Message of the Church or message of the Kingdom, Part 13

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Good morning everyone. Thank you for taking the time again to listen in to our broadcast on Missouri Liberty Radio this morning. For those of you who go to the website and listen from an archive, thank you for taking time out of your lives to listen to the message that I believe God has given me.

I want to remind you again, that in the trials which we have been going through now for almost 4 years - I am fighting for the Kingdom of God. I am fighting for the truth that Jesus Christ, Yeshua the Christ - is King right now. I've told you many times before that when the missouri trooper arrested me, he told me as we were in the jail, "You are not here because of your id., or the tags on your car, you are here because of the books on your website."

I challenge anyone, anywhere who is hearing my voice right now, to find anything on the website www.godsendusmen.com that is not teaching things concerning the Scriptures and our responsibilities to them. The books on my website are a call, a plea, for men and women, boys and girls, to return to the teachings of Yahweh, Jesus -Yeshua the Christ. Not only are we not following the teachings of Christ today - but in many many lives of people - they do not even know what the teachings of Christ are.

Being under the influence of a man made creation of something called "church" - and learning from this man made creation most, if not all, of what men are supposed to know about the Bible, about Yahweh and His Son - the sad reality is - that this evolutionized, convoluted theology invented and created by men - has in reality - by design - been created as a means to draw people away from the true teachings of Christ - instead of leading men to the true teachings of Christ.

When I left the quote unquote Baptist "church" in the early 80s - after years and years of being exposed to its teachings - I said, "If a man is either 1) not voluntarily leaving that institution, or 2) has not been kicked out of that institution because he has asked too many unanswered questions, then the reality is - that man does not know his Blble."

When I finally left that institution, I realized that if a man has not rejected almost every single thing he was taught while in that institution, it is because he does not know his Bible. The "church" says:

- Jesus is a coming king.

The Bible says He was crowned King of kings and Lord of lords in the first century.

The "church" says:

Some mythical, Catholic, Jewish, Hollywood created entity called Satan, owns the present world.

The Bible says

[1] The earth is Yahweh's, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein.

[2] For he hath founded it upon the seas, and established it upon the floods.

[3] Who shall ascend into the hill of Yahweh? or who shall stand in his holy place?

[4] He that hath clean hands, and a pure heart; who hath not lifted up his soul unto vanity, nor sworn deceitfully.

[5] He shall receive the blessing from Yahweh, and righteousness from the God of his salvation.

[6] This is the generation of them that seek him, that seek thy face, O Jacob. Selah.

[7] Lift up your head, O ye gates; and be ye lift up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in.

[8] Who is this King of glory? Yahweh strong and mighty, Yahweh mighty in battle.

[9] Lift up your heads, O ye gates; even lift them up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in.

[10] Who is this King of glory? Yahweh of hosts, he is the King of glory. Selah.

The "church" says:

"Render unto Caesar, render unto Caesar."

The Bible says:

How long halt ye between two opinions? if Yahweh be God, follow him: but if Baal, then follow him. And the people answered him not a word.

The "churchmen" have gotten that so wrong when I hear them try to tell people what Luke 20 means it's like watching an old Andy Griffith episode with Ernest T. Bass running around Mayberry putting on the clown show he was so famous for. "Render unto Caesar, render unto Caesar." They're not even close to teaching the truths that Christ was teaching from that passage.

The "churchmen" say:

Romans 13 is commanding men to obey the governments of men - even when they are evil. You pay taxes to them. You send your sons and daughters off to fight their political wars for them. When the policeman tells you to get down on the ground - you fall down as if to worship and lick their boots. You obey them because God put them there.

The Bible says:

There is no power but of God. You know the powers of God because they recognize that God and God alone has the authority and power to define good and evil. And anyone else who comes along and claims that power has put themselves in the seat of God and is an antichrist and has declared war on the Kingdom of God, on His Son and against the throne of David - that which was given to Yeshua the Christ in fulfillment of II Samuel 7.

The "church" says:

The Laws of God have been done away with. The Laws of God are for that mean old, blood thirsty God of the Old Covenant and on this side of the cross, God has given man the authority to redefine good and evil in his own terms and compel men under threats of beatings, jailings, torturings and even death - to obey man's edicts - or face the consequences.

The Bible says, quoting Jesus, Yeshua from John 14:

If ye love me, keep my commandments.

[16] And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;

[**17**] Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.

[18] I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you.

[**19**] Yet a little while, and the world seeth me no more; but ye see me: because I live, ye shall live also.

[20] At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you.

[**21**] He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.

In Mark 7 he said this:

Then came together unto him the Pharisees, and certain of the scribes, which came from Jerusalem.

[2] And when they saw some of his disciples eat bread with defiled, that is to say, with unwashen, hands, they found fault.

[3] For the Pharisees, and all the Jews, except they wash their hands oft, eat not, holding the tradition of the elders.

[4] And when they come from the market, except they wash, they eat not. And many other things there be, which they have received to hold, as the washing of cups, and pots, brasen vessels, and of tables.

[5] Then the Pharisees and scribes asked him, Why walk not thy disciples according to the tradition of the elders, but eat bread with unwashen hands?[6] He answered and said unto them, Well hath Esaias prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people honoureth me with their lips, but their heart is far from me.

[7] Howbeit in vain do they worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.

[8] For laying aside the commandment of God, ye hold the tradition of men, as the washing of pots and cups: and many other such like things ye do.

[9] And he said unto them, Full well ye reject the commandment of God, that ye may keep your own tradition.

The "churchman" teaches a future Kingdom. The "churchman" teaches that a king will come some day and sit on David's throne in Jerusalem.

The Bible teaches that the King came, the King conquered, and the King set up His Kingdom in the first century. When Jesus, Yeshua was raised from the dead, the prophecy of David was explained in the sermon Peter preached on the Day of Pentecost, Acts 2:29

Men and brethren, let me freely speak unto you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his sepulchre is with us unto this day. [**30**] Therefore being a prophet, and knowing that God had sworn with an oath to him, that of the fruit of his loins, according to the flesh, he would raise up Christ to sit on his throne;

[**31**] He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see corruption.

Yes. The King came. The King finished His work. And contrary to what the "churchman" says is the greatest day in the history of mankind - the day Jesus came out of that grave being resurrected from the dead - the greatest day in the history of mankind occurred when He was raised up from the dead to sit on the throne of David - in Jerusalem - in fulfillment of the promise to David.

He's been on that throne ever since - never has abrogated His Kingship or His Kingdom even though an institution called "church" was created to cause men to fail to comprehend that He has been King for all this time and that it has been the responsibility of every living, breathing creature to conform to His Kingship and His Kingdom in every generation since this occurred in the first generation of the New World.

The "church" and the "churchmen" are what keeps the concept that men have the authority to create their own governments, with their own statues and compel men to obey them - when almost every single one of their statues violates the Laws of God in one form or another.

Jesus said according to Luke,

The kings of the Gentiles exercise lordship over them; and they that exercise authority upon them are called benefactors.

[26] But ye shall not be so: but he that is greatest among you, let him be as the younger; and he that is chief, as he that doth serve.

Mark heard it this way,

But Jesus called them to him, and saith unto them, Ye know that they which are accounted to rule over the Gentiles exercise lordship over them; and their great ones exercise authority upon them.

[**43**] But so shall it not be among you: but whosoever will be great among you, shall be your minister:

[44] And whosoever of you will be the chiefest, shall be servant of all.

He's saying that the world exercises their rule and their authority over people - but in

the Kingdom of God, let it not be so.

Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses.
[13] I give thee charge in the sight of God, who quickeneth all things, and before Christ Jesus, who before Pontius Pilate witnessed a good confession;
[14] That thou keep this commandment without spot, unrebukeable, until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ:

[15] Which in his times he shall shew, who is the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings, and Lord of lords;

Dominion, power and authority belongs to God. His Judgements - His Laws, His definitions of right and wrong, good and evil are what's to be implemented in society and God's people are supposed to lead the way in showing a lost world how it's supposed to be done.

Instead, a man made institution called "church" has for almost 1700 years compelled men to obey the traditions of men, the statues of men and forsake the unmistakable Words of Christ that men are to obey the Laws of His Father.

So, friends, as difficult as it may be to hear, I'm telling you again, if what you believe about God, about His Son, about the Bible - has come from something called "church" then you must reexamine every single thing you have ever heard - to make sure that it properly aligns with what is actually written in the Word.

And, you must read and study from the viewpoint that the Kingdom of God was established in the first century - or you will be looking at the Words through a skewed looking glass. Here's what I mean.

Jesus said, "Seek ye first the Kingdom of God, and His righteousness..."

1) Seek the Kingdom first. John the Baptist preached, "Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand." Jesus preached, "Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand." The apostles preached, "These all do contrary to the decrees of Caesar, saying there IS another King, One Jesus." By the way, the 1599 Geneva Bible has the word King, as found in Acts 17 - capitalized. And, the original 1611 King James Bible has the word King capitalized in Acts 17:7. Of course, in all the modern translations - the word King is now a lower case k. This, in order to be consistent with their false theology that the King referred to in II Peter 2 is any man that calls himself a king, or any man that a group of

people call king. The truth, the plain truth from the not just the Words of the Bible - but from the whole context - the whole meaning from cover to cover - is that Jesus the Christ - Yeshua the Christ - IS not just King of kings and Lord of lords - but He is the LAST of the kings that God allows for His creation. He is the King spoken of in II Peter 2. It is man's refusal to understand this and implement this into their societies that is the source for all the woes that currently exist - not just in America - but everywhere.

So, in order to understand what a man is reading from the Scripture - he must be reading and studying from the understanding that the Kingdom of God was established in the first century.

Seek first the Kingdom and His righteousness.

God's righteousness. Man does not have the ability, discernment or understanding to define good and evil, right or wrong outside of what is written in the Law of God. If a man believes that God has given him the power to redefine good and evil - then there is no way that man is going to be able to understand what he is reading or even studying when he is seeking truth from the Word of God. It's like trying to read a map without the key.

2) You must study the Scriptures with the proper understanding of time, place and people. When was the Word written. Who wrote the Words and to whom were the Words written. We must understand that not one single Word was written to us in 2019. We were not alive when the Words were written. Every single word was written during or prior to the first century. When the recipients of the Word were told THEY would see the Son of Man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory - when THEY were told, "This generation shall not pass away, till ALL these things be fulfilled," when THEY were told, "These be the days of vengeance when all things which were written may be fulfilled," we need to understand that those things happened to those people just like they were told - or they were lied to.

With those understandings, we can then begin to see the pages of the Word of God open and revealed exactly the way they were supposed to be.

Not one single word was written to us, but every Word was written for us.

We then can take the principles that we learn and apply them to our lives and to our communities - and it is then - and only then will we begin to see healing in our land.

But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall.

Malachi 4, as we well should know, was a prophecy that was fulfilled at a specific time in a specific place to a specific people. But the principle contained in that text applies generationally. To every generation that will fear His name - Deuteronomy 12

And now, Israel, what doth Yahweh thy God require of thee, but to fear Yahweh thy God,

And how is this evidenced in a man's life?

to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve Yahweh thy God with all thy heart and with all thy soul,

[**13**] To keep the commandments of Yahweh, and his statutes, which I command thee this day for thy good?

So if a generation wakes up from it's rebellion - you know - kind of like the generation we are in right now - and they turn back to Yahweh like this says, and -

unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall.

If we approach the Scriptures in any other ways - we're not going to get it. We're not going to have truth revealed to us. And sadly, in our generation and at least 5 or 6 generations before us - the approach to the Scriptures has been what has been "spoon fed" or even "force fed" from the "church." A word that should never have even been in our English Bibles.

Look, I know that is hard to swallow. It's hard to take. But I have laid it out. Show me what Greek word we derive the word "church" from - and then show me where in the New Testament that Greek word was ever translated as "church." It cannot be done. You say, "Charlie, do we have to keep talking about this?" Yes. We do. Our lives - not just spiritually - but physically speaking as well - our lives depend on it. The generation with which we pass on to our children and our grandchildren - their lives depend on it.

We are in what seems like a perpetual cycle of ignorance of the truth. The majority of the people don't know what the Bible teaches about the Messiah. They don't know what the Bible teaches about the Law of God. They don't know what the Bible teaches

about Creation. They don't know what the Light was that filled the world before God created the sun. And worse, the people don't care what that Light was and they are totally aloof and indifferent as what the significance even is.

We should have had years and years a head start on passing real truth onto the next generation coming - but again - the sad reality is - the next generation coming is dumber than we are. We have done virtually nothing to advance the Kingdom of God in our generation - and now the next generation coming is dumber than we are. And if you don't see it that way - then even sadder for us now.

"Church" was created to war against the King and the Kingdom. The evidence is in their message. The evidence is in the effect they have had on society. It is the teaching of the so-called "church" that is the most prevalent understanding of God among the masses today - and look where we are.

Two weeks ago, we were looking at the website aish.com where the rabbi was telling people why the jews do not believe Jesus was the Messiah. And what the rabbi cited as evidences in his presentation was nearly word for word the same teachings that come from the so-called "churchmen."

I showed you how the rabbi said that Jesus was not the Messiah because He did not rebuild the third temple. I then showed you how the "churchmen" are locked arm in arm with the jew in trying to rebuild a physical third temple in Jerusalem today and how they claim that it is to be done in fulfillment of Bible prophecy. The "churchman" and the jew teach the same exact thing. The jew concludes that Jesus was not the Messiah because He did not rebuild a third temple. The "churchman" says - Jesus was the Messiah and will build a physical third temple soon. The jew is happy that the "churchman" preaches what he preaches. He doesn't care what the means are to achieving his goal - he doesn't care what the "churchman" says because the message that quote unquote "Jesus" is coming again to rebuild a third temple IS - listen to me - it IS a complete denial that Jesus, that Yeshua was the Messiah - which is exactly what the jew wants people to believe.

The "churchman" can say whatever he wants to say and can try to bluff his way through with his antichrist message - but if a man believes that a physical third temple will be built by the Messiah in the future - then that messiah was not Jesus, Yeshua. That's the correct conclusion that the jew has determined - and his conclusion would be correct if a man does not believe that Jesus fulfilled the prophecies in the first century. The rabbi, in his article, cites Zechariah 14 as being unfulfilled Bible prophecy and uses Zechariah 14 in his argument that Jesus, that Yeshua was not the Messiah.

I am saying that Zechariah absolutely provides evidence to the Christian - listen now not the "churchian" but to the Christian - that Jesus, Yeshua was the Messiah. The jew says that Zechariah is unfulfilled Bible prophecy and because Zechariah is unfulfilled Bible prophecy - Jesus was not the Messiah.

So here is what I'm trying to get you to see this morning - if the book of Zechariah is not fulfilled Bible prophecy - by Jesus - in the first century - then we also must conclude as the jew does - that Jesus, that Yeshua was not the Messiah.

So if we are going to be Christians, followers of Jesus Christ, then we better find fulfillment of the book of Zechariah in Jesus - in the first century.

Turn with me to John 12. Now we have already talked about this passage - several times I believe - but we need to look at it again - in light of the rabbi's teaching as to why Jesus was not the Messiah. Verse 1:

Then Jesus six days before the passover came to Bethany, where Lazarus was which had been dead, whom he raised from the dead.

[2] There they made him a supper; and Martha served: but Lazarus was one of them that sat at the table with him.

[3] Then took Mary a pound of ointment of spikenard, very costly, and anointed the feet of Jesus, and wiped his feet with her hair: and the house was filled with the odour of the ointment.

[4] Then saith one of his disciples, Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, which should betray him,

[5] Why was not this ointment sold for three hundred pence, and given to the poor?

[6] This he said, not that he cared for the poor; but because he was a thief, and had the bag, and bare what was put therein.

[7] Then said Jesus, Let her alone: against the day of my burying hath she kept this.

[8] For the poor always ye have with you; but me ye have not always.

[9] Much people of the Jews therefore knew that he was there: and they came not for Jesus' sake only, but that they might see Lazarus also, whom he had raised from the dead.

[10] But the chief priests consulted that they might put Lazarus also to death;

[11] Because that by reason of him many of the Jews went away, and believed on Jesus.

[**12**] On the next day much people that were come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem,

[13] Took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of Yahweh.
[14] And Jesus, when he had found a young ass, sat thereon; as it is written,
[15] Fear not, daughter of Sion: behold, thy King cometh, sitting on an ass's colt.
[16] These things understood not his disciples at the first: but when Jesus was glorified, then remembered they that these things were written of him, and that they had done these things unto him.

Alright. For those of us who believe that Jesus was the Messiah. In order for Him to be the Messiah, He must have fulfilled the prophecies - all of them - from Moses to Malachi. This, the jew has correct. The jew is right about this. And remember also that the rabbi said - in reference to the "churchman's" claim that Jesus has fulfilled some of the prophecies - but will fulfill the rest of them at His supposed second coming - the rabbi shot that argument down because he said the prophecies do not teach a two fold coming of Messiah. The jew says that Messiah would fulfill all the prophecies at His coming.

Zechariah 14 says that when Messiah comes - in that day - He will be King. The jew says that Jesus was not Messiah because was not King.

Do we, as followers of Jesus, Yeshua, do we believe that Jesus was King? Did the events recorded in John 14 happen or not? Were they real? Did they happen?

On the next day much people that were come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem,

[13] Took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of Yahweh.

[14] And Jesus, when he had found a young ass, sat thereon; as it is written,

[15] Fear not, daughter of Sion: behold, thy King cometh, sitting on an ass's colt.

Do we believe this? Does this fulfill Zechariah? I want you to look very closely at verse 16:

These things understood not his disciples at the first: but when Jesus was glorified, then remembered they that these things were written of him, and that

they had done these things unto him.

The key here is "then they remembered that these things were written of HIm." Where were those things written? What does this mean? It means that the disciples had their eyes opened - they had an "Aha" moment - "Oh, wow, this is what the prophets of old had to say about the Messiah." I hope somehow I am conveying this to you properly because as I am trying to describe what the disciples figured out - the hair is standing straight up on the back of my head. Put yourself in the shoes of the disciples. Imagine that you are there in the streets of Jerusalem as the people throw down their clothes and palms leaves and cried in the streets, "Blessed is the King that cometh in the name of Yahweh." And His disciples are watching this, with all the other intimate knowledge they had concerning this man, Jesus, with all that they had seen and heard - in public and in personal private conversations with Yeshua - and then their lights came on - as they realized that what they were seeing before their very eyes was the fulfillment of hundreds of years old prophecies concerning the day that the Messiah, the promised One of Israel - the One Who had been longed for since the days of Moses - the One to Whom David spoke - Isaiah, Jeremiah - Daniel - all of the great men of old - this Jesus was the fulfillment of the prophecies concerning Messiah.

Is it possible that these things that were written of Him were what was written in Zechariah? The jew says no. What will you conclude?

Let's read Luke's account of this story. Luke 19, Jesus had sent two of His disciples to just take a colt...verse 30,

Saying, Go ye into the village over against you; in the which at your entering ye shall find a colt tied, whereon yet never man sat: loose him, and bring him hither. [**31**] And if any man ask you, Why do ye loose him? thus shall ye say unto him, Because the Lord hath need of him.

This was not to be questioned. This was the fulfillment of Bible prophecy, the Lord, the Messiah, the King - the One Who is Supreme in Authority - the One Who was the Light before there was a sun needed this colt to fulfill what was written concerning the Messiah and King. It is to be noted that the Scriptures record that no man objected to the colt being taken for the service of Yahweh.

[**32**] And they that were sent went their way, and found even as he had said unto them.

Stop for a minute and think about this. Again, put yourselves in the shoes of these men. Jesus said, "Go here and find this and do that." So they went. And when they got to the place appointed, there was the colt, standing there, tied, just like Jesus said. At the very least, if you were one of those men, wouldn't you just shake your head and say, "Wow, how did He know that colt would be there?"

[**33**] And as they were loosing the colt, the owners thereof said unto them, Why loose ye the colt?

[**34**] And they said, The Lord hath need of him.

Again, you walk up to a colt in a place exactly where Jesus told you it would be - in another village from where you were - you see this colt and begin to loosen it. Then the owners say to you exactly what Jesus told you they were going to say, and you respond exactly the way Jesus told you - and you walk away with the colt. You'd have to be saying, "He truly is the Lord" by now - or Jesus had to have set this whole thing up somehow - but you knew He couldn't have done that behind your back. So now the pieces are starting to come together for you. "Truly, this man is the Son of God, the Son of David, the Messiah, the King." Verse 35.

[**35**] And they brought him to Jesus: and they cast their garments upon the colt, and they set Jesus thereon.

[**36**] And as he went, they spread their clothes in the way.

[**37**] And when he was come nigh, even now at the descent of the mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen;

[**38**] Saying, Blessed be the King that cometh in the name of Yahweh: peace in heaven, and glory in the highest.

[**39**] And some of the Pharisees from among the multitude said unto him, Master, rebuke thy disciples.

[40] And he answered and said unto them, I tell you that, if these should hold their peace, the stones would immediately cry out.

[41] And when he was come near, he beheld the city, and wept over it,

[**42**] Saying, If thou hadst known, even thou, at least in this thy day, the things which belong unto thy peace! but now they are hid from thine eyes.

[43] For the days shall come upon thee, that thine enemies shall cast a trench about thee, and compass thee round, and keep thee in on every side,

[44] And shall lay thee even with the ground, and thy children within thee; and they shall not leave in thee one stone upon another; because thou knewest not the time of thy visitation.

With everything that has been taught you. Everything that you have seen with your own eyes and have heard with your own ears, you still are not going to understand that all Bible prophecy was fulfilled in your generation.

[**45**] And he went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold therein, and them that bought;

[46] Saying unto them, It is written, My house is the house of prayer: but ye have made it a den of thieves.

This was a direct reference to Isaiah 56, if you care to look it up later.

[47] And he taught daily in the temple. But the chief priests and the scribes and the chief of the people sought to destroy him,

[**48**] And could not find what they might do: for all the people were very attentive to hear him.

Now let's look at Matthew's version of this story. Matthew 21, verse 1.

And when they drew nigh unto Jerusalem, and were come to Bethphage, unto the mount of Olives, then sent Jesus two disciples,

[2] Saying unto them, Go into the village over against you, and straightway ye shall find an ass tied, and a colt with her: loose them, and bring them unto me.[3] And if any man say ought unto you, ye shall say, The Lord hath need of them;

and straightway he will send them.

[4] All this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying,

[5] Tell ye the daughter of Sion, Behold, thy King cometh unto thee, meek, and sitting upon an ass, and a colt the foal of an ass.

[6] And the disciples went, and did as Jesus commanded them,

[7] And brought the ass, and the colt, and put on them their clothes, and they set him thereon.

[8] And a very great multitude spread their garments in the way; others cut down branches from the trees, and strawed them in the way.

[9] And the multitudes that went before, and that followed, cried, saying,

Hosanna to the Son of David: Blessed is he that cometh in the name of Yahweh; Hosanna in the highest.

[**10**] And when he was come into Jerusalem, all the city was moved, saying, Who is this?

[11] And the multitude said, This is Jesus the prophet of Nazareth of Galilee.

Go back with me now to verse 4.

All this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying,

[5] Tell ye the daughter of Sion, Behold, thy King cometh unto thee, meek, and sitting upon an ass, and a colt the foal of an ass.

The jew says that Jesus, Yeshua was not the Messiah because He did not fulfill Zechariah 14. The "churchman" says that Zechariah 14 has not been fulfilled. I'm telling you that Zechariah has absolutely been fulfilled. Jesus Christ - Yeshua the Christ from the first century is King. He is King of kings and Lord of lords. He is not a coming king. Zechariah 14 is talking about a future Messiah Who will be King. The jew says Jesus was not the fulfillment of Zechariah 14..

All this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying,

[5] Tell ye the daughter of Sion, Behold, thy King cometh unto thee, meek, and sitting upon an ass, and a colt the foal of an ass.

Which prophet is this story talking about? Turn with me to Zechariah 9. We will look at verse 1. Zechariah 9, verse 1.

The burden of the word of Yahweh in the land of Hadrach, and Damascus shall be the rest thereof: when the eyes of man, as of all the tribes of Israel, shall be toward Yahweh.

With that in mind, I want you to turn to Zechariah 14. The rabbi says that Jesus was not the Messiah because He did not fulfill Zechariah 14. Verse 1.

[1] Behold, the day of Yahweh cometh, and thy spoil shall be divided in the midst of thee.

[2] For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle; and the city shall be taken, and the houses rifled, and the women ravished; and half of the city shall go forth into captivity, and the residue of the people shall not be cut off from the city.

[**3**] Then shall Yahweh go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle.

[4] And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, and there shall be a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.

[5] And ye shall flee to the valley of the mountains; for the valley of the mountains shall reach unto Azal: yea, ye shall flee, like as ye fled from before the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah: and Yahweh my God shall come, and all the saints with thee.

[6] And it shall come to pass in that day, that the light shall not be clear, nor dark:[7] But it shall be one day which shall be known to Yahweh, not day, nor night: but it shall come to pass, that at evening time it shall be light.

[8] And it shall be in that day, that living waters shall go out from Jerusalem; half of them toward the former sea, and half of them toward the hinder sea: in summer and in winter shall it be.

[9] And Yahweh shall be king over all the earth: in that day shall there be one LORD, and his name one.

[**10**] All the land shall be turned as a plain from Geba to Rimmon south of Jerusalem: and it shall be lifted up, and inhabited in her place, from Benjamin's gate unto the place of the first gate, unto the corner gate, and from the tower of Hananeel unto the king's winepresses.

[11] And men shall dwell in it, and there shall be no more utter destruction; but Jerusalem shall be safely inhabited.

[12] And this shall be the plague wherewith Yahweh will smite all the people that have fought against Jerusalem; Their flesh shall consume away while they stand upon their feet, and their eyes shall consume away in their holes, and their tongue shall consume away in their mouth.

[13] And it shall come to pass in that day, that a great tumult from Yahweh shall be among them; and they shall lay hold every one on the hand of his neighbour, and his hand shall rise up against the hand of his neighbour.

[14] And Judah also shall fight at Jerusalem; and the wealth of all the heathen round about shall be gathered together, gold, and silver, and apparel, in great abundance.

[15] And so shall be the plague of the horse, of the mule, of the camel, and of the ass, and of all the beasts that shall be in these tents, as this plague.

[**16**] And it shall come to pass, that every one that is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall even go up from year to year to worship the King, Yahweh of hosts, and to keep the feast of tabernacles.

[17] And it shall be, that whoso will not come up of all the families of the earth

unto Jerusalem to worship the King, Yahweh of hosts, even upon them shall be no rain.

[**18**] And if the family of Egypt go not up, and come not, that have no rain; there shall be the plague, wherewith Yahweh will smite the heathen that come not up to keep the feast of tabernacles.

[**19**] This shall be the punishment of Egypt, and the punishment of all nations that come not up to keep the feast of tabernacles.

[20] In that day shall there be upon the bells of the horses, HOLINESS UNTO Yahweh; and the pots in Yahweh's house shall be like the bowl's before the altar.[21] Yea, every pot in Jerusalem and in Judah shall be holiness unto Yahweh of hosts:

Now listen to the Word of God -

and all they that sacrifice shall come and take of them, and seethe therein: and in that day there shall be no more the Canaanite in the house of Yahweh of hosts.

I want you to understand that the jew says all of this future. The "churchman" says all of this future. If you care to, do some research and find out why the "jew" believes he is required to keep the Feast of Tabernacles today. Then do some research and find out what the "churchmen" have to say about the Feast of Tabernacles. The conclusion that both of them teach is that the Feast of Tabernacles points to a time in the future where the Messiah will be revealed as King. They call it a 1,000 year millenial reign. It is a future time where the Messiah will be revealed and He will be King over all the earth.

Examining verse 21 closely, for the true follower of Christ - the teaching that the fulfillment of Zechariah 14 as future must be exposed as the lie that it is. Verse 21 clearly shows that the fulfillment of Zechariah 14 happens before the sacrificial system of the Old Covenant world has ended. Please don't try to tell me that Zechariah 14 is unfulfilled. Because if you do, then you have to tell me that I am required to believe that a physical third temple must be built. Then you will tell me that I am required to believe that animal sacrifices are still the prescribed method for the forgiveness of sin. Then, I'll have to believe that Jesus was not the Messiah and that He is not the King.

If Zechariah 14 has not already been fulfilled, then the sacrificial system of the Old Covenant world has not been done away with. You can't have it both ways.

Go back to Zechariah 9. Look at verse 7. Verse 1 has already told us that the prophecy would be fulfilled in the day when the eyes of man, as of all the tribes of Israel, shall be

toward Yahweh. Verse 7.

And I will take away his blood out of his mouth, and his abominations from between his teeth: but he that remaineth, even he, shall be for our God, and he shall be as a governor in Judah, and Ekron as a Jebusite.

[8] And I will encamp about mine house because of the army, because of him that passeth by, and because of him that returneth: and no oppressor shall pass through them any more: for now have I seen with mine eyes.

[9] Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass.

Now, is there anyone, jew or "churchman" who wants to stand up and say that Zechariah has not been fulfilled in Jesus, in Yeshua?

Look, I expect the jew to still argue concerning Jesus. That's fine. Go ahead all you want to, I really don't care. I'm trying to reach those out there who claim to be followers of Jesus, or Yeshua. I'm trying to get those people to realize Who He was and ultimately Who He is. He's King right now.

I'm trying to get people to see what the implications of these things are. We need to repent that we have been following other gods, other lawmakers - we've been following statues and idols - we've destroyed our generation and we are doing nothing to prevent the lies and deceptions of our generation to pass onto our children and our grandchildren.

In order for physical changes to take place - we have to change our minds spiritually. We have to know Who This Jesus was. He fulfilled the prophecies - all of them. He is King of kings and Lord of lords and our responsibility is to live accordingly. We're not doing that now. Our citizenship is with the world. The documents in our billfolds and purses identify us with anything and everything BUT the Kingdom of God. Our treasures are laid up in places everywhere - except for where they should be.

Sadly, we have bought the lie of the "church" and the jew that everyone in the world today that calls himself a king - is a king - everyone, that is, except for the Only One Who truly is the King. And this has happened because we don't understand that the Messiah fulfilled the prophecies in the first century.

The truth that the Messiah fulfilled the prophecies in the first century is not some ho-

hum event that lacks significance for us today. It is huge, it's colossal, it's earth shaking. It is so important to God that He caused the writers of the last 27 books of the Old Testament (I meant to say the last 27 books of the Old Testament) to call these events the passing of the heavens and the earth - the end of the world - the elements melting away with a fervent heat - the establishing of New Heavens and a New Earth - a New Covenant - a new and better way.

Teresa and I found out this past week that the world is coming to an end tomorrow the day they call September 23, 2019. The "churchman" that was lying about this was telling people that this was going to be the most important date not just in this century - but in the history of mankind. As numb as I am to this idiocy, it is still heartbreaking to know that there are people who are still falling for this garbage.

No, September 23, 2019 is not the most important date in the history of mankind. In fact, on the chart of important days, it's at least ranked somewhere in the high hundred thousands.

What could be more important than the angel coming to Zacharias to tell him about the birth of his son John the Baptist? Maybe the angel coming to Mary to tell her about the birth of her son, Jesus? Maybe the day the wise men from the east found He was born King of Israel? Maybe the day John the Baptist started preaching, "Repent for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand?" Maybe the day the voice of God was heard from heaven in declaring that this Jesus was His beloved Son in Whom He was well pleased? Or maybe the day Jesus gave sight to the blind, or the day He raised Lazarus from the dead? Was the most important date in the history of mankind the day that Jesus raised Himself from the dead to sit on David's throne and fulfill the prophetic writings that began hundreds of years before He was there in the first century?

If we do not understand that the most important date or date(s) in the history of mankind occurred in the first century when God Himself took on the form of man to reveal His secret things face to face so that we would know how to worship Him in spirit and in truth - then we've missed the whole meaning of life.

We are now at the 23rd of September 2019 as the most important date, because these liars first said it was supposed to be September 23, 2017, then September 23, 2018, now it's 2019. All of this is done to keep people from repenting that they have not allowed the King to be king in their generation. They are to sit back, do nothing, and wait for a jewish messiah - who - sadly - isn't going to save them - but is going to be the jewish saviour and force the rest of the world to serve the jew or die.

The King already came. The King is not coming again. The King came and fulfilled all the prophecies from Moses to Malachi. The King finished the sacrifices. There are no more sacrifices.
