**35**] As long as it lieth desolate it shall rest; because it did not rest in your sabbaths, when ye dwelt upon it.

[**36**] And upon them that are left alive of you I will send a faintness into their hearts in the lands of their enemies; and the sound of a shaken leaf shall chase them; and they shall flee, as fleeing from a sword; and they shall fall when none pursueth.

[**37**] And they shall fall one upon another, as it were before a sword, when none pursueth: and ye shall have no power to stand before your enemies.

[**38**] And ye shall perish among the heathen, and the land of your enemies shall eat you up.

[39] And they that are left of you shall pine away in their iniquity in your enemies' lands; and also in the iniquities of their fathers shall they pine away with them.[40] If they shall confess their iniquity, and the iniquity of their fathers, with their trespass which they trespassed against me, and that also they have walked contrary unto me;

[**41**] And that I also have walked contrary unto them, and have brought them into the land of their enemies; if then their uncircumcised hearts be humbled, and they then accept of the punishment of their iniquity:

[**42**] Then will I remember my covenant with Jacob, and also my covenant with Isaac, and also my covenant with Abraham will I remember; and I will remember the land.

[43] The land also shall be left of them, and shall enjoy her sabbaths, while she lieth desolate without them: and they shall accept of the punishment of their iniquity: because, even because they despised my judgments, and because their soul abhorred my statutes.

[**44**] And yet for all that, when they be in the land of their enemies, I will not cast them away, neither will I abhor them, to destroy them utterly, and to break My covenant with them: for I am the LORD their God.

[**45**] But I will for their sakes remember the covenant of their ancestors, whom I brought forth out of the land of Egypt in the sight of the heathen, that I might be their God: I am the LORD.

I'm not saying for sure, but that principle could very well be why God has not completely and utterly allowed America to be destroyed - yet. It could very well be that God is remembering the men and women boys and girls that signed onto and agreed to live by the Scriptures as stated in the New Haven Colony Covenant more than 400 years ago. [46] These are the Statutes and Judgments and Laws, which the LORD made between him and the children of Israel in mount Sinai by the hand of Moses.

How can it possibly be that God would speak these Words to the children of Israel and command them to be kept all the way to the time of Christ - then all of a sudden - tell Jesus to tell everyone this was no longer going to be what was expected?

Ok. I get that that was what was done according to the sacrifices, and the water "baptisms" - I get that. But we are talking principles here. Principles that are for all time. God wants His Creation to live according to His - very few - very few Commandments, Statutes and Judgements. God does not want His Creation to set their own definitions of good and evil, right and wrong, and call them statutes, and tell men and women boys and girls to govern themselves by their statues.

Obviously, as obvious as God could have made it, the animal sacrifices are no more. Jesus put an end to that system. While the enemies of God executed Jesus for their own wicked reasons, God took that horrible circumstance and used it for His Own good.

The animal sacrifices ended. The water washings - otherwise known as "baptisms" -Jesus provided an end of those things. But the way we are supposed to live our lives. The way were are supposed to be Governed in our affairs with other men - God has not ever abandoned His definitions of good and evil.

Today, men call sodomy good. It's praised. They have gay-las and feasts with their presidents and former presidents celebrating their debauchery. Gambling is good. It's all over the land today. Believe it or not, it was from Fox News. It says:

A Mega Millions lottery ticket purchased in Maine was worth a staggering \$1.348 billion this past Friday night.

The winning jackpot is the fourth-largest the world has ever seen and the secondlargest in Mega Millions game history, as FOX Business reported.

While many people play the lottery with dreams of financial freedom and an escape from their current reality, one national expert is sounding the alarm about the practice, saying "predatory" gambling is America's "most neglected major problem."

Les Bernal is national director of Stop Predatory Gambling, an organization headquartered in Washington, D.C.

"Through its advertising and marketing of lotteries, state governments have turned a nation of small earners — who could be small savers — into a nation of habitual gamblers," Bernal told Fox News Digital by email.

Bernal also said that over the next eight years, the American people are "going to lose more than \$1 trillion of personal wealth to commercialized gambling, at least half of which is being extracted by state lotteries."

He added, "If you could just cut that figure by 50%, there's no other policy reform that comes in 1,000 miles of that to make a bigger difference in the lives of everyday Americans."

Bernal offered specific examples of how lotteries prey on lower-income citizens.

He pointed out that there is a concentration of sales outlets in poorer communities, as well as messages on scratch tickets that "deceitfully declare" that playing is "your fastest way to a million dollars!"

One Massachusetts 50-year-old who regularly gives scratch tickets as gifts to people he doesn't know well, such as gifts for grab-bags, said that practice sometimes "leaves a twinge of guilt, to be honest."

He also said, "How do I know that the recipient isn't teetering on the edge of a gambling addiction? It's worth thinking about."

Bernal continued, "So if you're someone who just lost their job, or you're trying to pay your rent at the end of the month, or you need money to pay a large medical bill, state lotteries attempt to position themselves as the answer — exploiting the financial desperation of our fellow citizens."

Many states are now selling \$50 scratch tickets — "and Texas sells \$100 scratch-off tickets" in low-income neighborhoods — "to citizens making a minimum wage of \$7.25 an hour," he said.

"A citizen has to work two days before they can lose it all in an instant to a \$100 scratch ticket promoted by Texas state government," Bernal noted.

"State lottery advertising and marketing is the public voice of American government today," he continued.

"It's what we advertise to the American people more than anything else — and it's a con. It's a lie," Bernal also said.

Just chalk it up to the rest of them.

"What government incentivizes to the American people shapes our national character." Bernal said that state lotteries are "driven by greed," and their marketing and advertising strategies toward lower-income groups are "a reflection of this."

Advertising is tailored by income category, he noted.

Friends, none of you better buy a lottery ticket or bet on a sporting event. It's evil. It's against the Laws of God and it should be exposed and preached against.

Today, evil is called good and good is called evil. It's everywhere. Right in your face. And yes, that choice, if you choose the Statutes of God, means, taking up a cross - not *the* cross - there was only One Who was able to take up *the* cross - it means taking up a cross - and following King Jesus.
