## **Church or Kingdom, Part 10**

Once again, I want to thank so many of you who have written in with words of encouragement and insight into the messages we have been discussing in our weekly series. It's just great seeing the lights come on - and again - it's not about me or you - but it's about drawing people to the understanding of the present day reality of the King, His Kingdom, and His Laws and Judgements.

There are a couple of things I'd like to say before we get started this morning in continuing with the theme of "Church" or Kingdom.

First, I want to let you know that once again - now for the 6th time - the trials have been canceled. The judge in the case has formally recused himself. I can't remember if I told you about our last conversation - so forgive me if I am repeating myself.

I filed a document with the court all the way back in October of 2018 in which I told them I wanted a new judge in the trial. This document, along with others that have just been sitting there for over 2 years was finally brought to court in August of 2019. I don't understand this. It goes to show again that I don't understand any of what they are doing. I don't know how you can file a document in their system and they just ignore it for years and years - but that's what they do. There are documents that have sitting there since 2017 and when I asked why they have been ignored, the persecutor said that I had withdrawn those documents. I never withdrew those documents. Never.

It's quite possible that he was mistaken about those documents in that one day I went to his office to pick up a response from him. I had filed a document and specifically asked for a response. He came out of his office and within a few seconds of seeing me began screaming at me that if I did not withdraw certain documents - he was going to have me arrested. Then, he took a copy of the document that I had sent him and forced it into my chest and walked away. Of course, because he did it, that's not to be considered obstruction of justice or tampering with a witness or anything like that. But, that's exactly what he did.

I never withdrew that document. It's still on the docket - and as of today - has still not been answered or addressed.

So, I don't know how documents can be filed, I mean, the court clerk accepted the documents, put them on the record, yet they get ignored.

In the hearing of August 7, the judge said he was going to rule on all outstanding motions. One of those motions was the document that I filed to remove the judge.

He looked at me and asked me if I had evidence to present. I told him I don't know what he means. I said that I thought in Missouri all you had to do was request another judge and you could get one. He told me the time had past for that. So he said I had to produce evidence. I told him I wouldn't know what or how to produce evidence - so I just told him I thought he should recuse himself because he had been mean to me.

This particular judge does not speak loudly and I have trouble hearing him some times. There have been times when I thought it was my turn to speak and he thought otherwise. He would verbally berate me and belittle me in front of everyone there - just because I could not hear him. I have told him on many occasions that I have trouble hearing him - but he would still just berate me and belittle me because I couldn't hear.

I realize that he is probably very frustrated at me because I don't play the game they are used to. I don't know how to play their game. I'm not interested in playing their game. This is business for them. It's what they do. It's how they make their living. It's just one more case, one more faceless, lifeless body in front of them. It's a paycheck.

It's nothing of the sort for me and the countless numbers of people that they continually file before them day after day after day. I am a man that has a wife, I have children, I have grandchildren. I struggle every single day like everyone else putting food on the table - and here I am with my entire life attempting to be destroyed by these people who think nothing about what they are doing to the lives of people.

So, I fight them. Not with guns. Not with fists. But with the only thing I have - my words. And I don't know their machinery. I don't know their procedures and practices. When another man lies about you in front of other people - I cannot and will not believe that for a normal flesh and blood man - a proper response is to speak up and say that the person is lying about you.

I have done that several times. In their system, prosecutors are allowed to lie, they are allowed to twist and distort, the police is allowed to lie - but the accused has to sit there and take it and then figure out how to overcome the lies based on their procedures. It's not a matter of simply they tell their side - you tell your side. It doesn't work that way.

I have a friend who is a federal constitutional attorney. You listening to me know what I

believe about the U.S. CONstitution. My friend knows what I believe about the U.S. CONstitution. We are opposites on our beliefs - but - this man is still my friend. He is genuinely concerned for myself and my family. He has helped us. He is not against me and even though we disagree on some very major fundamentals - he is not against me - therefore he is for me and I am grateful for his friendship.

He told me something a while back that I did not know. And after going through what I am going through, I absolutely see what he is saying is true.

We've all heard the saying "Innocent, until proven guilty." And according to my friend, this was once the case in American courts but in the late 70s and early 80s it all changed. It didn't change just because someone decided it was going to change. It changed because it used to be that the courts were required to believe the words of accused over the words of the police and the persecutor.

It was incumbent upon the persecutor to overcome the testimony of the accused. Now, it has all been reversed. The courts believe the words of the police and persecutor over the words of the accused and the accused then has to overcome the persecutor. So, the reality is - if you have been quote unquote "charged" with something in the U.S. today - you are "Guilty, until you can somehow prove yourself innocent." Listen, I'm not just telling you I think this is what is going on - I'm telling you this is exactly what is going on.

This is why almost 100% of quote unquote "charges" in the U.S. today result in pleabargained settlements. It is almost impossible to overcome a system that says a man is guilty until he can somehow prove his innocence.

Not being satisfied with my statement that the judge had been mean to me, he pressed for me some real evidence.

I told him that I was totally shocked when he looked at me last year and said, "I already know what you think about our laws." After he said that to me in open court, I went home and prepared the document to have him removed.

In court in August 2019, I told him that when he said that to me, it showed me that he was prejudiced against me and had already made up his mind. I told him that I told a cop that "All I have ever done in my life is try to live by the Laws of God" then that cop took that statement and twisted into things I never said.

I never said that because I try to live by the Laws of God that means I can go out and kill

someone without fear of the consequences or that I could go out and steal from someone without fear of the consequences. How absolutely stupid of someone to deduce that because someone chooses the Laws of God over the statues of men that that means they can do whatever they want. Didn't these people at least attend Sonday school when they were little? The statues of men do not prevent murder - they do not prevent theft. The truth is -

Because sentence against an evil work is not executed speedily, therefore the heart of the sons of men is fully set in them to do evil.

Because men refuse to implement the Judgements of God related to such things as murder and theft - anything they think they are doing to rid their societies of such things actually works to the opposite. Murder and theft INCREASE and have continued to INCREASE. How dare someone who claims to be a "christian" condemn another man who finds the Laws and Judgements of God superior to the statues of men.

Remember, I've not been quote unquote "charged" with any offense involving another flesh and blood man. There is no victim. In fact, on the document that the cop filed there is a checkbox called "Victim" and it is checked NONE!

So I told the judge that he had already made up his mind about me due to the twisted words of a cop and he had not heard what I believe about his laws from me.

At that point, he got up and told his court reporter to go outside with him. Then just a few minutes later, he came back in and said, "That's all for today." Then, this past week it became official that he had recused himself. Either by the providence of God or by my own stumblings through their system - apparently I had now provided evidence on the record that showed the judge was not being impartial. The official statement says that he recused himself to avoid the appearance of impropriety.

I have no idea what is next. I'll just have to wait and see - again.

The next point I want to bring up this morning is this and this should lead us into today's message.

The enemies of God seem huge. It seems as though they cover the entire world right now. And you know what? It's true. The enemies of God have completely dominated the entire world today.

Through the years, I've heard people talk about fleeing the U.S. because of the direction the U.S. is going. But my response has always been, "And go where?" The U.S. either has direct control over almost every other country in the world - or they are allies with them - or they are meddling in other places - or they control policies in other places because of the quote unquote "money" they send around the world.

The enemies of the Kingdom of Christ control this world today. They are in control of the money, the statues, the sciences, the communication, the transportation, you name it - they control it.

But - and this is a huge huge size 54 - BUT - they cannot control the minds of every single man, woman, boy and girl in God's creation. We know they want to. But the mind, they cannot control everyone's.

Most people, when they think about the enemy, get so overwhelmed - they get defeated before the enemy can even be engaged. And that's by design. The enemy wants a defeated, deflated opponent who gives up without a fight. And, for the greatest part of it all - that is exactly what has happened.

Here's the challenge I want to give to you today. Take your eyes, your thoughts, the things that occupy you - and remove them from the enemy. Do not focus on the enemy. We, as the people of God - if we are to ever see any type of victory - and make no mistake about this - I believe that victory is not only possible IN OUR GENERATION - but it could happen in a matter of years - if we as those who claim to be the Sons and Daughters of God - will refocus - point our thoughts and our minds on US - and our relationship to the King and His Kingdom - if we will work to get OUR lives in order - forget about the world - the world is gone. The enemies of the King and Kingdom have won the war of the world. WE HAVE LOST THAT WAR.

But if we will focus on ourselves - getting ourselves right with the King and His Kingdom - then the exact blueprint is available for us - "These that have turned the world upside down have come hither also, whom Jason hath received, and these all do contrary to the decrees of Caesar, saying there is another King, One Jesus."

The government controlled "churches" do not believe Acts 17. The enemies have Christ and His Kingdom own the "churches." That war is lost. Those who think they can quote unquote "attend" those places for the purposes of winning those inside to the King and Kingdom - though noble in their thoughts and efforts - they are not going to win.

The quote unquote "preachers" have been neutralized, they've been blinded by the tax-deductible gift and tax-exempt status." They are not going to bite that hand that feeds them. Am I saying don't evangelize? Don't preach and teach? No way. No way am I saying that. But what I am saying is that we, who claim to be the followers of the King and the Kingdom need to focusing most of our energies on getting our lives in order. Bringing our thoughts and minds into captivity. We need to be focusing on getting our lives, get our ships sailing in the right direction. "Let the dead bury the dead" is what our Lord said.

Do we really know what Christianity is? Do we really believe that there was a flesh and blood man that walked on this earth 2,000 years ago and that man was God Himself who took on the form of a man so that He could look face to face, eye to eye with men and women, boys and girls and point them to all the realities of what was taught from the Genesis account of creation, through the giving of the Law, through the frailties and shortcomings of men being rulers and kings over each other, through the prophecies - then by the Fulfillment of the Prophecies - Him being made flesh revealed all the secrets of the Old Covenant World so that mankind could live with full understanding of the Kingdom of God from that time - then from generation to generation?

This is what He did. He revealed the hidden things, the mysteries of God that had been reserved and kept back in the Old Covenant World. He clearly revealed to those who would accept Him that the plan of God was for men and women, boys and girls, and all of His creation to live according to His Kingship, according to His Will, and that when men accept His Laws and His Judgements into their generations - blessings from God would be poured upon them to the point they couldn't contain them all.

Listen to what happened in the life of Joseph who was obedient to the Laws of God - even though he stared death right in the face on several occasions:

Joseph is a fruitful bough, even a fruitful bough by a well; whose branches run over the wall:

- [23] The archers have sorely grieved him, and shot at him, and hated him:
- [24] But his bow abode in strength, and the arms of his hands were made strong by the hands of the mighty God of Jacob; (from thence is the shepherd, the stone of Israel:)
- [25] Even by the God of thy father, who shall help thee; and by the Almighty, who shall bless thee with blessings of heaven above, blessings of the deep that lieth under, blessings of the breasts, and of the womb:
- [26] The blessings of thy father have prevailed above the blessings of my progenitors unto the utmost bound of the everlasting hills: they shall be on the head of Joseph, and on the crown of the head of him that was separate from his brethren.

Listen to the everlasting promise of Yahweh that is available from generation to generation:

And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of Yahweh thy God, to observe and to do all his commandments which I command thee this day, that Yahweh thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth:

- [2] And all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of Yahweh thy God.
- [3] Blessed shalt thou be in the city, and blessed shalt thou be in the field.
- [4] Blessed shall be the fruit of thy body, and the fruit of thy ground, and the fruit of thy cattle, the increase of thy kine, and the flocks of thy sheep.
- [5] Blessed shall be thy basket and thy store.
- [6] Blessed shalt thou be when thou comest in, and blessed shalt thou be when thou goest out.
- [7] Yahweh shall cause thine enemies that rise up against thee to be smitten before thy face: they shall come out against thee one way, and flee before thee seven ways.
- [8] Yahweh shall command the blessing upon thee in thy storehouses, and in all that thou settest thine hand unto; and he shall bless thee in the land which Yahweh thy God giveth thee.
- [9] Yahweh shall establish thee an holy people unto himself, as he hath sworn unto thee, if thou shalt keep the commandments of Yahweh thy God, and walk in his ways.
- [10] And all people of the earth shall see that thou art called by the name of Yahweh; and they shall be afraid of thee.
- [11] And Yahweh shall make thee plenteous in goods, in the fruit of thy body, and in the fruit of thy cattle, and in the fruit of thy ground, in the land which Yahweh sware unto thy fathers to give thee.
- [12] Yahweh shall open unto thee his good treasure, the heaven to give the rain unto thy land in his season, and to bless all the work of thine hand: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, and thou shalt not borrow.
- [13] And Yahweh shall make thee the head, and not the tail; and thou shalt be above only, and thou shalt not be beneath; if that thou hearken unto the commandments of Yahweh thy God, which I command thee this day, to observe and to do them:
- [14] And thou shalt not go aside from any of the words which I command thee this day, to the right hand, or to the left, to go after other gods to serve them.

Malachi chapter 3 is a direct prophecy concerning the coming of John the Baptist, and the coming of the Messiah. Every single word of Malachi 3 has already been fulfilled. Contained in this prophecy are generational principles that still apply. There are promises in here that apply to us so much as they applied to the first century in which they were fulfilled in. Look with me to verse 1 of Malachi 3.

- [1] Behold, I will send my messenger, and he shall prepare the way before me: and Yahweh, whom ye seek, shall suddenly come to this temple, even the messenger of the covenant, whom ye delight in: behold, he shall come, saith Yahweh of hosts.
- [2] But who may abide the day of his coming? and who shall stand when he appeareth? for he is like a refiner's fire, and like fullers' soap:
- [3] And he shall sit as a refiner and purifer of silver: and he shall purify the sons of Levi, and purge them as gold and silver, that they may offer unto Yahweh an offering in righteousness.
- [4] Then shall the offering of Judah and Jerusalem be pleasant unto Yahweh, as in the days of old, and as in former years.
- [5] And I will come near to you to judgment; and I will be a swift witness against the sorcerers, and against the adulterers, and against false swearers, and against those that oppress the hireling in his wages, the widow, and the fatherless, and that turn aside the stranger from his right, and fear not me, saith Yahweh of hosts.

I want you to notice something very specific the sins that are named here. Sorcerers, adulterers. There is simply not enough time today to address these two crimes against society. I will say this - however and you can go do some research until we can get back to this. Sorcerers. Eli Lilly. Merck. Drug companies - just fill in the blank. Adulterers. Do not limit your understanding of adultery to sexual crimes. The crime of adultery goes way way beyond just sexual crimes. Think Monsanto. Think mixing seeds. Think the mad science of cloning. False swearers. Do not be so simplistic that the crime here is cussing or saying bad words. This is talking about rampant perjury that is committed every single day in the so-called courts of the United States of America. In the eyes of God perjury is one of the most serious crimes in the Judgements of God. Yet it happens every single day, countless times per day in the courts of America. Oppress the hireling in his wages. Do not limit this understanding to the man who pays his workers less than they deserve or is unkind to his workers. While it absolutely includes this, it goes way way beyond. It is an abominable system of taxation that has been going on in America for over a hundred years and it made God so angry He wanted to declare war when He first caused it to be written in His Holy Word - and today - it still makes Him so angry that He wants to declare war! Why?

[6] For I am Yahweh, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed.

The God of our Bible has not changed. His opinions are the same today as they have always been. The same sins and iniquities that separated men from their God

thousands of years ago are the same sins that separate them from their God today and no amount of statues or laws that men make to justify themselves will EVER change the mind of God. We are fools if we believe that just because men have written things in their "laws and in their statues" that it has caused Almighty God to change His mind on what He has determined to be right or wrong - good and evil. Arrogant, rebellious fools is what most men are today.

[7] Even from the days of your fathers ye are gone away from mine ordinances, and have not kept them. Return unto me, and I will return unto you, saith Yahweh of hosts. But ye said, Wherein shall we return?

Search ourselves today. Do we believe these everlasting principles? It's about implementing the ordinances of God into our societies.

You and I both know that the quote unquote "church" has relegated the Laws of God to the trash heap. The "Laws of God have been nailed to the cross. The Laws of God are not for today." Then as soon as the collection plate dips a little off the preachers go to Malachi 3 and somehow resurrect a part of the Law of God that fills their bellies. How dare they teach that the Laws of God have been nailed to the cross then compel men to give 10 percent of their quote unquote "income" to their "church."

When I was in Bible college, I have told you the story before, that young men would actually get into fist fights concerning predestination and whosoever will. They would also argue about whether the tithe - the 10% - should be paid before taxes or after taxes. Bunch of idiots. Total morons completely devoid of understanding the mind and Perfect Will of God.

- [8] Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings.
- [9] Ye are cursed with a curse: for ye have robbed me, even this whole nation. [10] Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith Yahweh of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.

Don't limit the blessings of God that He wants to pour out upon His people to a small portion of His Law. The principle here is obey God, prove me now, see if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it. This is what God wants for His people. This is a central theme

throughout all the Word. Obey me - institute my Laws and My Judgements in your communities and I'll bless you. Here's the blueprint, walk in it.

- [11] And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith Yahweh of hosts.
- [12] And all nations shall call you blessed: for ye shall be a delightsome land, saith Yahweh of hosts.
- [13] Your words have been stout against me, saith Yahweh. Yet ye say, What have we spoken so much against thee?
- [14] Ye have said, It is vain to serve God: and what profit is it that we have kept his ordinance, and that we have walked mournfully before Yahweh of hosts?

Even though all of this is Fulfilled Prophecy - the principles remain.

The false theology that has come from the quote unquote "church" has produced a generation that refuses to polish the brass on a sinking ship. It has refused to straighten the deck chairs. "Even though many of these terrible things are appalling in themselves, their significance should gladden the heart of every true believer." Hal Lindsey. The Laws of God have been nailed to the cross - so have said all the "churches" and the "churchmen" in America at least over the past 200 years give or take.

The men that boldly preach that the King and His Kingdom are for today - NEVER - not once EVER say that the Laws of God have been done away with. Their ministries and their preachings are constantly on pointing men and women, boys and girls to the King, to the Kingdom, to the King's Laws, Statutes and Judgements.

The only Law that "churches" teach is a law concerning tithing. Interestingly enough, debate could be had that of the few Laws of God that HAVE BEEN done away with - this could be one of them. Totally backward. Doubleminded men are unstable in all their ways is what the Word of God declares. In the New Covenant World, He does not want 10% - He wants 100%. Verse 15.

[15] And now we call the proud happy; yea, they that work wickedness are set up; yea, they that tempt God are even delivered.

This is another reason why I am saying today - we need to get our focus off of what they are doing - and I simply mean so that we are not overwhelmed with care or fear or defeatism - it's upside down indeed. But let's right the ship in our lives. Let's focus on

getting our houses in order and see if we can prove God, move God into major change in our communities.

- [16] Then they that feared Yahweh spake often one to another: and Yahweh hearkened, and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared Yahweh, and that thought upon his name.
- [17] And they shall be mine, saith Yahweh of hosts, in that day when I make up my jewels; and I will spare them, as a man spareth his own son that serveth him.
- [18] Then shall ye return, and discern between the righteous and the wicked, between him that serveth God and him that serveth him not.

This is what we want. I know it is. Though this was a prophecy and was a Fulfilled Prophecy - then principle remains.

This is another huge difference between what I teach and believe and what the "preterist" teaches. The "preterist" would not teach the application of these principles today. They would say that since the prophecy received its fulfillment - then principles have no application, either. I flatly reject this as unBiblical. In many ways, this type of thinking has just as much of a neutralizing effect on people as does futurism.

This is why I say, while futurism is 100% unBiblical and Fulfilled Bible Prophecy is 100% Biblical - it is the conclusion that matters. The correct conclusion of Fulfilled Bible Prophecy must be that the King and His Kingdom were established because the King came, the King conquered, the King fulfilled, and the Kingdom was established.

If a man claims to believe that Bible prophecy was fulfilled - and then holds onto the belief that Christ is not King now - or that God is allowing other kings to exist - or worse still - that God is causing men's governments to be in existence - then he has missed the whole point of Fulfilled Bible Prophecy.

I started out this message by asking you if we really believe that Jesus - that Yeshua - came and walked among men in the first century. Did He take the form of a man to reveal the mysteries of the Old Covenant World and to establish a New World whereby He was King and the Kingdom of God is the only Kingdom / Government allowed to exist?

When I was winding down my message last week, I told you I wanted to get into the reasons why the modern jew does not believe that Jesus was the Messiah. I want to show you from their own words, much like I did with Tovias Singer, but from another

rabbi - who actually expounds on what Singer said. Ultimately, it is this. Jesus was not the Messiah because according to the jews, He did not fulfill the Messianic prophecies of the Old Testament.

Here is where I'm driving to in today's message - Church or Kingdom, Part 10.

The quote unquote "church" teaches that Jesus, Yeshua, did not fulfill the prophecies. They will say that He fulfilled some of them, but not all of them. The modern jew says that Jesus did not fulfill any of them. Remember now, the "churchmen" say that Jesus fulfilled some, but not all. The jew says that if Jesus failed to fulfill even ONE of the prophecies - then He was not the Messiah.

There is a jewish website called aish.com - a i s h dot com. There is an article there entitled, "Why Jews Don't Believe in Jesus" written by rabbi Shraga Simmons. More than likely, we will not get through all of this today. This is what is said:

For 2,000 years Jews have rejected the Christian idea of Jesus as messiah. Why?

One of the most common questions we receive at Aish.com is: "Why don't Jews believe in Jesus?" Let's understand why – not to disparage other religions, but rather to clarify the Jewish position.

Jews do not accept Jesus as the messiah because:

- 1. Jesus did not fulfill the messianic prophecies.
- 2. Jesus did not embody the personal qualifications of the Messiah.
- 3. Biblical verses "referring" to Jesus are mistranslations.
- 4. Jewish belief is based on national revelation.

But first, some background: What exactly is the Messiah?

The word "Messiah" is an English rendering of the Hebrew word Mashiach, which means "anointed." It usually refers to a person initiated into God's service by being anointed with oil. (Exodus 29:7, 1-Kings 1:39, 2-Kings 9:3)

As someone who claims to be a follower of Jesus Christ, Yeshua the Christ - is the Biblical account - by His own Words - by Jesus' own Words - is it believable enough to say to the jew - you are wrong. Jesus / Yeshua was anointed by God. Luke 4 verse 14:

- [14] And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about.
- [15] And he taught in their synagogues, being glorified of all.
- [16] And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, as his

custom was, he went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and stood up for to read.

- [17] And there was delivered unto him the book of the prophet Esaias. And when he had opened the book, he found the place where it was written,
- [18] The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,
- [19] To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.
- [20] And he closed the book, and he gave it again to the minister, and sat down. And the eyes of all them that were in the synagogue were fastened on him.
- [21] And he began to say unto them, This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears.

Look with me to Luke 7. I wanted to read just a portion of this chapter, but as I often do, I look at the verse above the one I want and I say, "Man, that's good." Then I look above that one, and say, "Man, that's good." Then I just have to quit and go to verse 1. I'm trying to find out if there is Biblical evidence as to why I should risk my whole life and the lives of my family for this man named Jesus, this man named Yeshua. If He was the Messiah - my life better show it. Verse 1.

- [1] Now when he had ended all his sayings in the audience of the people, he entered into Capernaum.
- [2] And a certain centurion's servant, who was dear unto him, was sick, and ready to die.
- [3] And when he heard of Jesus, he sent unto him the elders of the Jews, beseeching him that he would come and heal his servant.
- [4] And when they came to Jesus, they be sought him instantly, saying, That he was worthy for whom he should do this:
- [5] For he loveth our nation, and he hath built us a synagogue.
- [6] Then Jesus went with them. And when he was now not far from the house, the centurion sent friends to him, saying unto him, Lord, trouble not thyself: for I am not worthy that thou shouldest enter under my roof:

Did the centurion here believe that Jesus was Messiah? He called Him Lord. I believe he did.

[7] Wherefore neither thought I myself worthy to come unto thee: but say in a

word, and my servant shall be healed.

- [8] For I also am a man set under authority, having under me soldiers, and I say unto one, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth it.
- [9] When Jesus heard these things, he marvelled at him, and turned him about, and said unto the people that followed him, I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel.

Can you picture this in your mind. Here is this centurion who has humbled himself before Christ - but not without letting Christ know the earthly power that he had over people. I say to this man Go here, and goes. Do this and he does. Then look what Jesus did. It says He "turned him about." Picture this in your mind. This man just told Jesus I have great power over people. And Jesus turned Him about. Jesus told this man and everyone who was looking on - I've got more power than you have. Wow. That is awesome. Do you believe this? I'm convinced already. I know this is true because the Word of God is quick and powerful and sharper than any two-edged sword and I am repeatedly brought to my knees and humbled in my heart at what I read concerning this Jesus. Verse 10.

- [10] And they that were sent, returning to the house, found the servant whole that had been sick.
- [11] And it came to pass the day after, that he went into a city called Nain; and many of his disciples went with him, and much people.
- [12] Now when he came nigh to the gate of the city, behold, there was a dead man carried out, the only son of his mother, and she was a widow: and much people of the city was with her.
- [13] And when the Lord saw her, he had compassion on her, and said unto her, Weep not.
- [14] And he came and touched the bier (that's the stand upon which the body was laying): and they that bare him stood still. And he said, Young man, I say unto thee, Arise.
- [15] And he that was dead sat up, and began to speak. And he delivered him to his mother.
- [16] And there came a fear on all: and they glorified God, saying, That a great prophet is risen up among us; and, That God hath visited his people.

Jesus did not embody the personal qualifications of Messiah? Do we believe Luke 4 or do we have doubts? Verse 17.

[17] And this rumour of him went forth throughout all Judaea, and throughout all

the region round about.

- [18] And the disciples of John shewed him of all these things.
- [19] And John calling unto him two of his disciples sent them to Jesus, saying, Art thou he that should come? or look we for another?

Here we go brothers and sisters. The same needs to be said today. Was He the one that should come? Or should we look for another? Do we believe this text or not? Should we be Christians, or not? Are these words on these pages sufficient evidence for us to forsake our lives and follow Jesus as the Messiah? Verse 20.

[20] When the men were come unto him, they said, John Baptist hath sent us unto thee, saying, Art thou he that should come? or look we for another?

Ever wonder why the jews accepted John the Baptist, but didn't accept Jesus?

- [21] And in that same hour he cured many of their infirmities and plagues, and of evil spirits; and unto many that were blind he gave sight.
- [22] Then Jesus answering said unto them, Go your way, and tell John what things ye have seen and heard; how that the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, to the poor the gospel is preached.
- [23] And blessed is he, whosoever shall not be offended in me.

Would to God that this verse of Scripture would burn into our hearts and minds and become so much a part of us that nothing could separate us from generational principle found in this verse. Are offended by Christ? Are we offended by His Kingship? Are we afraid what someone might say if we advocate for the King and His Kingdom? Are we afraid what someone might say if we advocate for the King's Father's Laws, Commandments, Statutes and most importantly, His Judgements?

- [24] And when the messengers of John were departed, he began to speak unto the people concerning John, What went ye out into the wilderness for to see? A reed shaken with the wind?
- [25] But what went ye out for to see? A man clothed in soft raiment? Behold, they which are gorgeously apparelled, and live delicately, are in kings' courts.
- [26] But what went ye out for to see? A prophet? Yea, I say unto you, and much more than a prophet.
- [27] This is he, of whom it is written, Behold, I send my messenger before thy face, which shall prepare thy way before thee.
- [28] For I say unto you, Among those that are born of women there is not a greater prophet than John the Baptist: but he that is least in the kingdom of God

is greater than he.

- [29] And all the people that heard him, and the publicans, justified God, being baptized with the baptism of John.
- [30] But the Pharisees and lawyers rejected the counsel of God against themselves, being not baptized of him.
- [31] And the Lord said, Whereunto then shall I liken the men of this generation? and to what are they like?
- [32] They are like unto children sitting in the marketplace, and calling one to another, and saying, We have piped unto you, and ye have not danced; we have mourned to you, and ye have not wept.
- [33] For John the Baptist came neither eating bread nor drinking wine; and ye say, He hath a devil.
- [34] The Son of man is come eating and drinking; and ye say, Behold a gluttonous man, and a winebibber, a friend of publicans and sinners!
- [35] But wisdom is justified of all her children.
- [36] And one of the Pharisees desired him that he would eat with him. And he went into the Pharisee's house, and sat down to meat.
- [37] And, behold, a woman in the city, which was a sinner, when she knew that Jesus sat at meat in the Pharisee's house, brought an alabaster box of ointment,
- [38] And stood at his feet behind him weeping, and began to wash his feet with tears, and did wipe them with the hairs of her head, and kissed his feet, and anointed them with the ointment.
- [39] Now when the Pharisee which had bidden him saw it, he spake within himself, saying, This man, if he were a prophet, would have known who and what manner of woman this is that toucheth him: for she is a sinner.
- [40] And Jesus answering said unto him, Simon, I have somewhat to say unto thee. And he saith, Master, say on.
- [41] There was a certain creditor which had two debtors: the one owed five hundred pence, and the other fifty.
- [42] And when they had nothing to pay, he frankly forgave them both. Tell me therefore, which of them will love him most?
- [43] Simon answered and said, I suppose that he, to whom he forgave most. And he said unto him, Thou hast rightly judged.
- [44] And he turned to the woman, and said unto Simon, Seest thou this woman? I entered into thine house, thou gavest me no water for my feet: but she hath washed my feet with tears, and wiped them with the hairs of her head.
- [45] Thou gavest me no kiss: but this woman since the time I came in hath not ceased to kiss my feet.
- [46] My head with oil thou didst not anoint: but this woman hath anointed my

feet with ointment.

- [47] Wherefore I say unto thee, Her sins, which are many, are forgiven; for she loved much: but to whom little is forgiven, the same loveth little.
- [48] And he said unto her, Thy sins are forgiven.
- [49] And they that sat at meat with him began to say within themselves, Who is this that forgiveth sins also?
- [50] And he said to the woman, Thy faith hath saved thee; go in peace.

With all that was said in this chapter concerning Jesus, concerning Yeshua, is this anointing of oil enough evidence for us to forsake all and follow this Jesus?

The modern jew says Jesus was not the Messiah because Jesus was never anointed with oil into God's service. What do you think?

Something just dawned on me and continues to give me great strength and assurance that Jesus, that Yeshua was the Messiah. You know what it is? It's the fact that the jews and the "churchmen" are still looking for their messiah. Hey, I've been hearing for over 50 years now that the messiah is coming. Jesus is coming. The rapture is coming. Well, it's not coming. And with each day that goes by, further evidence is proven that their teachings are false and that the preaching of Jesus of Yeshua as Messiah and King gains more and more evidence. The jewish messiah is not coming. The "churches" messiah is not coming - because He already came and they missed it. Just like the Pharisee whose house Jesus went to - missed it. And the lowly woman got it right and anointed his feet with oil. Think about this - the Pharisee didn't anoint Jesus HEAD with oil - but the woman who embraced the King - anointed His FEET with oil. I believe there's a message there.

I'm out of time this morning. I'm barely getting started here with why the modern jew says that Jesus was not the Messiah.

Lord willing, I'm going to continue next week because I'm going to show you how the quote unquote "church" teaches the same thing that the modern jewish rabbi teaches. The modern jewish rabbi says Jesus was not the Messiah because Jesus did not fulfill the prophecies. The modern "churchman" says that Jesus was the Messiah but will some day fulfill the prophecies. You can't have it both ways.

The message of the "church" and the message of the King and the Kingdom are not the same message. Which one for you?
