Be not conformed to this world

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Good morning everyone. Today is what the world calls September 6, 2020 - and because God's people have not taken dominion over even the calendar - and it's most commonly understood as the 9th month of the year - I'll just use the 9th month to say that we are just 11 days away now from Kingdom Conference 2020!

Last week, in arguably what did not seem to be a particularly well-received message - not that I received push-back - I didn't - but I didn't hear from very many of you in relation to the message. I think it may be another one of those times where I didn't focus as much on one single issue and maybe didn't get my perspective fully delivered.

And again, I have said this a hundred times - perspective is everything. It's what causes one man to think he sees something one way - and another man to think he sees something another way - and as it is said, "Maybe the truth is somewhere in between."

When it comes to Scripture, though, we cannot afford to be quote "somewhere in

between." We need to be solidly on the side of Biblical truth. We have to be.

As has been stated many many times before, and I believe Romans 13 is a classic, foundational passage on this very issue - there isn't a "truth is somewhere in between" - one side is right and one side is wrong. The text is talking about government. Now, it's either talking about Godly Government established in the first century - otherwise known as the Kingdom of God, the Ecclesia - which is by far - not even close in the world today in comparison - that viewpoint probably hasn't even reached 1% of what people believe today - or else - you have the popular view - the +99.9% view that Romans 13 is talking about man's governments - whether it be the U.S., England, Austalia, Russia, China, Canada - fill in the blank - those are what Romans 13 is talking and those are what God has quote "ordained" as the quote "powers that be" - and this is as black and white as anything can be in Scripture.

One of those viewpoints is correct. The other is not. There's nothing in between. And, I hate to be the bearer of bad news on the issue - but this simply cannot be - among those who claim to be followers of Christ - a quote "agree to disagree" issue. For the one who gets this wrong - the Scriptures say - those who do not submit to the powers that be - with their resistance - receive to themselves damnation.

If a man gets Romans 13 wrong - and he resists the God ordained "powers that be" he brings to himself damnation. That's what the text says. It's as clear as can be - and the reality is - all parties are in agreement on this.

Now, those who advocate for the position that men's governments are in place today because God has ordained it to be so - will ALWAYS - I've seen it my entire adult life - and said adult life - but I need to strike that - I've seen it my ENTIRE life - those people will always go back to the first 39 books of the Bible to begin building their case that God has established men's quote little g governments - to rule today - in the New Covenant World and what I'm telling you is that because they do not understand - and again - that's because there's about +99.9% of people in the world today who do not believe that Christ came to set up His Kingdom in the first century - the +99.9% of people in the world today do not believe that Christ fulfilled the prophesies in the first century - there perspective then - is that the world as was once known - BEFORE CHRIST - has simply continued on the way it was - regardless of the fact that the very Son of God was sent to physically walk this earth - and bring about the most dramatic changes the world had ever seen up to that point in time.

The +99.9% of people in the world today - do not see or understand that when Christ

came - He changed everything. The world did not continue to exist as it had for hundreds of years prior to His coming.

There was a prophetic promise made concerning this coming Messiah - Who came - in complete fulfillment of the Scriptures and the plan of God from before the foundation of the world - that according to Isaiah 9:6 - the government - government would someday be on His shoulder and

and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counseller, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

[7] Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

The times where God allowed Israel to have kings like all the other nations was going to end. It was going to be replaced with a single King, Who, when He took the throne of David - His government and His peace and his Kingdom would never end - it was established with judgement and with justice from that point even for ever. And that forever is clearly pointing to that future time when the Messiah would come - restart the calendar again - and make forever apply to the New Covenant World.

And again, this is why it is so vitally important to see the book of Acts, chapter 2 in the way I have shown it to you - beginning with the message of Peter where he stated - as clearly as anything can be said in Scripture - at the day of Pentecost - a mere 50 days after the crucifixion of Christ - Peter was preaching for all the world to see and hear -

This is that which was spoken of by the prophet Joel - it shall come to pass in the last days.

The phrase the last days means the end of the Old Covenant World and that took place in the first century - and it means everything. It changes everything. The world as they knew it at that time - and earlier - from Creation - through Abraham - through Moses - through the prophets - through John the Baptist - the world as they knew it was going through the most radical change ever - and that change took place in the first century.

And for the +99.9% of people in the world today - they do not see that the advent of Christ in the first century - really made much of a change at all.

This is why men's little g governments are still in the place they are in today - and the Kingdom of God is relegated to some futurist, pie-in-the-sky event - that is never going to come by the reappearing of a jewish messiah that in all reality is a false, antichrist, lie created for one purpose - and that is to keep people from finding the true Messiah that came in the first century - changed the world - brought down all the kingdoms of the world and took His place on David's throne.

I was trying last week to show us again how the appearing of Christ in the first century was such a huge, monumental change - that the most dramatic language God inspired the writers to use - was that the old world passed with a fervent heat. It was the elements melting away with fervent heat - it was the heavens dissolving - the passing of the heavens and the earth and the establishment of the new.

Then, my discussion on the word "crime" versus "sin" was to show us how that the use of the word "crime" is basically enabling those who do not believe that Christ brought about monumental change - by suggesting - even if it's unintentional - but it lending itself to the concept that it is credible for man to define or redefine good and evil - and because for the overwhelming number of things that man calls "crime" - we are allowing them to replace the Laws of God with their own laws.

Sin is the transgression of the Law of God. And in the New Covenant World which was and is so dramatically different from the Old World - we are now once again back to the place where Israel was BEFORE the days of the earthly kings - where the only Law that should be on our lips, our hearts, our minds - is the Law of God - the perfect Will of God for His Creation. We should be using our vessels - our bodies that are supposed to solely and completely devoted to our King - we should not be yielding our vessels to lend credence to the concept that men are allowed to define or redefine good and evil.

I want you to look with me for a few minutes this morning at a passage that I'm sure most of you have seen or read a hundred times or more. But, I am going to show something to you that you may have never considered. Look at Romans chapter 12. And we will begin in verse 1.

- [1] I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.
- [2] And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

First of all, Paul is saying here that I am calling you, brethren, I am exhorting you, I am imploring you - I am desiring for you - by the mercies of God,

Webster's 1828 says to seek or ask or pray with urgency - present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

Okay. I'm in. Sign me up. What's the next step. Verse 2.

[2] And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

Alright. Of course. I could park here for a thousand years and preach to followers of Christ the urgency TO NOT BE CONFORMERS TO THIS WORLD. That principle can be applied in a multitude of ways. And for today, we could apply this to the world in which we live today and I would make no argument whatsoever - I would amen every single time someone preached non-conformity to this world.

This is why - the biggest reason why - I have preached an anti-mask message. Who said to wear the mask? Men's little g governments. If man's little g governments did not tell people to put on a mask - they wouldn't be doing it. By the way, I see some discussion now among those who are - let's call them - antimaskers - many of them are calling the mask a diaper. And rightly so. And brethren, babies wear diapers. I'm not wearing a mask - number one - because I believe it violates the Laws of God - on several levels - but I'm not wearing a mask, a face diaper because I am a non-conformist.

Call it what you want. Say anything you want to about me - call me rebellious if you want to - if that's what obeying Romans 12:2 looks like - then well - guilty.

When I grew up in the quote "church" and then went on to Bible college - and then on to quote "church" work - be not conformed to this world meant - don't drink, don't go to movies, don't smoke, don't chew, and don't go with the girls that do. Really. That's what it meant. That was the extent of Romans 12:1-2 when I was playing "church."

And yeah, even the world itself knows that some of those things are not good. But it's way more than that in light of Scripture and in light of the perfect Will of God for His people.

Now listen closely - here - I'm not telling any of you not to wear a seat-belt if you want to. But - if you are wearing a seat belt because quote "the government told you to." Well, maybe the seat belt is a good thing. Maybe it's not. But, I'll tell you this - if the quote "government" didn't have a statue calling it good or evil - who knows - I might even wear one from time to time. If someone comes to me with the voice of God and says - you should do this or that - or you should not do this or that - hey - I'm all ears. I'll perk right up - full attention - straight ahead - let's examine "Thus saith the Lord." But when strange voices enter my room - my alerts and alarms begin to sound and my obedience to Romans 12:2 is in high gear.

If non-conformity to this world is taken by the world to be rebellion - then so be it. Conformity to the King and His Kingdom is all I care about - and as long as I'm not in rebellion to the One Who has the government on His shoulder - then I'm okay.

And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

The word world here as found in the Greek is - well - let's take a quiz.

We've got three choices.

1. Aion - 165 in Strong's which means an age. Specifically the jewish age (that wording is according to Strong's) a Messianic period (and he adds present or future) hint - there is NO FUTURE Messianic age. We've talked about this extensively. The Messiah was sent to the end of the Old Covenant age. The Messiah offered Himself a sacrifice for the sins of the Old Covenant World - when? IN THE END OF THE WORLD. Back to Strong's age, course, eternal

And, I'll list your choices in the order in which they are found in Matthew 24. This is vital. It's vital to understanding Matthew 24 because all three of our word choices for world are found in Matthew 24 and each of them have an entirely different meaning and understanding them properly makes the difference on whether we understand the Word or not. It was not until AFTER - I had spent over 20 years playing "church", going to quote Bible college - it was not until AFTER I left that belief system before I ever found that the word world appears three times in Matthew 24 and it comes from an entirely different Greek word with an entirely different meaning each time.

How does this happen? How do you play "church" that long? How do you go to quote

"Bible college" and take Greek and not have someone, anyone, at least stumble onto something so significant? How is that even today - there's not a quote "Baptist preacher" in a million who has told the people that listen to him - that the word world has three different Greek meanings in the Scripture? I don't get it. It must be, it has to be by design. Purposefully hidden. And I believe, purposefully hidden to keep people from finding the truth regarding the end of the Old Covenant world and the true understanding of what the New Covenant World is all about.

Choice number 2. 3625 in Strong's - oikoumene - it means, specifically, the Roman empire. The world at that time, at least when the Greek word oikoumene was used - meant the Roman empire.

And be not conformed to this Roman empire:

I could accept that. But before we give the answer, let's examine the third choice.

2889 which comes from kosmos. The orderly arrangement. The world. I wish Strong's and others would not use the word itself to define the word. That doesn't do much good, in my opinion. But this word is typically used to describe God's Creation.

And be not conformed to God's Creation:

Would you agree that we could or should just eliminate choice three right away? Yeah, I think we should. And, if you were reading from a Greek New Testament, you would be right. The word here in Romans 12:2 is not kosmos.

So, which is it? Will you take Door Number 1? aion? Or will you take Door Number 2 - oikoumene?

Well, drum roll please - the word is aion. When I first saw this many years ago - it was a real head scratcher for me.

And be not conformed to this age: hmmm
And be not conformed to the jewish age:
And be not conformed to the Messianic period:

Alright. Once again, perspective is everything. The people in the first century were in the days of the end of the Old Covenant age. They were in that transition period where the Old was coming down and the New was coming on. Since Christ had taken David's

throne at the resurrection of Christ - even though the temple was still in existence - and would not be destroyed until several years later - the Kingdom of God - the present day reality of the Kingdom of God was being preached with all power, all authority, all might of all those who understood they were in the end times. Even though the end had not fully and completely taken place - even though the official end of the Old Covenant World was signified by the destruction of the temple - the followers of Christ were beseeched, earnestly, urgently being led and guided into the Kingdom of God at that time.

The teaching of "be not conformed to this world" was an admonition to embrace the New World.

Be not conformed to this age - the Old Covenant age - the Old Covenant world - where God allowed physical kings - who no doubt - made up their own rules - they made up their own definitions of good and evil - it was a day was Israel had kings like all the other nations. They had a little g government like all the other nations. Those days were ending. And those people in the first century, those first century saints were being urged, begged, pleaded with - to go ahead and start living according to the Kingship of Christ - where the government would be on His shoulder, where the kingdoms of the world would all be taken back - all their leaders - all their quote "laws" would all be brought down - and Christ would be exalted as the One True King. Where God's Laws, Judgements, Statutes, ordinances and Perfect Will would be exalted and there would be none else besides Him.

Unto thee it was shewed, that thou mightest know that Yahweh He is God; there is none else beside him.

Know therefore this day, and consider it in thine heart, that Yahweh He is God in heaven above, and upon the earth beneath: there is none else.

That all the people of the earth may know that Yahweh is God, and that there is none else.

And let me remind you again that the word God means - rulers, judges, magistrates. The God of heaven is not some tiki god made of elephant tusk. He is Ruler. He is Judge. He is Magistrate, He is King.

I am Yahweh, and there is none else, there is no God beside me:

There is none else. There is no Ruler beside Me. There is no Judge beside Me. There is no King beside Me. This where we are supposed to be in the New Covenant World. In

the Old World, He allowed, because of the hardness of their hearts, because of their rebellion against Himself and His prophets, He allowed them to have kings like all the other nations. But when He sent His Son the King to Israel, and He walked among them - raising the dead, healing the sick, preaching His Kingdom - then ultimately being executed by the state - but then laughing at them in triumph as He raised Himself from the dead with the help of no one but His Father - He changed the world. He did away with the Old and made all things New. He brought an end to the days where God allowed Israel to have a king like all the other nations. Those days ended. And now - since then - until now and henceforth forevermore - He is the King. And beside Him - there is no other.

Come out of the Old Covenant world. Be not conformed to the Old Covenant World where God allowed Israel to have a king like all the other nations. Those days are over.

I girded thee, though thou hast not known me:

That they may know from the rising of the sun, and from the west, that there is none beside me. I am Yahweh, and there is none else.

Do you want to know what the Perfect Will of God is? This is it. He's screaming from the heavens for all to hear and know. This is the Perfect Will of God and this is what He brought back to the New Covenant World which began in the first century when He sent His Son - the King to take David's throne.

- [18] For thus saith Yahweh that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I am Yahweh; and there is none else.
- [21] Tell ye, and bring them near; yea, let them take counsel together: who hath declared this from ancient time? who hath told it from that time? have not I Yahweh? and there is no God else beside me; a just God and a Saviour; there is none beside me.
- [22] Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else.
- [9] Remember the former things of old: for I am God, and there is none else; I am God, and there is none else.

Did you see that? I'm reading from Old Covenant writings. Isaiah is here talking about the former things of old. Former to what? What's the ancient times? He's about the days before the earthly kings. And, Isaiah is prophesying concerning the days of the

New World, the new heavens and the new earth.

And ye shall know that I am in the midst of Israel, and that I am Yahweh your God, and none else: and my people shall never be ashamed.

We have got to start refusing conforming to the Old World wherein the days God allowed earthly kings. Be not conformed to those days after which Yahweh allowed Samuel to allow the Israelites to set up kings. We are in the New Covenant World - where things are supposed to be like the former days.

We are in a world where there is One King, One Potentate, One Ruler. Judges that rule - measure the actions of the people - exclusively by the Laws of God. That's what it means to be a follower of Christ. That's what it means when Paul was saying

- [1] I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.
- [2] And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

This is our reasonable service. We say He's King. Isn't it reasonable that we would demonstrate this to our generation? We are non-conformists - not because we are rebellious - but if that's the world the world sees it - I can't help that. But are non-conformists because we live in a world where the +99.9% - led by the supposed "preachers" do not understand that when the Messiah came - when Christ came - when the King came - He made the most monumental change to the world - that the world has ever known.

We have just, for the most part, grown accustom to the ho-hum that Jesus came, Jesus did a few pretty cool miracles, Jesus made some people mad, they killed Him, but no big deal, He just raised from the dead - ho-hum - Jesus ascended into the heavens to sit there and wait a couple thousand years til He would come back again - and at that time - events far greater than anything He ever accomplished the first time - will take place.

Friends, that's the jews' religion. The Messiah of the true Christian faith - came in the flesh - in the first century - or the last century - however you want to look at it - He did every single thing that was prophesied before the foundation of the world - He brought an end to an era of the Old Covenant World where Israel was allowed to have earthly

kings - and He restored things back to the former days - where God is God and there is none else beside Him.

And here we are today, where the +99.9% out there - including nearly the whole realm of people who call themselves quote "Christians" and they are getting ready to have this big show called an election - and they are supposedly going to choose between Joe Biden and Donald Trump as their so-called "leader" and not a single one of them has the Spiritual discernment to recognize the terrible blasphemy they are perpetuating.

God is God. Christ is King - and there is none else beside Him. "Christians" so-called fighting for Trump? Fighting for something called "Republicans?" Fighting for something called the CONstitution? Listen, I'm begging, I beseech you, just like Paul did, be not conformed to this world - but be transformed by the renewing of your minds to prove the acceptable and perfect Will of God.

"Christians" so-called are getting ready to participate in an election. They are going to go stand in a line - the very same line that will be filled with freaks, perverts and queers. The very same line. And we can't see that we are conforming to the world - in complete violation of Romans 12:1-2.

I need someone to explain to me how standing in the same line with the freaks and the queers and the perverts and quote "voting" against the guy they're voting for - and in some cases - voting for the same guy the freaks and the queers and the perverts are voting for - is not a clear violation of this command in Romans 12:1-2?

Which brings me to another point. I did not intend to say anything about this - but - at the very least - it will tend to clarify some things that I have said in the past that maybe need to be clarifying.

If you recall, when I preached those two messages regarding wearing the face diaper being a sin if you are not sick - or if you are not clearly allergic to something - I said that wearing the face diaper because the quote "government" said to - is violating the Laws of God.

Now, I believe, and not that it matters - well - it does matter - because other men witnessed to the same belief and understanding - that even though the Scriptures do not say, "Thou shalt not wear a face diaper when commanded to by little governments" doing so anyway violates Thou shalt not lie and thou shalt not bear false witness.

I showed Scriptures where the nations - who did not have the Law of God given to them - nonetheless obeyed the Law - because the Law of God can even be seen in nature. I'm saying this because I have preached for many many years that when I plead with people to follow the Laws of God - I am talking about more than what Moses came down the Mount with. For instance, Paul said, in I Corinthians 11:14,

Doth not even nature itself teach you, that, if a man have long hair, it is a shame unto him?

We could have some interesting discussions as to what this means. Is he talking literally about the length of a man's hair? What is that length? When I grew up in the quote "church" it was a quote "sin" for our hair to be over our ears. Really? I don't really see a ruler here in the passage. What's long? If I had hair over my ears and down onto my back - I don't by the way - but compared to my wife's hair - that would be short.

Is Paul talking about principles here? Like - men should look like, act like, walk like, talk like, dress like men - and be distinctly different in all aspects of a woman? I don't know. Maybe.

Either way, if it's actually talking about the physical hair of a man, or the appearance or his mannerisms, I don't know - but either way - for a man to have long hair - whatever that means - if he does - is it sin? The Law that came down from the mount did not say "Thou shalt not have hair touching your ears."

But doesn't nature itself teach you that, if a man have long hair, it is a shame unto him?

So the record is clear - the Perfect Will of God - as revealed in the Scriptures - teach that it is a shame for a man to have long hair - whatever that means. So, even though that principle was not written on Moses' tablets - it's still part of the Law of God. The Law of God delivered to Moses is not exclusively the Laws of God. The Perfect Will of God contains the Laws given to Moses - but it is not exclusive.

Be not conformed to this world.

Moses didn't come down from the Mount with those Words written on the tablet. But it is against the Perfect Will of God to be conformed to this (or that) world. The Perfect Will of God is not exclusively found in the tablets Moses came down from the Mount with. Knowing these things, expounding these things, this is how we would know

whether a man is qualified to be a judge of the Law of God.

Being conformed to the world - is sin. I would hope that those who want to remain strongly tied to the strict Words that Moses came down the Mountain with, would argue that being conformed to this world (or that one) is a violation of the First Commandment. I would argue that. But that would not be my only argument.

Last week, Randy sent me an article via email link and sent some of his comments along with it. Thanks, Randy, I appreciate that.

This was in regards to another California quote "church" corporation that was actually fined by their master - their governor - their creator - and in trying to be just so blunt as to open the eyes of the skeptics - their god - yes - a quote "church corporation" has it's god - the state. We have to stop sugar-coating. We have to stop making excuses for these people. Look, I know we all have loved-ones who are caught up in this deception. They are nice people. They love us - even though they think we are nuts. But the quote "church corporation" is a double-whammy of false - unGodly - unBiblical - teaching.

"Church" is unBiblical - and the "church corporation" is unBiblical on steroids. It's taking the blasphemy of "church" to a whole other level that's just mind blowing. When we should be discussing the clear fact that the word "church" shouldn't even be in our Bibles - now we have to go even a whole other worldly conversation altogether and shine the light on how evil the "church corporation" is. We can't even get to the root because the branches are so thick with deception - we can't even see the root. Amazing.

'I Plead With You, Back Off': California Church Fined Thousands For Meeting In-Person And Singing

Are you kidding? I Plead with You, Back off? Listen:

The pastor of a Baptist church in California begged state officials earlier this week to back off enforcing lockdowns on churches after his congregation received a \$10,000 fine for holding two services last Sunday.

Senior Pastor Jack Trieber of North Valley Baptist Church in Santa Clara, California,

explained his church's predicament and pleaded with Democratic California Gov. Gavin Newsom to relent his shutdown order in a Facebook video that has racked up millions of views since having been posted earlier this week.

The church was fined \$5,000 for holding a morning service and \$5,000 for an evening service, according to local Fox affiliate KTVU.

The church was also issued a citation for singing during their worship services, according to a statement given to The Christian Post, which reported:

The four-page letter posted on the front door of the church accused North Valley Baptist of "failing to prevent those attending, performing and speaking at North Valley Baptist's services from singing." In the letter, county officials revealed they had been sending agents into the church to spy on the congregation during worship services.

"This activity is unlawful," the notice stated. "The county understands that singing is an intimate and meaningful component of religious worship. However, public health experts have also determined that singing together in close proximity and without face coverings transmits virus particles further in the air than breathing or speaking quietly."

The county demanded that North Valley Baptist "immediately cease" their activities, warning that "failure to do so will result in enforcement action by the county."

In the Facebook video, Trieber explained how the church at first complied with the state's lockdown orders, which were supposed to have lasted for two weeks, but they have struggled as the lockdowns have dragged out. "We have tried to obey authority," he said. "After 11 weeks of that, we have still continued—24 weeks—to keep it all closed, but after 11 weeks, we went back into the auditorium temporarily."

Alright. Let me stop here for just a second. Here's the problem. The quote "church at first complied..."

Where is there a "line-in-the-sand" in regards to "be not conformed to this world?" We don't conform for a little while, then if the conformity crosses a line, we complain. That's not how it works. It's not our first duty, it's not our second duty or third duty to decide to obey God rather than men - it is our ONLY duty.

"We have tried to obey authority," he said. "After 11 weeks of that, we have still continued—24 weeks—to keep it all closed, but after 11 weeks, we went back into the auditorium temporarily."

Once again. What is authority? If you have Romans 13 wrong - which these people clearly do - they can't possibly understand the Scripture. Romans 13 is basic Christianity 101. And these people - I don't care how sincere, how meek, how kind they want to put on that they are - and look I'm not going to apologize for saying it's a "put-on" about being kind and meek and all that stuff - because the Baptist quote "churches" that I was a part of growing up - was filled with the military - and those kind, mild, meek men - as soon as they were outside the four walls of that building - would tear someone's head off if they were told to by their commanders. And brethren, I know that some of you - in your past life were deceived into being in the military - I know that - and for those of you that I have personally spoken to you - you not that I'm not trying to alienate you. And I know that some of you that were in the military of the U.S. are not proud of that - you've repented of it - and we obviously can't change the past - but thank God our Heavenly Father can and will forgive us.

It's one thing to be involved in something like that when we were young and didn't know any better - but I'm telling you that in the quote "churches" the U.S. military is nearly worshipped and it is a Godless, wicked thing.

You know full well that the U.S. military is not there to defend anything, other than the interests of bankers and oil men and others of that ilk. It's not about defense - it's an all-out offensive on places in the world that will not yield to the U.S. agenda.

Don't mistake my words as meaning I do not believe in self-defense because if you think that - please don't break into my house in the middle of the night. If I wake up in time, I'll assure you there will be a fight.

The problem with this "church corporation" just like MacArthur's is they have never come out of the Old Covenant World. They've never met the Master and King who claimed that He and He alone - Matthew 28:18

And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

If He has all of it, how does anyone else have any? Yeah, I'm simplistic. Denegrate me by calling me a simpleton if you want to. But that won't change the fact that Christ is King and He has taken ALL Authority and Power to Himself and man doesn't get to have any of it.

Tell a supposed follower of Christ that if he sings as part of his worship - that singing is unlawful. How dare they use the word "unlawful" when speaking of their wicked, rebellious decrees. I am commanded to worship God."

Okay, stop again. "I'm in charge of the spiritual health of the people in this city." Is what this so-called preacher has said. And again, here is the problem. If this man were truly a follower of Christ, preaching the Kingdom of God, leading an Ecclesia. He would NEVER say that his 'charge' is exclusively for the quote 'spiritual health' of people. The article continues:

"I plead with you, back off," he continued. "Open up the spiritual environment of this valley immediately because we're going to see chaos. I'm not threatening that we're going to create chaos ... but I am willing to take a stand."

Wow. Grovelling at the foot of the enemy. Go back to I Samuel 17 and watch as a young boy refuses to grovel at the foot of a giant. While all the other older men around him seemed to be scared to death of Goliath - David was unafraid. I don't see David pleading with Goliath to back off for the sake of not creating chaos. The article continues:

"Yes, let's be safe. Let's be careful. But this area needs the church," he added.

You know what, this preacher said he's been preaching spiritual health in that community for over 45 years - and now - he's in a battle against people who are telling him to close his quote "church?" I'd say this preacher needs to reexamine the message he's been preaching for 45 years because it obviously lacked power to bring about lasting change.

North Valley Baptist Church is among several California churches that have defied the state government's orders against in-person assembly. Grace Community Church in Los Angeles has been wrangling in Los Angeles courts after Pastor John MacArthur and the church elders announced last month that they would be assembling despite the governor's order.

Citing Christ and the Bible as the ultimate authority over his congregation, MacArthur wrote in the lengthy blog post replete with scripture that "we cannot and will not acquiesce to a government-imposed moratorium on our weekly congregational worship or other regular corporate gatherings. Compliance would be disobedience to our Lord's clear commands."

Okay. I get it. Sounds great.

Christ and the Bible as the ultimate authority over his congregation,

guilty of nothing. And, the court was forced into putting this on the record.

Anyway, when I arrived at the courthouse, they now have signs everywhere saying that diapers are required. And I thought, oh boy, here we go again. But, I did not put the diaper on. I'm not going to preach one thing on Sonday mornings and then do something else if the fire gets hot. I was the only one in the entire building that did not have the diaper on. About half way through the hearing, an attorney looked at me and said, "I hate these things. And he pulled his diaper off and tossed it on the table." Now there were two of us in the building that didn't have one.

And if one prevail against him, two shall withstand him; and a threefold cord is not quickly broken.

All we have right now is our witness, our testimony, our stand. Be not conformed to this world - is our command. It's our walking papers. A threefold cord is not easily broken. How about a 5 fold, 10 fold, hundred fold?

I hope you are planning on joining us for Kingdom Conference 2020! Maybe some of you are still undecided, still not sure whether you can come. God's true people - God's true commonwealth of Israel must unite, we must come together. We must seek out how we can build Ecclesia. Ecclesia - the local community of believers is the plan of God - since before the foundation of the world. If you are, I'd certainly like to know about it - because - sadly - to be quite open with you - I don't know of a functioning Christian community of believers who have Christ as their King and they are living as the nation of God, the commonwealth of Israel.
