

What is the Gospel?

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In last week's message, I brought out what could be considered by some, to be the most controversial points that I have made since I have been preaching these messages on Missouri Liberty Radio.

This is the same message that I have been preaching for over 35 years now. My message has been a singular focus - and that is - that the Kingdom of God and the Kingship of Christ has been a present day reality since AD70 - and it is the responsibility of every living, breathing creature to conform to His Kingdom - and His Kingdom only.

I have preached that in the Old Covenant World - because of Israel's rebellion - the sinful condition of their evil hearts - and their demand for a "king like all the other nations" - Yahweh gave them what they wanted.

But - and this is extremely important - this was allowed only for a period of time - until the end of the Old Covenant World - where - in that time - in the end of the Old Covenant World - He would send His Son to redeem His people, to forgive their sins, to reconcile their iniquity - that being the national sin of rejecting Yahweh as their King and Lawgiver - to reveal to God's creation what His righteousness looks like - and to anoint His Son as King of kings and Lord of lords - to put down all rule, power and authority that was allowed in the Old Covenant system - and to require all men, women, boys and girls to forevermore submit to His Kingdom - and to His Kingdom only.

The events of the Old Covenant World were hugely important. The lessons learned from the stories that took place were all written for our learning and instruction in the New Covenant World. They were recorded so that we could know the perfect Will of God for His creation.

Let me explain. One might assert that the promises to Abraham from God could be considered to be the starting point to determine this perfect Will of God for His creation. This is what was said to Isaac in Genesis 26, beginning in verse 1:

[1] And there was a famine in the land, beside the first famine that was in the days of Abraham. And Isaac went unto Abimelech king of the Philistines unto Gerar.

[2] And Yahweh appeared unto him, and said, Go not down into Egypt; dwell in the land which I shall tell thee of:

[3] Sojourn in this land, and I will be with thee, and will bless thee; for unto thee, and unto thy seed, I will give all these countries, and I will perform the oath which I swore unto Abraham thy father;

[4] And I will make thy seed to multiply as the stars of heaven, and will give unto thy seed all these countries; and in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed;

[5] Because that Abraham obeyed my voice, and kept my charge, my commandments, my statutes, and my laws.

Now again, as I have said in the past, it is extremely important that you have your Bibles open - not just listening to what I'm saying - by reading the text - so that you can see these words for yourself. Yes, faith cometh by hearing, I get that - but seeing these words while you are hearing them will help them to get seered into your heart. Take a mental picture of what these words look like on the pages of your own Bibles - so that they will be as frontlets between your eyes - bind them into your brains so that you cannot get them out of your mind. That's how important they are. If you just can't follow along - maybe because you are traveling - then as soon as you can - go back and see these passages for yourself.

Why did Yahweh make these promises to Abraham? Because he obeyed His voice, he kept His charge - he guarded the words of Yahweh like a sentry would guard his post - he kept God's Commandments, kept God's Statutes and kept God's Laws.

Now, look where we are today. The "churchmen" - who are almost exclusively ALL 501(c)(3) government corporations - just like the liquor stores, the porno houses, the abortion clinics, the Southern Poverty Law Center, the Satanic Churches of America - on and on we go - these "churchmen" tell us that today - God's Commandments, God's Statutes, God's Laws and Judgements - have all been done away with. They are not for today.

And, again, I've said this a thousand times, at least, if God's Laws, Commandments, Statutes and Judgements have been done away with - what is left? Man's laws, man's statues, man's judgements - those are what is left. And this is why the "churchmen" preach that God Himself - through a twisted perversion of Romans 13, I Peter 2, Luke 20 have tried to convince people that God Himself has decreed that His Laws, Commandments, Statutes and Judgements are null and void - and men now are to obey whatever so-called government they may be surrounded by when they are born.

These same "churchmen" have developed a theology that has no foundation in Scripture that Jesus/Yeshua can be taken as Saviour but left as Lord. They've developed

a theology that came about by adding to the Word and taking away from the Word to convince people that the Kingdom of God is in the future - and further that in the future it is limited to a certain amount of time. They've created an evolved teaching that they have erroneously called "the Gospel" and today I ask you - again - what has this teaching produced? What is the fruit that we are seeing today?

I know we have people listening from Canada and as far away as China. But today, I'm asking you that are hearing my voice in America today - what is the fruit of this false gospel? What type of civilization do we have in America today?

There are reportedly nearly 400,000 of these so-called "churches" in America today. There are supposed Christian television networks that broadcast 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Billions of dollars are spent each year on the so-called "preaching of the gospel" and what has been the result?

I try to be as kind as I possibly can when speaking with people. But I'll say this today. Anyone that would dare say that "all is well in America today" is a pure idiot.

The so-called gospel that I was exposed to since the early 1960s is a powerless gospel that has not only NOT changed society towards the righteousness established by Christ - but it has enabled and empowered the proliferation of evil in a very short period of time.

Yet again, this week in America, if we can believe the narrative - and I strongly emphasize the "IF" word here - we've already heard from the current secretary of state of the U.S. who said the American experiment is based on lying, cheating and stealing - to which he received tremendous applause and laughter - so - IF we can believe the narrative - another school shooting took place this past week. The two nut-jobs that supposedly carried out the shootings - one of them was supposed to be 18 - so they paraded him on television - with his long, scraggly purple hair - and then the other one they called a girl - which then we find out is in the process of "transgendering into a boy" - good grief people - can't we see the fruit that has been produced?

Why are these kids doing these things every single week in America? They are products of their education. This education includes the teaching that the Laws of God have been done away with. This education includes the teaching that the Kingdom of God is not for today. Combine this with the education that creation came about as a result of the big bang and evolution - and now - there is no God - there is no morality - other than that which is determined by the people and their government and this is the fruit that

is produced.

Look with me please to Proverbs chapter 16. And let's begin reading in verse 1.

[1] The preparations of the heart in man, and the answer of the tongue, is from Yahweh.

[2] All the ways of a man are clean in his own eyes; but Yahweh weigheth the spirits.

On what scale does Yahweh weigh the spirits? The scale is His perfect Will. He weighs the spirits of men based on what He has provided in His Word - as to how men are to live. How we live is the same as "our ways."

[3] Commit thy works unto Yahweh, and thy thoughts shall be established.

[4] Yahweh hath made all things for himself: yea, even the wicked for the day of evil.

While we are gathering insight into His perfect Will for His creation - we also see other guiding principles as well. Verse 4 is one of those things. I'm not going to spend a lot of time here - but in this verse you see predestination in the Old Covenant world. Yahweh appointed some for good and some for evil in the Old Covenant world. This was a necessity in order to bring creation to the exact time period of the revealing of the King and His eternal Kingdom.

However, this is not so in the New Covenant world. All men have a choice in the New Covenant world. All men are called to repentance. All men are called to bow the knee to King Jesus - and God is not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance. The New Covenant World is a whosoever will proposition. I believe this is how we see predestination and whosoever will in the Scriptures. One was for the Old Covenant World and the other is for the New Covenant world. In the New Covenant World - man has no excuses not bowing the knee to the King. You can't say that a man lives the way he lives or does what he does - because God has ordained it to be so and the man has no choice.

I guess I better go a little further here. I'm not at all talking about works for salvation. For by grace are you saved through faith - and that not of yourselves - it is the gift of God - lest any man should be boast. What I am saying is that God has made the gift of His Son King and His Kingdom - available for anyone who will by faith - embrace this King and embrace His Kingdom and make a conscious choice to walk in it. I don't know how anyone could argue against this from the Scriptures. Verse 5. Proverbs 16.

[5] Every one that is proud in heart is an abomination to Yahweh: though hand join in hand, he shall not be unpunished.

[6] By mercy and truth iniquity is purged: and by the fear of Yahweh men depart from evil.

[7] When a man's ways please Yahweh, he maketh even his enemies to be at peace with him.

[8] Better is a little with righteousness than great revenues without right.

[9] A man's heart deviseth his way: but Yahweh directeth his steps.

[10] A divine sentence is in the lips of the king: his mouth transgresseth not in judgment.

[11] A just weight and balance are Yahweh's: all the weights of the bag are his work.

[12] It is an abomination to kings to commit wickedness: for the throne is established by righteousness.

Remember, again, now, we are learning the Perfect Will of God for creation - and we are learning it from the things He revealed in the Old Covenant World. In the Old Covenant world, He allowed earthly kings. Even still, he expected Godliness and Righteousness from those earthly kings. They were not capable of keeping this forever, so there would be a need for a King to come - who could. And that King is Yeshua.

[13] Righteous lips are the delight of kings; and they love him that speaketh right.

[14] The wrath of a king is as messengers of death: but a wise man will pacify it.

[15] In the light of the king's countenance is life; and his favour is as a cloud of the latter rain.

[16] How much better is it to get wisdom than gold! and to get understanding rather to be chosen than silver!

[17] The highway of the upright is to depart from evil: he that keepeth his way preserveth his soul.

[18] Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall.

[19] Better it is to be of an humble spirit with the lowly, than to divide the spoil with the proud.

[20] He that handleth a matter wisely shall find good: and whoso trusteth in Yahweh, happy is he.

[21] The wise in heart shall be called prudent: and the sweetness of the lips increaseth learning.

[22] Understanding is a wellspring of life unto him that hath it: but the instruction of fools is folly.

[23] The heart of the wise teacheth his mouth, and addeth learning to his lips.

[24] Pleasant words are as an honeycomb, sweet to the soul, and health to the bones.

[25] There is a way that seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the

ways of death.

America has developed theologies that are not based on the Perfect Will of God. America has created a government that is not based on the Laws, Commandments, Statutes and Judgements of God. The United States of America was built on OUR CONStitution and OUR laws, and OUR treaties, and OUR agreements - shall be the supreme law of the land. And their laws have created "churchmen corporations" who lead people to believe that this is all good and it is all ordained of God - and the way that they have decided seems right - has come to the end thereof are the ways of death.

This is the fruit of the so-called "gospel" that we have called "good." This is the fruit of the so-called government that we have built and have called it "good."

What we are seeing around us today should be seen as signs of judgement and the result of we as a people rejecting the Commands of God so that we may keep our own traditions - but instead - the twisted theology from the "corporate churchmen" have coined another ungodly, Scripturally baseless phrase - called "signs of the times." As in God has ordained all these evil things to be occurring - because it is the fulfillment of Bible prophecy - and instead of believing the true gospel - which is the Kingdom of Christ - we are to just sit back and watch the show and wait for Jesus to come back to this earth, riding on a white horse - and He will fight all the enemies - that we have allowed to become great in the land and throughout the world because we have not done our part in standing for the King and His Kingdom.

The other day I was watching a video on Youtube and there was a man that I'll refer to as a "freedom fighter." There are people out there who are not sitting idly by while the governments of men oppress and enslave people. Even though most of these "freedom fighters" are not fighting in the name of Christ - I still am glad to see any attempts that a man tries to stand against oppression. But anyway, the "freedom fighter" and his interviewer were lamenting the fact - as they said - "Christians" were some of their biggest opponents in their fight against oppression.

The issue here was that this "freedom fighter" had exposed corruption in the local sheriff's department. I mean, he had this on video. He had eye-witnesses. It was open and shut. He said that his own Dad - who was as he said "a Christian" was opposing him because he was exposing the corruption in the local sheriff's office.

This is a hot button for me and I get frustrated hearing these "freedom fighters" say

things like this because the truth is - a true Christian would never oppose the bringing corruption and oppression out into the open so that it could be brought to judgement and to an end. A true Christian would never want to see oppression and corruption just swept under the rug and allowed to continue.

These people are wrongly associating "churchianity" with Christianity. Christianity is not "churchianity." Jesus Christ and His disciples would be thrown out of the "churches" in America today - it would be the "churchmen" who would conspire with the governments - to crucify Christ again - if He were here preaching today what He preached over 2,000 years ago.

We live in a society - that is just like the one Jesus lived in - not because God has ordained it to be so - not because WE are fulfilling Bible prophecy - which would mean that we have no control at all over what is taking place - but it's because we have developed a scheme of theology - and a scheme of government - that in our eyes is right - but in reality - it is all rebellion to the King and His Kingdom - and because we have refused to learn the Perfect Will of God for His creation - which is His Laws and Judgements, His Commandments, His Statutes - we would kill the very Son of God and think that we are doing God's Will in doing it.

We have a society today that is bearing the fruit of rebellion - and it's not God's fault - nor is it God ordained - nor is it the plan of God or the Will of God - it's the way it is because we will not yield to the present day reality of the King and His Kingdom.

We have fallen for a false gospel. We have fallen for another Jesus. Almost all of America today believes that the "church" is synonymous with God - and they want nothing whatsoever to do with it. And sadly, they are correct.

Last week, I made the statement that the Gospel is not the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus - and I will say it again. The death, burial and resurrection of Jesus/Yeshua are essential elements of the Gospel - but - if that is all there is to what a man believes is the Gospel - then he has never heard the true Gospel preached by the Christ, or by His disciples.

Turn with me please to Mark 1. We will begin in verse 1. We are also still talking about Daniel 9:24, as well. Verse 1.

[1] The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God;

Please remember our earlier messages concerning His name. His last name, as we understand names, is not Christ. Christ is what He is. He is the Messiah. The Messiah is the Redeemer, the Restorer, the King. We found the Messiah. We found Him of Whom Moses and the prophets did write, Jesus, the King of Israel. The Gospel is the Good News that Jesus, the Christ, the Son of God, the King - has come. Verse 2.

[2] As it is written in the prophets, Behold, I send my messenger before thy face, which shall prepare thy way before thee.

[3] The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight.

[4] John did baptize in the wilderness, and preach the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins.

[5] And there went out unto him all the land of Judaea, and they of Jerusalem, and were all baptized of him in the river of Jordan, confessing their sins.

[6] And John was clothed with camel's hair, and with a girdle of a skin about his loins; and he did eat locusts and wild honey;

[7] And preached, saying, There cometh one mightier than I after me, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to stoop down and unloose.

[8] I indeed have baptized you with water: but he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost.

[9] And it came to pass in those days, that Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee, and was baptized of John in Jordan.

[10] And straightway coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens opened, and the Spirit like a dove descending upon him:

[11] And there came a voice from heaven, saying, Thou art my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

Let's not just read the passage and not understand the great significance here. The heavens opened. The voice of God was heard. Think about this. Put yourself in the shoes of those who were eyewitnesses to this. The heavens opened - the voice of God was heard. Up until that time - God had only spoken with an audible voice from heaven a few times. This is a fascinating event that people were witnessing. Verse 12.

[12] And immediately the Spirit driveth him into the wilderness.

[13] And he was there in the wilderness forty days, tempted of Satan; and was with the wild beasts; and the angels ministered unto him.

Now, please watch this closely. A man does not have to spend 4 years in Bible college and two years in seminary to learn from the Scriptures - from God's Word - what the Gospel is. Verse 14.

[14] Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God,

[15] And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel.

What time is He talking about? He is talking about Daniel 9:24. Daniel 9 is the passage where God laid out the time table. Seventy weeks are determined. The final aspect of Daniel 9:24 - to anoint the Most Holy - that time was there.

Jesus came into Galilee preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God. Friends, the Gospel is the Good News that God had brought to Israel the Redeemer, the Restorer, the Saviour and the King. Everything was fulfilled - the time is fulfilled - there's nothing left from the prophecies to be fulfilled - from Moses - through the prophets - it's all fulfilled - and the Kingdom is right here at the doorsteps.

In Daniel's day, the Kingdom was 490 years away. But at that day - the 490 years had been fulfilled - and the Kingdom was standing right there on the doorstep - and the King was in their midst. The heavens had opened, and the voice of God had proclaimed it.

No where in this passage of Scripture - that so very clearly defines the Gospel - is the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus discussed. The death, burial and resurrection of Jesus were absolutely essential elements of the Gospel and the plan of redemption - but if that is what a man thinks is the full gospel - then that man has never heard the Gospel.

The Gospel is that the Kingdom of God was at hand - over 2,000 years ago - and that it IS in full implementation today - and it is the responsibility - the requirement - of every living, breathing creature to conform to His Kingdom - right now.

The days where God allowed the nations - and the nation of Israel - to walk after their own ways - with their own kings - or their own republics or their own democracies - those days are over. The only system of Government that is Ordained of God to be in place in the New Covenant is a system of Godly Judges - Romans 13 calls them the ministers of God - as those men "rule" - they measure the actions of the people according to the Laws of God - period.

They can't make up their own laws. If they do, God calls them statues. For God's people - this must be the standard - Isaiah 33:22

[22] For Yahweh is our judge, Yahweh is our lawgiver, Yahweh is our king; he will save us.

See the New Covenant World very clearly in this passage. Yahweh is Judge. Yahweh is Lawgiver. Yahweh is King. LAST - Yahweh is Saviour. He's not Saviour - if He is not Judge, Lawgiver and King.

Those that preach Him as Saviour and not King - are not preaching the Gospel. They are preaching another gospel and another Jesus.

James 4:12

[12] There is one lawgiver, who is able to save and to destroy: who art thou that judgest another?

I Timothy 6:12-16

[12] Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses.

[13] I give thee charge in the sight of God, who quickeneth all things, and before Christ Jesus, who before Pontius Pilate witnessed a good confession;

[14] That thou keep this commandment without spot, unrebukeable, until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ:

By now, you know that I can't read a verse like this without stopping. Paul was writing to Timothy over 2,000 years ago. Timothy was reading this letter over 2,000 years ago. Paul told Timothy to keep this commandment until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ. That's because Timothy and those who were still alive at AD70 would witness the appearing of the Lord Jesus Christ. Then WE which ARE ALIVE AND REMAIN - unto the coming of the Lord - that was said to those Christians over 2,000 years ago.

He came - just like He said He would. Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass, till ALL ALL ALL these things be fulfilled. One of the "all these things" was distinctly -

[27] For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.

[28] For wheresoever the carcase is, there will the eagles be gathered together.

[29] Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken:

[30] And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

[31] And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

[32] Now learn a parable of the fig tree; When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer is nigh:

[33] So likewise ye, when ye shall see all these things, know that it is near, even at the doors.

[34] Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled.

Listen, He came back exactly the way He said He would. And because He came back - exactly the way and the time He said He would - I Timothy 6:15 is the result. This is what happened when He returned.

[15] Which in his times he shall shew, who is the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings, and Lord of lords;

[16] Who only hath immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom be honour and power everlasting. Amen.

Today - Jesus Christ - has been King of kings and Lord of lords for over 2,000 years now - and when communities - such as the New Haven Colony in the early 1600s on American soil - when they commit themselves to the King and His Kingdom the blessings of God will be so great - they will last well beyond even the lives of those who lived it - but when the children grow and leave the God of their fathers - those blessings will turn to cursings and their ends will once again be death and destruction.

So what do we do? Well, the first thing we need to do is to understand what we have done. We have followed a false gospel. We have fallen for deceivers such as C.I. Scofield who taught that the Gospel of the Kingdom is not for today. We have fallen for deceivers who have taught that a people can be the "Chosen People of God" - yet reject His Son.

We need to understand that those who claim that Jesus Christ came in the flesh have been given a Kingdom. We have been given a nation. We are supposed to be the people of God - called out of the false kingdoms of the world - and into the Kingdom of God - into the Government of God. We have citizenship. Ephesians 2 tells us the name of our citizenship. It is the Commonwealth of Israel. That name has a Godly heritage that goes all the way back to Abraham who obeyed the Commandments and Judgements and Laws and Statutes of God.

We need to understand that just as Moses refused to be called an Egyptian citizen - we should refuse to be called citizens of any nation not called the Commonwealth of Israel.

Look with me to Hebrews chapter 11 and we'll begin in verse 23.

23] By faith Moses, when he was born, was hid three months of his parents, because they saw he was a proper child; and they were not afraid of the king's commandment.

Look at the principle found here - and that principle was from the Old Covenant World, too. Moses, one of the great founders of the faith, his parents were not afraid of the king's commandment. They would not have been welcome in - I'd dare say - any of the modern government corporate "churches" in America. In the modern government corporation "church" in America they would have been taught to obey the quote unquote "king's commandment" no matter what - because God commands His people to "render unto Caesar" no matter the demand.

[24] By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter;

What does that mean? If Moses allowed himself to be called Pharaoh's daughter, he would have been considered an Egyptian citizen. But instead...

[25] Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season;

[26] Esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt: for he had respect unto the recompence of the reward.

Being an American citizen can mean great monetary wealth. By knowing how to manipulate the U.S. economic system, a man can become very wealthy. But Moses, one of those that we should look at as an example, thought it greater to identify as a citizen of the Kingdom of Christ - rather than a citizen of Egypt.

[27] By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king: for he endured, as seeing him who is invisible.

Once again, Moses led by example what it means to be a follower of Christ. Not fearing the wrath of the king, he followed after Christ - looking for the Great King Who was to come.

There are no God ordained earthly kings in this world today. During the time of Moses, the king of Egypt was ordained of God. He was purposely put there by God and it was

necessary to show us His Perfect Will for His people. Though there are no God ordained earthly kings today - the principle we learn from the life of Moses is applicable.

This world is full of men who call themselves kings. This world is full of men who call themselves judges and lawmakers and presidents. But they are not operating with the Lawful Authority of the God of heaven. They are in place because they have the biggest guns, the most spending power or both.

The command to come out from among them and be separate so that we can be the people of God is what we are supposed to be doing. And the examples have been shown that we should not be coming out with fear. Moses didn't fear. The principle is the same today.

These are the things we need to be talking about. The American Experiment of lying, cheating and stealing that Mike Pompeo is so proud of - is not working. It may be working for some people. I guess certain criminal elements that get rich and thrive off it - it's working for them - but for the people who are being oppressed, and being killed, and having what little property they have seized and taken away from them - it's not working for them.

The gospel that demands that people obey the powers of darkness in the world is a gospel that only benefits the powers of darkness. We see all around us the fruit produced from the powers of darkness and our hope - which is a false hope that Jesus will come back some day and set it all straight - is false. It's not going to happen.

In Acts 28:20, Paul said this:

[20] For this cause therefore have I called for you, to see you, and to speak with you: because that for the hope of Israel I am bound with this chain.

Paul said that because of the hope of Israel - he was bound with a chain. And in verses 30 and 31 he tells exactly what that hope is:

[30] And Paul dwelt two whole years in his own hired house, and received all that came in unto him,

[31] Preaching the kingdom of God, and teaching those things which concern the Lord Jesus Christ, with all confidence, no man forbidding him.

I'm not going to tell you that preaching and living the hope of the Gospel, the Kingdom of God, is not going to come without persecution. We've allowed evil to proliferate for so long - in the beginning stages of returning to the Kingdom and Kingship of Christ - it is probably going to be painful. But each day we wait. Each week that goes by. It is

going to be harder and harder for those who are trying to obey the King. And again, it's not God's fault. It's our fault.

Go back with me to Hebrews chapter 10. I don't like to try to scare people into the Kingdom of God. The "churchmen" have devoted great effort into trying to scare people into submitting to their false theology. I've always tried as much as I can to show people the Kingdom of God because it's the right thing to do. Lately, though, I have tried to appeal to people in saying things like, "Look around you in America. See the death and destruction and the proliferation of evil..." and appeal to them to Come out from all that into the Kingdom of God. Maybe I should have been doing more of that through the years - but I haven't done a lot of it in the past because I want people to willingly, lovingly Come into the Kingdom because it's the best way.

But there is a passage of Scripture that we cannot ignore. And I believe it has great application today. And, if by the fear of this passage, it will bring men to the understanding of their need to embrace the Kingdom of God - then so be it.

Hebrews 10: verse 22.

[22] Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.

[23] Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;)

[24] And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:

[25] Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

Now, let's stop here a second. "Churchianity" teaches this as going to "church." Nothing could be further from the truth. "Assembling of ourselves together" is a totally political phrase. This means being assembled as a Government - as a called out Christian community of believers who agree to be Governed by King Yeshua and His Kingdom exclusive of all others. Governed according to the Laws, Judgements, Commandments and Statutes of Yahweh. That's what this means. It is not talking about "going to church." "Assembly" means Government.

I would refer you again to my website. At the bottom of the Home page, you will find a link to the New Haven Colony Covenant. There you will see exactly what is meant by this "Assembling." It is a group of true Christians who came together to build a community and their Lawbook was the Bible and their King was Jesus, and they chose Godly judges to "rule" - to measure the actions of the people - according to the Laws of God. They plainly said that the Bible was the only thing needed with which they would be Governed.

Back to Hebrews 10 verse 26.

- [26] For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins,
[27] But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries.
[28] He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses:
[29] Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?
[30] For we know him that hath said, Vengeance belongeth unto me, I will recompense, saith the Lord. And again, The Lord shall judge his people.
[31] It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God.

As of AD70, the people were given the full implementation of the Kingdom of God and of His Son, the King. It is worse in the New Covenant to set up kings like all the other nations than it was in the Old Covenant World.

To think that we can continue on with the status quo and not know that things are going to continue to get worse and worse and worse - is just beyond me.

A friend of mine told me this past week that even some of the Baptists are beginning to rethink some of their end-times theology. I've heard some - not much - but some of them begin to backtrack and say things like, "Well, we must have had our calculations off somewhere." Well, yeah, by about 2,000 years. But they are beginning to back off on some of their rapture, end of the world emphasis because the truth is, folks, if it was going to happen, it should have happened by 1988. And here we are 31 years later - and people are beginning to question things a little.

The good news that the Kingdom of Christ is already available is ripe for teaching. People are seeing that what was supposed to be working - isn't working. The naivety that people in quote unquote government - who are just openly showing themselves to be the snakes they are - the naivety that these people are ordained of God - is wearing thin. The naivety of the rapture doctrine is wearing thin.

Referring to these people as "the powers that be" has to stop. Letting people think that the knowledge of God is found in the 501(c)(3) government corporate quote unquote "church" has got to stop. Letting people think that the gospel is summed up as the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus - has got to stop.

Repentance is needed - absolutely. But we must be telling them what they need to repent of. This is where it has to begin.

Again, I'm amazed at how clear - cut - the Words of the Bible are - as we began in Mark 1 today -

Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God,
[15] And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel.

And then, we will allow "preachers" so-called - to develop theologies that require conclusions that 1) Force the Kingdom of God into the future, or 2) Insist on some type of "spiritual kingdom today" and "physical kingdom later" - when there's just no Biblical foundation or justification for these teachings.

People have the idea that in order for the Kingdom of God to be in full force today - Jesus has to be here on this earth ruling from a physical throne in Jerusalem. Would you think about this for a minute? People all across the United States - and you can just go ahead and insert the name of any earthly government here - but people all across the world - for the most part - have never been in the same room with one of their presidents or one of their kings. They've probably never spoken face to face with one of their quote unquote "lawmakers." But they obey them.

Why is it that people who claim to be followers of Christ believe that only if Christ was physically walking on this earth today - would there be a requirement to obey His Kingdom? Why is His Kingdom not real because He does not have a physical, bodily presence here?

How could the plain, simple words of Christ from Mark 1, be so twisted that men have no problem seeing the phrase - at hand - or the time is fulfilled - and then just as easy as can be - say that there should be thousands of years inserted?

I have documented in my books that the modern front runner in this theology was C.I. Scofield. I have shown from his own writings how he manipulated Scripture and played slight of hand tricks by saying that Greek words were one word - then he slips in an entirely different meaning substituting an entirely different Greek word.

I have documented his relationship with the Zionists of his day. His books were

published at Oxford University where the Rhodes Scholarship program was implemented. And this is not just a coincidence and the two are forever joined at the hip.

In my years of ministry, I've had a lot - and I mean a lot - of futurists who have told me that they did not get their doctrines from Scofield. And as hard as I try to maintain composure and respect, I just kind of chuckle because the things they tell me they believe are exactly what Scofield taught. They deny Scofield - but teach the exact same things he taught.

Take for instance Revelation 12. These are Scofield's notes - word for word.

"The Dispensation of the Kingdom (2 Samuel 7.16) begins with the return of Christ to the earth, runs through the "thousand years" of His earth-rule, and ends when He has delivered up the kingdom to the Father."

Ok. Dispensation of the Kingdom. And he specifically references 2 Samuel 7.16. I have gone to a lot of effort to discuss 2 Samuel 7.16.

[16] And thine house and thy kingdom shall be established for ever before thee: thy throne shall be established for ever. Verse 12,

[12] And when thy days be fulfilled, and thou shalt sleep with thy fathers, I will set up thy seed after thee, which shall proceed out of thy bowels, and I will establish his kingdom.

[13] He shall build an house for my name, and I will stablish the throne of his kingdom for ever.

[14] I will be his father, and he shall be my son. If he commit iniquity, I will chasten him with the rod of men, and with the stripes of the children of men:

[15] But my mercy shall not depart away from him, as I took it from Saul, whom I put away before thee.

[16] And thine house and thy kingdom shall be established for ever before thee: thy throne shall be established for ever.

Scofield and all preachers that I know, call this the Davidic Covenant. Scofield and all modern preachers that I know of - say the Davidic Covenant is yet to be fulfilled in the future.

But I have shown how that Acts 2 makes it as clear as anything found in the Scripture that what was meant by this promise to David from 2 Samuel 7 was fulfilled in the

resurrection of Christ.

Men and brethren, let me freely speak unto you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his sepulchre is with us unto this day.

[30] Therefore being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him, that of the fruit of his loins, according to the flesh, he would raise up Christ to sit on his throne;

[31] He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see corruption.

Scotfield knew Acts 2 was in the Bible before he started this false belief that the Davidic Covenant has not been fulfilled.

Even if a man had not considered the fact that the Gospel is "Repent for the Kingdom of heaven is at hand..." I would dare say that if I asked 100 people sitting in a quote unquote "church" how many gospels are there? I'd get an emphatic 1. There's only 1 gospel. Even when they don't know what it is - they'll still say 1. And to that, I wholeheartedly agree.

But what does Scotfield say? In his notes on Revelation 14, he says this:

Gospel. This great theme may be summarized as follows:

In itself the word Gospel means good news. And of course, I agree.

But listen to this:

Four *forms* of the Gospel are to be distinguished.

Really? There are four forms of the Gospel? That's what he says. Here's the first form of the Gospel according to Scotfield.

(1) The Gospel of the Kingdom.

Great! He got it. Oh, but wait. Here's his explanation. This is the good news that God purposes to set up on the earth, in fulfillment of the Davidic Covenant (2 Samuel 7.16) a kingdom, political, spiritual, Israelitish, universal, over which God's Son, David's heir, shall be King, and which shall be, for one thousand years, the manifestation of the righteousness of God in human affairs.

Oh wow. Now, I don't have time to get into today, I go into greater detail in the books

on my website - of which I have told you before - I was arrested because of those books. But Scofield does not mean Israelitish as in Abrahamic - he means Israeli - as in Zionism. This is where the whole concept of Jews as God's chosen people and Jesus ruling the world from Jerusalem - this is where this all comes from.

Now, the one thing he got right - though he completely obliterates any truth by saying there are four forms of the gospel - but the tiny little part that he got right concerning the Gospel is the Gospel of the Kingdom - watch what he does next.

I want you to remind that Paul said the hope of Israel was the preaching of the Kingdom of God. I am telling you that the only hope for America and beyond is the Good News of the Gospel of the Kingdom - look what Scofield does with this.

Two preachings of this Gospel are mentioned, one past, beginning with the ministry of John the Baptist, continued by our Lord and His disciples, and ending with the Jewish rejection of the King.

Ok. Now hold on. You aren't going to believe what's next.

The other (preaching of the Gospel of the Kingdom) is yet future (Matthew 24:14) during the great tribulation, and immediately preceding the coming of the King in glory.

In other words, the only hope that we have - the present day reality of the Gospel of the Kingdom of God - he says - because of his twisted theology - the Gospel that is capable of changing men's lives, turning the world upside down - that Gospel is not for today but is only for the future. This is what futurism gives you, friends. This is what the despicable lie of the future kingdom gives you. It leaves you totally without hope.

If a man believes in a future kingdom - he is totally without hope because the Bible does not teach a future kingdom. There are not four forms of the Gospel. There is one Gospel and it is Repent for the Kingdom of heaven is at hand. It is, For these be the days of vengeance when all things which are written are fulfilled.

We must expose these despicable, antichrist teachings of futurism. This is not just an agree to disagree approach because what you believe about "eschatology" doesn't really matter. Futurism is an all-out attack on the true Gospel preached by John the Baptist, continued by our Lord and His disciples and preached by every true follower of Christ that has been tortured at the hands of the state delivered by the quote unquote

"churches" throughout history.

When we begin speaking the truths of the present-day reality of the Kingdom of God - we must have the same faith that Paul delivered to Timothy that He will keep His promises to those that obey Him.

For those who already know about and understand the present-day reality of the Kingdom of God....Ok. It's time to start living it. For those who are just now hearing it - a challenge is made to search these Scriptures whether these things be so - and if so - we must begin to obey the Word of God. When we obey the Word of God - I believe that God will once again turn the world upside down.

Lord willing, we will go back to Daniel 9:24 next week to discuss the final 2 aspects of the the 70 weeks - bring in everlasting righteousness and to anoint the most Holy.
