

Message# 303_9-1-2024 – In the Beginning

Good morning everyone. Thank you for tuning into the message this morning.

Well, I have a disappointment to share with you this morning. I was on the “Off the Cuff Show” with Sam Britton the other night and I completely forgot to let you know about it last week - and - then I meant to send out an email reminder - and - well, I forgot to do that, too. I always enjoy the interviews with Sam and Trish. I've said many times that Sam is the best radio show host I've ever had an interview with.

I called him the following morning to ask him if he still had a radio station after the interview - and he laughed and said he did. We didn't hold anything back in the show. I originally told Sam I thought I could make it for an hour - but I think we did almost an hour and a half.

One of the things that came up in the show - and I regretted that I failed to mention to Sam in my answer was this. It's extremely important. Sam asked me what to say to “Christians” when they hear about Fulfilled Bible Prophecy - there is no return of Jesus Christ to this earth to fight against all the bad guys and then they want to argue about it - the first answer I said - and it is usually my first reply - is that - the more correct statement - in my opinion - is to refer to those who make such a statement - they are “churchians.” They are not Christians. I, personally, refuse to allow non-believers to hijack a purely Biblical term - Christians - and attach it to a belief system that is not Biblical.

“Churchians” do not believe that Jesus fulfilled all the prophecies. The Bible is as clear as can be. Jesus Christ fulfilled the prophets. And He did it - just like the Book of Revelation begins - with things that must shortly come to pass - and just like the Book of Revelation sums it up -

Seal not the sayings of the prophecy of this book: for the time is at hand.

And, of course, the many many passages prior to the Book of Revelation. The Words of Jesus, to His disciples in Matthew 16:28:

[28] Verily I say unto you, There be some standing here, which shall not taste of death, till they see the Son of man coming in His kingdom.

Those are not hard passages to understand. Matthew 24:33-34. In Matthew 24, Jesus spent the entire time telling His disciples when the temple would be destroyed, when His second coming would take place - both events - simultaneously signifying - as it says in the KJV and other English translations - when would the end of the world take place - the end of the Old Covenant age. That's what that means. Interestingly enough, even though pretty much every single modern English translation of the Bible - to which I'd say probably 90% or more of the "church world uses today" - for instance - listen to Matthew 24:1-3 from the New American Standard Bible, quote:

1 Jesus came out from the temple and was going away when His disciples came up to point out the temple buildings to Him.

2 And He said to them, "Do you not see all these things? Truly I say to you, not one stone here will be left upon another, which will not be torn down."

3 As He was sitting on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to Him privately *, saying, "Tell us, when will these things happen, and what will be the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?"

Even though the modern translations of the English Bible translate aeon correctly - age - the end of the age - pretty much every single churchian that I have ever dealt with in my life - believes that Jesus was describing the end of the world, as in the end of time, the end of the grass, the trees, the earth and all that's in it. That is not at all what Jesus was talking about in Matthew 24. He was talking about the end of the age. Yes, the KJV says it as, the end of the world, and that's accurate, as long as we don't take one word and jerk it out of the Bible and lay it on the table - and say - "Aha - world - that's the grass, the trees, the people, the earth and all that's in it."

No, if we first had read and understood Ecclesiastes 1:4

One generation cometh, another passeth away, but the earth abideth forever.

Then, when we had arrived at Matthew 24:1-3 - even if all we had were the oldest English translations, we would have thought, "Well, how does the end of the world - line up with "the earth abideth forever?" Or, if we had known the prophets who prophesied of New Heavens and a New Earth - we would have understood that it is talking about a new way of doing things - it's a new covenant. Indeed, Matthew 24, Jesus is talking about the end of the Old Covenant age. But today, we live in a world of psycho-babble "preachers" who have twisted the Word of God into things it never said or things that it never meant people to understand the way they think they do today.

Jesus is not coming back to this earth again. The first coming of Christ occurred in the first century - and the second coming of Christ occurred in the first century. Revelation 1:7:

[7] Behold, He cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see Him, and they also which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of Him. Even so, Amen.

That is not difficult language to understand. And sure, building Scripture upon Scripture. Had we known what Jesus said to Caiaphas as recorded in Matthew 26. Turn there for a minute, please. Matthew 26, read beginning in verse 59. This is Jesus before Caiaphas the high priest who literally signed the execution warrant for Jesus capital punishment by the state.

[59] Now the chief priests, and elders, and all the council, sought false witness against Jesus, to put Him to death;

[60] But found none: yea, though many false witnesses came, yet found they none. At the last came two false witnesses,

Make note again, how that when God wants us to know the witnesses or the testimony is false - the text tells us "false" as in "false witnesses." Now listen. This is exactly the same as when we study the word accuse in Luke 23 and compare that to Luke chapter 3. As in, "they began to accuse Him saying, We found this fellow perverting the nation and forbidding to give tribute to Caesar, saying that He Himself is Christ a King." And you then compare that to Luke 3 where Jesus tells the Roman soldiers not to accuse falsely. In Luke 3, the English text that says, "Do not accuse falsely" did not have to include the word falsely because the word accuse there actually means a false accusation. In Luke 23, where they were accusing Jesus of forbidding to pay tribute to Caesar, and claiming Himself to be King - that word does not mean false accusation - that's why it doesn't say so in the text. To say that the accusation against Jesus in Luke 23 was a "false accusation" is to intentionally mislead people and make sure the truth is hindered for them.

My point is, when the context is false accusation - the English text - at least in the KJV - tells us - it adds the word false or falsely - even though the Greek word itself means false accusation. And where we are not to understand certain accusations as false - an entirely different Greek word is used - which does not mean false - as in a false accusation. Look again at verses 59 and 60.

[59] Now the chief priests, and elders, and all the council, sought false witness against Jesus, to put him to death;

[60] But found none: yea, though many false witnesses came, yet found they none. At the last came two false witnesses,

Clearly. False witnesses. The Greek word here is pseudomartys and it means a false witness.

[61] And said, This fellow said, I am able to destroy the temple of God, and to build it in three days.

[62] And the high priest arose, and said unto him, Answerest thou nothing? what is it which these witness against thee?

[63] But Jesus held his peace. And the high priest answered and said unto him, I adjure thee by the living God, that thou tell us whether thou be the Christ, the Son of God.

[64] Jesus saith unto him, Thou hast said: nevertheless I say unto you, Hereafter shall ye see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.

Jesus told Caiaphas that he, Caiaphas would see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven. If we had known what Jesus told Caiaphas in Matthew 26:64 - then - when we arrived at Revelation 1:7 - the only "Aha" moment would be that we would quickly relate what God told John to write:

[7] Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see Him, and they also which pierced Him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of Him. Even so, Amen.

And, it would be easy to understand that what God was telling John to write about, was events that were all taking place in the same time frame. In the same time from as what Jesus told His disciples in Matthew 24:34 -

This generation shall not pass away, til all these things be fulfilled.

Then, we would easily grasp the understanding that the Kingdom of God - established by Jesus Christ - which ended the Old Covenant world, it ended the days in which God allowed the nations to walk in their own ways, it ended the earthly reign of kings in Israel - Jesus Christ taking the throne of David - just like it says in Acts 2:25-36 - thereby

making Jesus Christ - not only King of kings and Lord of lords - but the Last of the Kings that God allows for His Creation. Listen friends, this is not a message of lost hope. This is not a message of doom and gloom because we've been taught a lie, believed a lie, lived a lie for pretty much most people's lives - this is a matter of....turn to John chapter 8. Read beginning with verse 25, please.

[25] Then said they unto Him, Who art Thou? And Jesus saith unto them, Even the same that I said unto you from the beginning.

[26] I have many things to say and to judge of you: but He that sent me is true; and I speak to the world those things which I have heard of Him.

[27] They understood not that He spake to them of the Father.

Ok. They didn't understand it. But there is absolutely no excuse for us not to understand. We are seeing the whole story. We have such an advantage over them. Not to mention that their eyes were blinded. They were predestined not to understand. Not so for us. The blinders have been lifted. We see the whole story. It's right here for us to read and understand. Jesus was of God. Jesus was sent from God. Jesus was there at Creation. I suppose it should be said that if we don't believe the Genesis account of Creation, we probably won't understand these things either. Verse 28.

[28] Then said Jesus unto them, When ye have lifted up the Son of man, then shall ye know that I am He, and that I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father hath taught Me, I speak these things.

[29] And He that sent Me is with Me: the Father hath not left Me alone; for I do always those things that please Him.

[30] As He spake these words, many believed on Him.

[31] Then said Jesus to those [Judahites] which believed on Him, If ye continue in My word, then are ye My disciples indeed;

[32] And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

Friends. It's about knowing the truth. It's about knowing Who Jesus is, what He came to earth for. It's about knowing the truth of the Government of God. It's about knowing that Jesus came to free people from the chains of slavery that come from the whole concept of the nation-states - people walking according to their own ways - their own "governments" - their own definitions of right and wrong, good and evil.

I just can't say it enough. We need to understand that man's "laws" are his definitions of right and wrong, good and evil. That's what "laws" are. Yes. They have some "laws"

that say one man is not allowed to kill another man. That's fine. Any idiot should know that. But the same people that have made their definition "thou shalt not kill" - don't seem to have any problems at all with killing unborn babies - right up until the time the baby is completely outside of his mother. And every single "election cycle" in the u.s. - the people are arguing about whether or not it's okay to kill babies. They're insane. And that is exactly what God says happens to people who believe it's okay to make their own "laws" - their own definitions of good and evil, right and wrong.

Men and women actually have the unmitigated gall to call themselves - lawmakers - allow other mere people to call them lawmakers. That is one of the craziest things I've ever heard of. If sticking your fist in the face of God in rebellion was in Webster's dictionary - that would be one of the first, if not the first definitions.

Turn to James chapter 4 for a minute. Read from verse 1:

[1] From whence come wars and fightings among you? come they not hence, even of your lusts that war in your members?

[2] Ye lust, and have not: ye kill, and desire to have, and cannot obtain: ye fight and war, yet ye have not, because ye ask not.

[3] Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts.

[4] Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God.

Verse 4 is another one of those verses that has gotten completely lost in that monster called "church." The shallowness, the lack of study. The inability to grasp deeper and truer meanings. "Friendship with the world only applies to adulterers and adulteresses - that's only people that have committed sins of infidelity in their marriages."

That is not at all what this verse of Scripture is talking about. The Greek word here for adulterer is *moichos* and it means *μοιχός moichós, moy-khos'*; *perhaps a primary word; a (male) paramour; figuratively, apostate:—adulterer.*

Mr. Thayer gives a more accurate Greek definition as *faithless toward God, ungodly*

I'm not denying the fact that it could be understood as simplistically as infidelity - but the infidelity is being unfaithful to God. It's about being unfaithful, an unfaithful citizen of

the Government of God. Being a citizen of the world - living according to the "laws" - the definitions of right and wrong, good and evil - according to men - is being moykhos -

know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God.

This is really serious business. Enmity with God? The enemy of God? The biggest reason why people do not understand this is because they have been taught the lie, believed the lie, that it is God's Will - at this present time - actually from the time of Christ - till now and beyond - that men and women, boys and girls bow to and submit to man's little g "governments" - their "laws" - their definitions of right and wrong, good and evil - and why - because Jesus Christ has not set up His Government, Jesus Christ did not come again as He said He would - the fulfillment of Bible Prophecy is in the future - meaning that if Jesus is not King now - then man is. And people believe that is hope?

I've got news, that is the biggest amount of despair I've ever heard of in my life. Preaching the good news that Jesus Christ already came, that Jesus Christ already set up His Government - takes away people's hope? The only hope that takes away is people's hope - people's trust - that God somehow told them they can live a life in complete denial of the Laws of God - in favor of the laws of men - and if that's what that message does - then God, please send us more men that will have the courage to preach your Word, to stand for your Word, to preach the truth, to preach the Only God Ordained Government - the Only God Ordained Lawbook allowed today - and that is the very few, tiny, comparatively microscopic in number - compared to the amount of "laws" men have come up with - Thou shalt not murder, thou shalt not steal, thou shalt not commit perjury, thou shalt not covet - as we have seen clear as a bell from James 4:1-2 - and just a few things briefly comprehended. Verse 5, now.

[5] Do ye think that the Scripture saith in vain, The spirit that dwelleth in us lusteth to envy?

[6] But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.

[7] Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Anytime we see devils, or satans, or demons, or serpents in our English Bibles, we are seeing instances where men and women - even boys and girls - are refusing to submit to the Government of God. Devils, satans, demons, serpents, those are people who

crave power over others - to enforce their preferences - to enforce - at gunpoint if they so choose - their definitions of good and evil - right or wrong. We aren't talking about fairytale spirits in the sky. We are talking about people. People who act like brute beasts. People who act like lying, slithering snakes. People who are possessed by their own desires for power, their own lusts for controlling other people's lives. That's what the Bible is talking about when it uses those words.

[8] Draw nigh to God, and He will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded.

[9] Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: let your laughter be turned to mourning, and your joy to heaviness.

[10] Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He shall lift you up.

Let go of your desires. Your desires to force people to live according to your "laws" - your definitions of good and evil, right and wrong. Bow to the King - the One and Only True King. You want hope? It's not in a false coming King. It's humbling ourselves in the sight of God right now - and He will lift us up.

[11] Speak not evil one of another, brethren. He that speaketh evil of his brother, and judgeth his brother, speaketh evil of the law, and judgeth the law: but if thou judge the law, thou art not a doer of the law, but a judge.

[12] There is one lawgiver, who is able to save and to destroy: who art thou that judgest another?

I've heard the Law of God spoken against for my entire life. In the "church" and in the world. "The Law of God is bad. The Law of God is evil. The Law of God is done away with. Jesus nailed the Law of God to the cross." Whenever you hear statements like this - you are hearing people say "Our 'government' is good. Our 'government' is to be obeyed. Our 'laws' are what you must submit to."

People have been completely lied to about what was nailed to the cross. The Government of God was not nailed to the cross. The Old Covenant ceremonies. The blood sacrifices. The water washings - more commonly known today by its more deceptive word - baptisms. Those things were nailed to the cross. But with the cross, with the coming of Christ, with the destruction of Jerusalem and the temple - came the Government of God. The Government of God, established in the first century, put an end to the despicable false doctrine of the "divine right of earthly kings." That wicked, abused doctrine - was replaced with the King of kings and Lord of lords - and if we only

knew the truth of God's Word - we would understand that this is the greatest hope that God has ever offered to His Creation.

The fake rapture, the fake second coming. It's all false hope. It isn't true. And the reality is - that false hope has destroyed the world as we know it today. It is a false hope that has continually made the world worse and worse and worse. That's what it has done. Lies will never produce good fruit. Back to John 8:33.

[33] They answered Him, We be Abraham's seed, and were never in bondage to any man: how sayest Thou, Ye shall be made free?

[34] Jesus answered them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin.

Now again. This should be very easy. To know what Jesus is talking about, we must have an understanding of the Scriptures - the written Word of God - that are able to make us wise unto salvation. For doctrine. For reproof. For instruction. Sin is violating the very few Laws of God. That's what Jesus is talking about.

[35] And the servant abideth not in the house for ever: but the Son abideth ever.

[36] If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.

The hope of the world is not in a false return of Jesus to this earth. That is not going to happen. There is no rapture. There is no second coming. The hope for all us is in knowing the truth. It is in knowing the truth about Who Jesus is - and that truth is what will make us free - and if we are in the truth of Christ - we shall be free indeed.

Hope. Hope is in freedom. Hope is in living a life of joy, of peace, of freedom. And that comes from the truth regarding the Son.

I told Sam and Trish the other day, sometimes, when we read principles from the Word of God - we can actually look at them in reverse - the opposite - and sometimes seeing them in that light - gives us as much insight - maybe even more. For instance. The Son shall make you free. The inverse of that - a lie shall make you enslaved.

And that is exactly what the false religion of unfulfilled Bible prophecy has done in our world today. It is the little g "governments" of the world that enslave people. It is the little g "governments" of the world that have an unbridled lust for controlling everyone and everything - even to the point of controlling people's breathing - we saw that just a

few years ago - for several years. And even after that happened - the masses of people still didn't wake up and understand what happened. Some did. I glad for that. But still not in the way that truly makes us free. Some people just got a fresh breath of hatred towards "government" - but the problem is - if you sweep that out - if they were to sweep out man's little g "governments" today - and not replace it with the Government of God, the Government of Christ, the Government of Heaven - the bad will come back in - and will be seven times worse than what was originally there. That's a principle. That's what Jesus said would happen if the bad is not replaced with the good.

But the problem is - until we can get people to understand the lie of futurism - they will not understand that the bad must be replaced with the present day reality of the Government of God. The Government of God, the Kingdom of God is not future. Jesus is not coming back to this earth to set up a future reign on this earth, when every human authority will be subject to Him. First of all, there is no "human authority." Jesus Christ said that He had all power - all Authority. So that eliminates the statement, "human authority will be subject to Him." Remove the word authority and just state that every human - if you understand that word to mean people, flesh and blood people, every one that is living is supposed to be subject to Him - right now. Not in the future. Not until He "comes again." Right now. There is no "authority" on this earth today. Every single man, woman, boy and girl alive right now is supposed to yield to the Authority of the Government of God.

Now let's clarify just a little. Man is capable of accessing the Authority of God - of tapping into it - if you will - when - and only when - he uses the Authority of God to rule, to measure, to judge the actions of another man - when - and only when - that man violates one of the very few Laws of God. This is really simple. Thou shall not murder. Thou shalt not steal. Thou shalt commit perjury. Thou shalt not covet. And just a few other things. When a man is charged - by two or more witnesses of violating one of these very few Laws - then a man can tap into the Authority of God and bring about justice - God's Justice on this earth.

But when a man intervenes in the life of another man - say for - sitting in a park - after dark - and then that ends up with death - we've got big problems. Let me say this. Remember a few months ago I made the statement that we don't know what trespasses are? A public park is quite different from someone's house. A man can't just park his car in someone's driveway at night without permission. If a man is parked in someone's driveway at night (or in the daytime, that doesn't really matter) - then the homeowner would certainly have a "right" to ask the person trespassing - what they

are doing. And they could certainly ask them to leave. Private property is different than public lands. But that's a discussion for another time.

So hope. The preaching of the present day reality of the Government of God is where we find hope - real hope. Teaching lies just because it seems to give people false hope is always a recipe for disaster - and that's what the false rapture has done.

It's so strange to me that people prefer false hope to real hope. We're in the middle of right now. The “republicans” are promising their version of hope. The “democrats” are promising their version of hope. And people fall for it. People believe if only their choices get in there - things will change. If we win the election - things will be better. And if it wasn't so sad - it would be hilarious. Their supposed choices are Donald Trump and Kamala Harris? Are you serious?
Incredible.

Earth is wobbling and days are getting longer — and humans are to blame

Let's read this one. Quote. Oh, and before I forget, if you click that link, you can see a video from NASA - showing the world spinning. It's quite fascinating. It's from 2016, though. They don't have anything newer than that. Of course, you can see the "earth" spinning, but the clouds stay the same the whole time it's spinning. They never change. They stay exactly the same as the "earth" is spinning - woops. But, it's there anyway, if you want to see it. Quote.

New studies, which utilized AI to monitor the effects of climate change on Earth's spin, have shown that our days are getting increasingly longer and that our planet will get more wobbly in the future. These changes could have major implications for humanity's future.

The length of Earth's days and the orientation of our planet are being thrown out of balance as human-caused climate change continuously alters Earth's spin, new research suggests.

Initially, these changes will be imperceptible to us, but they could have serious knock-on effects, including forcing us to introduce negative leap seconds, interfering with space travel and altering our planet's inner core, researchers warn.

Oh no. This has got me trembling already as I read this. Those nasty knock-on effects. And, oh man, altering our "planet's core."

A day on Earth lasts about 86,400 seconds. But the exact time it takes our planet to complete a single rotation can shift by tiny fractions of milliseconds every year due to a number of factors, such as tectonic plate movements, changes to the inner core's rotation and gravitational tugging from the moon.

However, human-caused climate change is another factor that can alter the length of our days, and scientists are just starting to realize how much this will affect our planet's spin in the coming years.

Over the past few decades, the rate of ice loss from Earth's polar regions, particularly Greenland and Antarctica, has been increasing rapidly due to global warming, leading to rising sea levels. Most of this extra water accumulates near the equator, causing our planet to bulge slightly around the middle. This, in turn, slows the planet's spin because more weight is distributed farther away from the planet's center — similar to how spinning figure skaters slow down by moving their arms away from their bodies.

In the new study, published July 15 in the journal PNAS, researchers used an advanced artificial intelligence program that combines real-world data with the laws of physics to predict how the planet's spin will change over time.

So the days are getting longer. Which means everything's getting warmer, which means, the end of the world is near, so, please NASA, please u.s. “government” - please u.n., please World Economic Forum - please, please save us.

As you read and read and read that article and you'll find out how man is destroying God's Creation - even though the Word of God says that man is as a grasshopper - what is man that thou art mindful of him? In relation of God and His Creation - man is not powerful enough to destroy God's world. But as you read about all the damage that man is capable of inflicting on God's Creation - they finally tell us how much longer the days are getting. Listen to this:

But in general, Earth's rotation has been slowing for millennia, mainly due to a process known as lunar tidal friction, in which the moon's gravitational effect on our oceans pulls water away from the poles. At the moment, this effect is lengthening our days by around 2.3 milliseconds every century.

The new studies show that climate change is currently lengthening our days by around 1.3 milliseconds every century. However, based on current global temperature models, the researchers predict that this could increase to 2.6 milliseconds per century by the end of the 21st century, which would make climate change the biggest influence on our planet's spin.

Wait a minute. 2.3 milliseconds every century? 1.3 milliseconds every century? We

aren't even talking seconds. We are talking milliseconds, thousandths of a second - and over a period of 100 years. These people are nuts. I cannot believe that people give them one ounce of credibility. This is crazy. 2.3 milliseconds, 1.3 milliseconds - every century. That's insane that these people are given billions of dollars of stolen money to spend their time spouting this nonsense.

Listen to this. From NPR. Jul 17, 2024.

Now I just have to stop here for a minute. So, the ice at the north pole and the ice at the south pole are melting. And, wow, this is a great discovery - the ice becomes water and goes into the ocean. But, these scientists are actually wanting people to believe - and amazingly - they do believe it - that the water around the spinning ball - around the equator bulges - really - the water around the equator bulges out from the rest of the water on their spinning ball? That is absolutely amazing that water does that. And I guess that's something we see with our own observations, isn't it? Russia is signaling it could take out the West's internet and GPS. There's no good backup plan.

Alright. Russia could be getting ready to take out the west's GPS - their global positioning system. What is GPS anyway? Well, according to the u.s. "government's" website, here's a brief overview of GPS.

What is GPS?

The Global Positioning System (GPS) is a U.S.-owned utility that provides users with positioning, navigation, and timing (PNT) services. This system consists of three segments: the space segment, the control segment, and the user segment. The U.S. Space Force develops, maintains, and operates the space and control segments.

When you visit this website - <https://www.gps.gov/systems/gps/> you will see that GPS is all about satellites. It's all about space. With that said, let's read the article about Russia taking out the west's GPS. Quote:

Russia is likely mapping underwater internet cables, a NATO official said.

The country is also believed to be behind flight GPS interference.

It's signaling it could wreak havoc with the West's electronic infrastructure, experts say.

Dmitry Medvedev, the deputy chairman of Russia's Security Council, issued a stark warning in June.

The undersea cables that enable global communications had become a legitimate target for Russia, he said.

Medvedev's warning came after Nord Stream 2, a pipeline that transfers gas from Russia to Germany, was blown up. Russian officials believed the West had been involved in the attack. (Recent reports suggest Ukraine was actually behind the attack.)

"If we proceed from the proven complicity of Western countries in blowing up the Nord Streams, then we have no constraints - even moral - left to prevent us from destroying the ocean floor cable communications of our enemies," Medvedev posted on Telegram.

Medvedev, a close ally of Russian President Vladimir Putin, has a long history of making incendiary claims.

But some analysts say this wasn't just another idle threat.

A serious warning

The vast network of undersea fiber-optic cables that transfer data between continents is indeed vulnerable to hostile powers, including Russia, the Center for Strategic and International Studies warned in a report this month.

In May, NATO's intelligence chief David Cattler warned that Russia may be planning to target the cables in retribution for the West's support for Ukraine in its war against Russia.

It's a scenario that has NATO's planners increasingly worried.

If the cables are seriously damaged or disabled, swaths of the internet services we take for granted and that our economies rely on, including calls, financial transactions, and streaming, would be wiped out.

Carl-Oskar Bohlin, Sweden's minister for civil defense, said damage to a telecommunications cable running under the Baltic Sea in 2023 was the result of "external force or tampering," though he did not provide details.

And in June, NATO stepped up aircraft patrols off the coast of Ireland amid concerns about Russian submarine activity, The Sunday Times reported.

The threat to GPS

Security analysts say that the internet is not the only network that Russia is probing for vulnerabilities.

In recent months, Russia has been accused of interfering with GPS navigation systems, causing havoc on commercial airline routes. As a result, flights from Helsinki to Tartu, Estonia, ground to a halt for a month in April.

Melanie Garson, an international security expert at University College London, said it was part of Russia's "gray zone" campaign against the West, which involves covert actions that fall below the threshold of open warfare.

"Russia has long been developing this capability and it is currently a cheap and effective way of malicious gray-zone interference," said Garson.

"As we increase our reliance on connectivity and space data in everything from

agriculture to food delivery, disrupting national and economic security through interfering with subsea cables and GPS becomes increasingly effective," she added.

Did you catch that? The article was all about Russia interfering with the west's GPS - but not one single thing was said about "space." Everything in the article was about undersea cables. Over and over, the article spoke only of underwater cables. There wasn't anything in there about space. Doesn't Russia go into "space" all the time? Couldn't they just easily knock a satellite down? Amazon boss Jeff Bezos has had his first spaceflight criticised by fellow astronaut Wally Funk, 82, who said the capsule 'didn't go high enough'.

The Blue Origin flight, which has been mocked on Twitter for only just escaping the

Earth's atmosphere, was Bezos' company's first human flight.

Alongside Funk on Bezos' \$5.5 billion rocket was his younger brother Mark, 53, and teenager Oliver Daemen.

Bezos described the crewed flight, which launched on Tuesday, as 'the best day ever', but his crewmate Funk had some qualms.

In a post flight interview with Fox, she said she was disappointed not to see the curvature of the Earth while aboard the Blue Origin flight.

Wait a minute, now. She said - supposedly an eyewitness - former astronaut - said she did not see the "curvature of the earth" because they did not go high enough.

Funk, who spent six decades attempting to reach space as a trained astronaut, said: 'We went right on up and I saw darkness. I thought I was going to see the world, but we weren't quite high enough.'

The octogenarian astronaut also said she would have loved to have spent longer in zero gravity to 'do a lot more rolls and twists and so forth.'

'I loved every minute of it,' she said. 'I just wish it had been longer.'

Footage from the Blue Origin flight showed the four passengers amid a backdrop of the Earth's atmosphere and black space, and a slight curve in the horizon.

The blistering 11-minute journey to space, orchestrated by Bezos, the world's richest man, flew to 350,000ft (106km) on the 52nd anniversary of the Apollo 11 moon landing.

Interesting. At 350,000 ft - ten times higher than commercial airliners fly - this "astronaut" said she did not see the "earth's curvature." How can that possibly be?
