

Daniel 9:24 - To bring in everlasting righteousness

For the last 35 years and now on the Missouri Liberty Radio for almost a year now, I've been dealing with one main passage of Scripture - and as you all well now - it has been Matthew 24. From there, we've have looked at hundreds of passages of Scripture confirming the simple words of Christ - "Verily I say unto you," and that was Jesus to His disciples - over 2,000 years ago - "This generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled." This is for the purpose of explaining that because ALL Bible Prophecy has been fulfilled - the Kingdom of God - in all its fulness - is a present day reality and has been for over 2,000 years.

It's simple. It's not hard to understand. When we believe the plain words of Christ - to His disciples over 2,000 years ago - things that were never intended to be mysteries for very long - start to become clear as we shake off the lies and deceptions of those that for centuries have declared war on the Kingdom of Christ have twisted the Words of the prophets, John the Baptist, Christ, and His disciples into things they never were intended to mean.

For instance, Romans 13 and I Peter 2 - were never meant to refer to anything other than the Kingdom of God. When a man believes the Words of Christ - "These be the days of vengeance when all things which are written are fulfilled" Luke 21:22 - and that "these be the days" meant - as clearly as He could have said them - the days in which He was living - the people, the place and the time - then it is not just reasonable to believe - but it is undeniable to believe that the "ministers of God" in Romans 13 - are actually the "ministers of God" and their fruit proves it.

The "ministers of God" are not liars, cheaters, and thieves. The "ministers of God" do not call themselves "lawmakers" then go out and create statues - men's quote unquote "laws" that oppose the Laws of God. The "ministers of God" do not operate outside the authority of the Bible. The Bible does not give anyone the "power" to do things contrary to the Scripture. The Word of God applies to all of God's creation. He created it - He owns it all - and He does not authorize anyone to live contrary to His Word.

Liars, cheaters, thieves, oppressors, taxers of labour, inventors of quote unquote retirement schemes that oppose the Laws of God, promoters of sodomy, those who praise evil and punish good - those are NOT the "ministers of God." Think, think, think. Those who do those things are NOT the "ministers of God." They are the powers of darkness. Their fruit plainly declares it.

Where in the world we ever got the idea that God demands obedience to the powers of darkness is just crazy.

I Peter 2 - when a man understands the Words of Christ - Repent for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand - I Peter 2 is now clearly referring to Christ as the King.

But when a man refuses to yield to the simple words of John the Baptist' earthly father - as found in Luke 1 - then it is then he will come up with all sorts of crazy, wild, theologies that have no basis from God's Word whatsoever. We've talked about them before.

Concepts such as - a certain race of people can be God's Chosen People - yet deny His Son. Folks, that's just laughable.

I John 4

Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.

[2] Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God:

You cannot say that someone who does not confess that Jesus the Christ, the Messiah is come in the flesh is of God. They are not God's Chosen People if they have not confessed that Jesus the Christ already came.

[3] And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.

II John 2

For many deceivers are entered into the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an antichrist.

[8] Look to yourselves, that we lose not those things which we have wrought, but that we receive a full reward.

[9] Whosoever transgresseth, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God. He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son.

[10] If there come any unto you, and bring not this doctrine, receive him not into

your house, neither bid him God speed:

[11] For he that biddeth him God speed is partaker of his evil deeds.

I don't care who you are. I don't care how many people listen to you, how much money people donate to your cause, how many letters are behind your name - if you say that people who have rejected Jesus as the Christ - if you say they are the Chosen People of God - then you are an antichrist, God does not dwell in you - and you are evil.

Harsh words? I didn't write them. If a man doesn't like this, he's got a problem with God. He is the One Who wrote these passages.

This is what happens when we take the Words of Christ and John the Baptist and the apostles and we say that "This is that" from Acts 2 doesn't mean "this is that" and "This generation" wasn't really "that generation" and "we which are alive and remain" didn't apply to the people it was said to - or "There be some standing here which shall not taste of death, till they see the Son of man coming in His Kingdom" - that didn't apply to the people Jesus said it to - men will take their false doctrines and twist the Scriptures in order to make them fit.

For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ.

[14] And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.

[15] Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.

Every single thing that was ever written in the Scriptures was for the sole purpose of God bringing an end to the Old Covenant system - which brought us - among other things - because of man's hatred of God - the concept that "we can rule ourselves like all the other nations and we can have kings like all the nations that forsook God."

The Old Covenant World had a time period established in it. It was not going to last forever. At the end of the Old Covenant World - a New World - a New Heavens and a New Earth were going to be created. They would be created in the days - the very same days where Yahweh sent His Son to redeem Israel, to forgive their sins and their iniquities - to put an end to the times where God allowed the nations to walk in their own ways (Acts 14:16) - to crown His Son as King of kings and Lord of lords in fulfillment of the promise He made to David in II Samuel 7.

I am still amazed that somehow we have the idea that the times in which we live now -

are more important than the first century. God has not sent His Son to walk physically on this earth right now - to heal the sick, raise the dead, give sight to the blind, walk on the water, feed 5,000 men with 2 fish and 5 loaves of bread, to cast out devils, to put an end to hundreds of years of sacrificing of animals, to fulfill all the prophecies from Moses through Malachi. God did not send John the Baptist in 2019 to

go before Him in the spirit and power of Elias, to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord.

There's not a virgin named Mary running around here today to whom the angel said

Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favour with God.

[31] And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS.

[32] He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David:

[33] And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end.

John the Baptist' mother is not here today saying

Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb.

[43] And whence is this to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me?

[44] For, lo, as soon as the voice of thy salutation sounded in mine ears, the babe leaped in my womb for joy.

[45] And blessed is she that believed: for there shall be a performance of those things which were told her from the Lord.

And Mary isn't here saying

My soul doth magnify the Lord,

[47] And my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Saviour.

[48] For he hath regarded the low estate of his handmaiden: for, behold, from henceforth all generations shall call me blessed.

[49] For he that is mighty hath done to me great things; and holy is his name.

[50] And his mercy is on them that fear him from generation to generation.

[51] He hath shewed strength with his arm; he hath scattered the proud in the imagination of their hearts.

[52] He hath put down the mighty from their seats, and exalted them of low degree.

[53] He hath filled the hungry with good things; and the rich he hath sent empty away.

[54] He hath holpen his servant Israel, in remembrance of his mercy;

[55] As he spake to our fathers, to Abraham, and to his seed for ever.

Zacharias is not here today to preach this about his son, John

And his father Zacharias was filled with the Holy Ghost, and prophesied, saying,

[68] Blessed be the Lord God of Israel; for he hath visited and redeemed his people,

[69] And hath raised up an horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David;

[70] As he spake by the mouth of his holy prophets, which have been since the world began:

[71] That we should be saved from our enemies, and from the hand of all that hate us;

[72] To perform the mercy promised to our fathers, and to remember his holy covenant;

[73] The oath which he sware to our father Abraham,

[74] That he would grant unto us, that we being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve him without fear,

[75] In holiness and righteousness before him, all the days of our life.

[76] And thou, child, shalt be called the prophet of the Highest: for thou shalt go before the face of the Lord to prepare his ways;

[77] To give knowledge of salvation unto his people by the remission of their sins,

[78] Through the tender mercy of our God; whereby the dayspring from on high hath visited us,

[79] To give light to them that sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace.

[80] And the child grew, and waxed strong in spirit, and was in the deserts till the day of his shewing unto Israel.

The first century was 1,000 times more important than any other time period in the history of mankind - from that time and forever - there will never be a more defining period for mankind. That time period was so magnificent that it's ending is described by such dramatic language as the passing of the heavens and the earth, the elements melting with a fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be

burned up.

When the Old Covenant world then - over 2,000 years passed away - the New Covenant World was then established and at that time - every single thing that mankind had taken or robbed from their Creator was all taken back by His Son and given to the Father. Gone were the days where God allowed them to have kings like all the other nations.

Revelation 11:15 proclaims the fulfillment of the words of the angel to Mary at the announcement that the King was coming.

And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying,
The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his
Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.

The words to Mary were

He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God
shall give unto him the throne of his father David:
[33] And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there
shall be no end.

And those words were spoken in the first century and were fulfilled in the first century. The first century advent of Jesus the Christ brought a complete end to hundreds of years of things being done a certain way in order to usher in a new way of doing things - that being that every knee bow and every tongue confess that He is Lord.

Those to Mary were not meant to be understood as thousands of years in her future. Her Son was called the Son of the Highest. Yahweh did give Him the throne of His father David, and the fact that men have been trying to deny it ever since - does not change the fact that He has been ruling over the house of Jacob for ever - since that time - and of His Kingdom there shall be no end.

Meaning for us today - it is the responsibility of every living, breathing creature to conform to that Kingdom - right now.

We live in a world that has been taken over - not because God ordained it to be so - not because God planned it that way before the foundation of the world - we live in a world that has been taken over by the God-haters because those who claim to be the people

of God refuse to act that way. We have claimed earthly citizenships - though we were never authorized to do so. We have refused our true citizenship - the Commonwealth of Israel - and we've done so for fear of being rejected by others - or because of fear of being persecuted for obeying our King.

We have refused to acknowledge that men ought to obey God rather than men - And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

We have traded away the only Authorized, Ordained King and Kingdom in the world today - for temporal satisfaction so that our bellies are full and our bodies are untouched.

We've allowed false teachers to creep in and tell us things like God has ordained Satan to be the Ruler of this present world - the conclusions then being that we can't fight against such a thing - afterall - it's God ordained. When the truth is, this is a lie that was created for the sole purpose of deception and neutralization of any opposition that might come up against such a false scheme.

We've traded the true Kingdom of Christ which has the power to knock down the gates of hell and bring into captivity the rebellious works of darkness for something called a "church" which - if we take just a very few minutes of study - we'd find that the word should not even be in our English Bibles - as it never was in our first English Bibles.

This week I responded to an email that I received from a man who would no doubt call himself a Christian - even a Christian Israelite. He was begging people to get and vote in the upcoming election to prevent some proposed legislation that was going to happen if a certain politician got elected.

I responded to the email - because quite frankly - I'm still just perplexed at the whole concept of voting as citizens in countries that God's people are absolutely not to be a part of. I just don't get that. I was kind to this man. But I did not receive a kind response. I had made mention that God's people were to Come out from among them and be separate and be the people of God - why? So that we would not be partakers of their plagues. His unkind response was that this offered no solution whatsoever.

He basically instructed me that there was no hope.

Once again, as I stated last week, that is the end result of futurism. That is the end

result of a belief system that says that Christ is a coming King - but not One now. That is the end result - hopelessness. Because if the hope is that a king is coming to save you - then because there is no promise of this Scripturally - hope in something that is false - is going to produce despair and hopelessness.

We are commanded to Come out from among and be separate. This is not a request. It's a direct command. It's orders. It's instructions. I would dare say, that most people who call themselves "Christians" have not only not taken any steps at all to Come out and be separate - but they haven't even considered that as an option.

Jesus instructed His followers to "Take up the cross and follow Him." Really? Take up a cross and follow Him - right to Calvary? That's what you want me to do?

No, Jesus, you take up your cross and mine - and go let yourself be crucified - then when it's all said and done - I'll claim you as my Saviour.

Works works works for salvation - that's what Charlie's teaching. No it isn't. No more than Jesus saying "Take up the cross and follow me." Or, if you love me, keep my commandments. Or, be not deceived, whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. Those aren't my words. Those aren't my teachings. Those are His teachings.

If a man knew that the Bible taught, "Come out from among them and be ye separate." If a man knew that the Laws of God were applicable for today. If a man knew that the Kingdom of God is the only Authorized Government in the world today - and that if this man wanted Jesus as His Saviour - he would be required to accept these teachings - could this man take Jesus as His Saviour - and reject all of Christ's teachings?

Many many years ago, when I was still playing "church" - I was ministering in one of these institutions as a youth minister and music minister. I was teaching that men needed to make a conscious decision to follow Christ - which meant things like, "If you love me, keep my commandments" among other things - and when the head pastor found out about this - he confronted me. At that time, I had no idea there was any other way of salvation. I was very sincere. But I guess very naive.

The head pastor took me in and said to me, "Charlie, I finally figured out what your problem is." Now, at this time, I was probably 20, 21 years old. And I was all ears in wanting to know what my problem is. If I had a problem, I wanted it fixed. This pastor said, "You believe in Lordship salvation." My response was like a little kid and I said just as sincerely as I could, "Well, isn't that what you believe?" I was shocked at the response. He said, "Absolutely not."

He went on to explain to me that I believed a man has to be a theologian in order to be - as he said - "saved." I didn't believe that then, and I don't believe that today. However, I absolutely believe that a man has to know what he is being asked to put his faith in - in order to believe.

Let me ask this. What should be said to a man who - well wait a minute - let's get this in an extreme. A man who owns a house of ill-repute comes to you in 2019 and says that he wants to come to Christ and would you help him find Christ. Now you know how this man makes his living. Would you be required to tell this man that if he became a follower of Christ he would need to find another way to make a living? Would you let him know this ahead of time? Or would you just ignore this so that you could quickly get him to say quote unquote "the sinner's prayer" or quickly get him baptized? Do we owe it to this man to tell him the way he makes his living is against the Law of God? Or do we just ignore it?

The apostle Paul said that he had declared unto them the whole counsel of God. I submit to you today, that because the true Gospel, which is Repent for the Kingdom of Heaven was established over 2,000 years ago is not being preached - the whole counsel of God is not preached. Men today do not only not know the whole counsel of God - but they have been taught that the whole counsel of God is not for today. This is another by-product of futurism.

If a sodomite came to you and asked you to help him come to Christ - would the issue of sodomy be addressed? Or would we just ignore it?

One day a rich man came to Christ and asked Him what He needed to do to be quote unquote "saved." Jesus told him to sell what he had, give it to the poor and come and follow Him. And the next verse says the man went away sad because he had great possessions. It's not works for salvation - it's a willing heart to do whatever is necessary to obey and please the Father.

Come out from among them is not works for salvation. Have we taken any steps at all in our lives to Come out from among them? When I responded to the email in regards to voting - I just don't get it. No one's out there holding a gun to these people's heads and forcing them to vote. They are voluntarily acting the part of citizens of country's that as those who call themselves Christians - they have no business participating in. How can the - or I should say - how will God lead us to bigger and better things - when we can't even be faithful in the smallest of things?

Again, ultimately, these are issues that result in conclusions that are wrong conclusions because we do not rightfully divide the Word of Truth.

If the Kingdom of God is future. And if, as Scofield says, that is when "righteousness will be key word" - if the Kingdom is future - then what is for today?

This is how these people come up with the concept that this one they call "Satan" is the current ruler of the world. And things are the way they are because it's the plan of God for it to be so. Things are the way they are because Bible prophecy is being fulfilled today. If this is true - and I certainly hope by now you do not believe that - but the great majority of people DO believe that - then the conclusion is that there is nothing you can do about it and nothing you SHOULD do about it - because you would be resisting God Himself. So evil proliferates because it's the Will of God. That's where we are today.

There are people out there who are fighting. They are trying to show some resistance and I will never do anything but encourage that. But we have to get to the root of the issue. Lopping off the limbs doesn't fix the problem.

The root of the problem is simply found in the fact that the true Gospel of Christ is not preached. And that is the Gospel of the Kingdom.

Last week, I sent out another email to my list and encouraged them to listen to Ted Weiland's Part 19 of Bible Law versus the U.S. Constitution. I had listened to it before - but I listened two more times again this past week. If you have not listened to that message, I would encourage you to listen to it. If you heard it, but not recently, I'd encourage you to listen again.

Why should the world be able to find hope in the Gospel of the Kingdom? Why should someone who lives their life as if God does not exist, or the Bible has no meaning, how could we get them to pay attention to the Gospel of the Kingdom?

I believe you will find some really great answers in Ted's Part 19 message. We have to face this - all of us. What we have been doing - is not working. I was speaking with my good friend Jeff this past week - and he's just a few years younger than me - but when we were kids - the idea of a kid bringing a gun to school and killing other kids was not only not done - but no one ever even thought about it. There was bullying and kids picking on each other and the occasional fight - but I never heard of anyone saying they'd come to school with guns and kill a bunch of kids. But, we all know it's now just a

matter of time before the next one takes place.

When you listen to Ted's message, you are going to see how this has happened. When a society rejects the Laws of God - the results are catastrophic. What we see today - is catastrophic. It's unparalleled. It's not getting better - but continually getting worse.

The pure logic. The reasoning behind what happens when men think their laws are better than God's is revealed in our society today. When the framers of the Constitution said "No man can be forced to testify against himself" - friends - I believe they knew that this was opposed to the teachings of the Scripture. When they outlawed what they referred to as "cruel and unusual punishment" - I believe they were doing so because they believed the punishments found in the Scripture for capital crimes needed to be replaced. But when you see and understand why God said what He said, and prescribed what He did - all of a sudden the Scriptures - the Laws of God - are relevant for today. You can see how that if we followed the Laws of God and His Judgements - things would be dramatically different than they are today - and it would actually take place in a very short period of time.

Men's statues will fail - 100% of the time. The only way we can return to joy, peace and prosperity is to return to the Laws of God that produce joy, peace, prosperity - and above all - freedom.

In America, today, even though we are so far removed from the Laws and the Kingdom of God - because the modern preachers have preached for so long that the Laws and the Kingdom is not for today - I truly believe that things could be turned around quickly if we would begin to tear down the lie of futurism. If futurism is removed, then what is left? The Gospel of the Kingdom of God.

No friends. We are not left with despair and no hope. The Gospel of the Kingdom of God provides the greatest hope.

Go with me now and let's work on a conclusion to Daniel 9:24. We've already discussed that 490 years - which - in adding the 70 years accomplished in the Babylonian captivity provides for 560 years - which brought us from that time - to exactly the time of Christ in the first century. We have talked about finishing the transgression, making an end of sins and reconciliation for iniquity. Let's examine now that the next phrase - to bring in everlasting righteousness.

One of the very first passages of Scripture that comes into mind in seeing this

fulfillment in the required time of 70 weeks - culminating in the first century - is Matthew 6:33.

But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

This is the first thing to be done. It doesn't say But seek ye the Kingdom of God, it says Seek FIRST the Kingdom of God and His righteousness. On this passage alone, we could stop from Daniel 9:24 and claim the fulfillment in the first century.

Romans 14:17

For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.

Listen to this closely, Romans 3:

[21] But now the righteousness of God without the law is manifested, being witnessed by the law and the prophets;

[22] Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference:

[23] For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;

[24] Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:

[25] Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;

[26] To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus.

Notice again, verse 21, "but now the righteousness of God without the law is manifested..." And of course, this is talking about the laws regarding sacrifices which are done away with.

Verse 22,

Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe:

Verses 25-26

Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;

[26] To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus.

At this time. Friends, it just can't be any clearer than this. Daniel 9:24s 490 years and all the elements listed - were fulfilled in Jesus the Christ. In Mauro's The Seventy Weeks and the Great Tribulation he says:

One characteristic of God's righteousness which He was to "bring in" (Daniel 9:24) through the sacrifice of Christ is that it endures forever; and this was emphasized in the prophecy. A work was to be done, and now has been done, which would bring in everlasting righteousness - everlasting because based on the cross, as foretold also through Isaiah, My righteousness shall be forever. Isaiah 51:8. Jesus Christ has now been made unto us "righteousness" (I Corinthians 1:30) and this is in fulfillment of another great promise:

[5] Behold, the days come, saith Yahweh, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth.

[6] In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is his name whereby he shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.

Look with me to Hebrews 1, beginning in verse 1.

[1] God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets,

[2] Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son,

Please note very carefully verse two - "hath in these last days spoken unto us by Son." Do I need to say it? Of course, I do. This was written over 2,000 years ago. It was read for the first time - over 2,000 years ago - and it says - as plainly as it can be said, "Hath in these last days." The phrase the "last days" in the Bible specifically refers to the "Last days of the Old Covenant world." The book of Hebrews was written in the Last Days of the Old Covenant world.

If we are truthful with the Word of God - we could stop right here in this verse alone -

and prove that All Bible Prophecy has been fulfilled. They were in the Last Days. We are not. It is 100% totally contradictory to Scripture to say that WE today - in 2019 - or at any other time outside of the first century is the Last Days. Verse 3.

whom he hath appointed heir of all things, by whom also he made the worlds;

[3] Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;

[4] Being made so much better than the angels, as he hath by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than they.

[5] For unto which of the angels said he at any time, Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee? And again, I will be to him a Father, and he shall be to me a Son?

[6] And again, when he bringeth in the firstbegotten into the world, he saith, And let all the angels of God worship him.

[7] And of the angels he saith, Who maketh his angels spirits, and his ministers a flame of fire.

[8] But unto the Son he saith, Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: a sceptre of righteousness is the sceptre of thy kingdom.

The Kingdom of God is a present day reality today and has been so for over 2,000 years now because in the Last Days it was said to the Son,

Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: a sceptre of righteousness is the sceptre of thy kingdom.

Daniel 9:24 was fulfilled in Jesus Christ. The Scriptures testify and affirm this over and over and over. Everywhere we look, we see the fulfillment of Daniel 9:24 in the first century - fulfilled when God sent His Son to walk on this earth and to fulfill Moses and the Law and the Prophets - which is why Nathaniel said, "We have found him of whom Moses in the Law and the Prophets did write, Jesus of Nazareth, the King of Israel."

I'm a little surprised that I have not heard from anyone objecting to me that Christ has a Kingdom - but it's only for the spiritual realm.

I'm a little surprised that someone has not brought up the passage where Christ said, "My kingdom is not of this world" in arguing that if that be the case - then the kingdoms of men are valid. If one does so, he does to his own peril and it twists the Word of God into something it simply does not mean.

His Kingdom is not just a spiritual kingdom that applies to only the things in the heavens. What kind of King would this be? What kind of a King claims to be King over the whole earth and the heavens - but then commands His servants to obey other kings? That would be a king of the greatest impotence the world has ever known.

What kind of King claims to be King - then disavows His Laws, Judgements and Commandments - sets them aside - and tells His servants to make up their own laws and statutes and obey them? This would be a king of the greatest impotence the world has ever known.

This world today has rejected the King of kings and Lord of lords - and the fruit of that rejection is easily seen - not just in America - but everywhere throughout the world. Only a return to the true Gospel of the Kingdom will bring us back from the calamity we are facing. It begins with a change of mind. This will only happen when we tear down the lie of futurism. And show men and women boys and girls that the Kingdom of God was fully implemented in the first century. When they see the fulfillment of Bible prophecy, it will bring about a change of mind, which will bring about repentance, which bring about a return to the Laws of God - which will bring peace, joy, prosperity and freedom. And the hope is - because we've seen it times before - this could happen very quickly - if we would preach the Gospel of the Kingdom of God.
