

Message# 339_5-18-2025 – Possessed by Evil Spirits

Preached first on 5/18/2025

Good morning everyone. Thank you for tuning into the message this morning.

Please remember those who are on the Prayer Request page on the website. We had a very nice visit with Doug and Mindy and Joanna and Simon and Beth and Sarah this past week. It's always nice when we can get together face to face.

Well, we are just getting started in the series “Possessed by Evil Spirits” and I feel that I need to pause for a week and deal with something else. It seems like as much as I try to deal with questions concerning - “What Next? What does it mean? How are we supposed to live?” I never seem to be able to communicate that very clearly. At least I think that way sometimes. But the more I think about it, I think the question comes because we have so many new listeners and they are all coming in at different times - they may not have been able to listen to all the messages in order to get their questions answered. One such email came in a couple weeks ago - and I've responded a couple times - and I just think the best approach may be just to pause this current series for a week and answer the emails.

It seems as though more and more people are grasping Fulfilled Bible Prophecy - I mean - it's so simple - I'm amazed that thousands of sincere seekers are not flocking to the message. People are disgruntled with “church.” They are disgruntled with “government.” And they are looking for something else. Because they are tired of being lied to. In the last several years, I've heard more people say, “I think we've been lied to about every single thing.” I've heard that statement more in the last several years than I have in the last 40 years combined. Even though the statement has been true for several hundred years - at least.

I was telling Teresa this week - the lie about the “soon coming of Jesus Christ to the earth” starting gaining momentum well almost 200 hundred years ago. They've been preaching this lie for almost 200 years. Yet - here we are. No Jesus has returned to the earth - 200 years for the “soon coming of Christ, any day, any minute, any second” yet somehow - the days, the minutes, the seconds just keep getting pushed back - by days, minutes, seconds. Two hundred years. That is one fifth of a 1000 years. Do we have any idea how long that really is? One fifth of a millenium. One fifth of the amount of time they told us a Jesus was going to reign on the earth for a thousand years. One fifth of that amount of time - 5 generations of time - 200 years. But here we still are.

When I was young - I was told by these lying deceivers that the 1980s had to be it. The 1980s was the “decade of destiny.” The rapture, C.I. Scofield's Great Tribulation - capital G, capital T - had to take place in the 1980s because “Israel was restored, became a nation again in 1948 - all of which was the great fulfillment of Bible prophecy” and then in order not to turn Christ into a liar - the rapture and the Great Tribulation - the fulfillment of Daniel's prophecy concerning the abomination of desolation - all that had to take place “in this generation”. But it didn't happen. We blew right through the decade of destiny - right into the insignificant 1990s - right through “there's no way the world could exist into the 2000s - and here we were one quarter of the way through another century - and friends - Christ is not the liar - Darby, C.I. Scofield, William Miller, Charles Spurgeon, Dwight Moody, Bob Jones, Sr., Jr., the III, the IVth, the Vth through the 20th, Billy Graham, Hal Lindsey, Jack VanImpe, Tim LaHaye, Harold Camping, Jerry Falwell, and just go on and fill in the blank of pretty much every single “preacher” dead - who never saw the rapture - and those still alive trying to keep that lie going - they too will be dead and gone and the lie will continue.

“Charlie, how could you name those men who were preachers of the Gospel?” No they weren't. They were not preachers of the Gospel. They preached another gospel. They did not preach the Gospel of the Kingdom Government of God that calls people out of the domain of darkness - the dominion of darkness - the demons of darkness - and into the Government of Christ where God's Laws are supreme. They did not preach the Gospel as found in the Bible.

William Miller - 1831 - 1844, quote, the link is in the notes.

The Great Disappointment in the Millerite movement was the reaction that followed Baptist preacher William Miller's proclamation that Jesus Christ would return to the Earth by 1844, which he called the Second Advent.

[Ever wonder where the modern day preachers got that term? Well, it's not in the Bible. It's been passed down from one liar to the next.]

His study of the Daniel 8 prophecy during the Second Great Awakening led him to conclude that Daniel's "cleansing of the sanctuary" was cleansing the world from sin when Christ would come, and he and many others prepared. When Jesus did not appear by October 22, 1844, Miller and his followers were disappointed.[1][2][3][4]

These events paved the way for the Adventists who formed the Seventh-day Adventist

Church. They contended that what had happened on October 22 was not Jesus's return, as Miller had thought, but the start of Jesus's final work of atonement, the cleansing in the heavenly sanctuary, leading up to the Second Coming.[1][2][3][4]

[Jesus's final work of atonement? Really? There it is again. It's what I've been screaming for 40 years now. If the Jesus Christ that walked on this earth in the first century did not completely finish the work of atonement - then He was not the Messiah. If a man believes that there is unfinished work that a messiah is supposed to do - then they are denying that Jesus the Christ came in the flesh. Every single one of these man's government mouthpieces does the exact same thing. Friends, our Christ, our Jesus the Christ said, "It is finished." He left nothing undone. The work of atonement that the Messiah did is finished. There is no messiah, no j e s u s that is returning to this earth to do a final work of atonement. That is what the jews spout and people that spout the same stuff today are antichrist jews' from exactly the same cult that murdered the Son of God. And I am not going to make excuses for them. I'm not going to say they were just misguided, innocent men. If you say that the Messiah of the Bible - the One prophesied all the way back in Genesis 49 by Jacob to his sons - if you say - that Shiloh - the Messiah - left this earth with unfinished business related to the atonement for sins - then you are an antichrist deceiver.] The Great Disappointment article continues:

Miller's apocalyptic claims

Between 1831 and 1844, on the basis of his study of the Bible, and particularly the prophecy of Daniel 8:14[5]—"Unto two thousand and three hundred days; then shall the sanctuary be cleansed"—William Miller, a rural New York farmer and Baptist lay preacher, predicted and preached the return of Jesus Christ to the earth. Miller's teachings form the theological foundation of Seventh-day Adventism. Four topics were especially important:

Miller's use of the Bible;

his eschatology;

his perspective on the first and second angel's messages of Revelation 14; and; the seven-month movement that ended with the "Great Disappointment".[6]

Miller's use of the Bible

Miller's approach was thorough and methodical, intensive and extensive. His central principle for interpreting the Bible was that "all scripture is necessary" and that no part should be bypassed. To understand a doctrine, Miller said one needed to "bring all scriptures together on the subject you wish to know; then let every word have its proper

influence, and if you can form your theory without a contradiction you cannot be in error." He held that the Bible should be its own expositor. By comparing scripture with scripture a person could unlock the meaning of the Bible. In that way the Bible became a person's authority, whereas if a creed of other individuals or their writings served as the basis of authority, then that external authority became central rather than the teaching of the Bible itself.[7] Miller's guidelines concerning the interpretation of Bible prophecy was built upon the same concepts set forth in his general rules. The Bible, so far as Miller and his followers were concerned, was the supreme authority in all matters of faith and doctrine.[8]

[His perspective was off from the beginning. When people approach the Bible - it doesn't matter how intensive or thorough they think it may be - when the Bible is read or studied minus the understanding of the clear Words of Christ - that All Prophecy was fulfilled in Him - in the first century - it doesn't matter how sincere, how thorough, how intense the study is - Jesus said - the Scriptures have not been opened to understanding without that basic foundation.

For these be the days of vengeance, that all things which are written may be fulfilled.

If a man cannot understand those simple, basic Words of Christ - there is no possible way that man can understand, let alone teach others, the prophecies found in the Book of Daniel.] The article continues.

Second Advent

The Millerite movement was primarily concerned with the return of Jesus, literally, visually, in the clouds of heaven. The French Revolution was one of several factors that caused many Bible students around the world who shared Miller's concerns to delve into the time prophecies of Daniel using the historicist methodology of interpretation. They concluded, to their satisfaction, that the end of the 1,260-"day" prophecy of Daniel 7:25[9] in 1798 started the era of "time of the end". They next considered the 2,300 "days" of Daniel 8:14.[10]

[Stop here. Did you catch that? The French Revolution caused people to get into "the time of the end." The French Revolution was at the end of the 1700s. Now listen to Scofield again in the introduction to "What do the prophets say". This was in 1918. A little more than a hundred years from William Miller's lies, quote:

THAT the human race is in a supreme crisis is obvious to the dumbest intelligence. Nothing like it has ever marked the long life of humanity on the earth. It is impossible to restrain the effort to find the meaning of it all. No one is really either satisfied with or convinced by the easy solutions proposed by a shallow optimism. For thirty years these prophets of peace without righteousness have assured us that great and serious wars were ended forever; and yet we are in the greatest and most serious of all wars. What does it all mean?

[He's talking about what they called World War I.]

The Christian believes that somehow, somewhere, the answer is in the writings of the Prophets — writings authenticated by Jesus Christ (Luke 16:31; 24:27, 44), and by hundreds of literal fulfillments. But these writings, plain and explicit in themselves, have been forced into meanings utterly foreign to the language used, in the effort to make them apply to the Church instead of to Israel; or have been the ready resort of unscholarly fanatics.

Surely it is timely that a sane and reasonable interpretation of those writings should be found. This book is a sincere effort to present such an interpretation, after thirty-five years of earnest study.

[The thread is the same. The theme is the same. Wars, crisis, but it's all okay because it's all signs that a j e s u s is getting ready to return to earth and save it. How about this one?

*Mine eyes have seen the glory of the coming of the Lord;
He is trampling out the vintage where the grapes of wrath are stored;
He hath loosed the fateful lightning of His terrible swift sword:
His truth is marching on.*

Those lyrics are taken right from the Book of Revelation. And when was that song written?

The "Battle Hymn of the Republic" is an American patriotic song written by the abolitionist writer Julia Ward Howe during the American Civil War.

Howe adapted her song from the soldiers' song "John Brown's Body" in November 1861, and sold it for \$4 to The Atlantic Monthly[1] in February 1862. In contrast to the

lyrics of the soldiers' song, her version links the Union cause with God's vengeance at the Day of Judgment (through allusions to biblical passages such as Isaiah 63:1–6, Revelation 19 and Revelation 14:14–19).

The threads are all the same. The themes are all the same. Why? It's because it has been one lie passed down from the next. One liar to the next. We've been putting up with these lies for almost 200 years - and one of the reasons - if not the biggest reason - is that men's little g "governments" are ran by demon possessed people, devil possessed people, satans who are obsessed with possessing people, land, money, control - and one of the biggest ways they accomplish their evil is through wars and rumours of wars - and the religion arm of the state smooths it all over because - "It's all going to be okay, these are all signs that j e s u s is getting ready to return and put an end to it all. Lies, lies lies. It's all for the purpose of keeping men's little g "governments" going. The article about Miller's Great Disappointment continues.

There were three things that Miller determined about this text:[11]

that the 2,300 symbolic days represented 2,300 real years, as evidenced in Ezekiel 4:6[12] and Numbers 14:34;[13]

that the sanctuary represents the earth or church; and by referring to 2 Peter 3:7,[14] that the 2,300 years ended with the burning of the earth at the Second Advent.

Miller tied the 2,300-day vision to the Prophecy of Seventy Weeks in Daniel 9 where a beginning date is given. He concluded that the 70 weeks (or 70 sevens, or 490 days) were the first 490 years of the 2,300 years. The 490 years were to begin with the command to rebuild and restore Jerusalem. The Bible records four decrees concerning Jerusalem after the Babylonian captivity:

[The 490 years' prophecy of Daniel is so ridiculously simple. Those years are exactly, perfectly fulfilled with the genealogies found in Matthew chapter 1. If you are not familiar with that - it's all in my book, The Religion of the New World Order. So simple. So clear.]

536 BC: Decree by Cyrus to rebuild the temple.[15]

519 BC: Decree by Darius I to finish the temple.[16]

457 BC: Decree by Artaxerxes I of Persia.[17]

444 BC: Decree by Artaxerxes to Nehemiah to finish the wall at Jerusalem.[18]

The decree by Artaxerxes empowered Ezra to ordain laws and to set up magistrates and

judges for the restored Jewish state. It also gave him unlimited funds to rebuild whatever he wanted at Jerusalem.[19]

Miller concluded that 457 BC was the beginning of the 2,300-day (or -year) prophecy, which meant that it would end about 1843–1844 (457 BC + 2300 years = 1843 AD). And so, too, the Second Advent would happen about that time.[11]

Miller assumed that the "cleansing of the sanctuary" represented purification of the earth by fire at Christ's Second Coming. Using an interpretive principle known as the day-year principle, Miller, along with others, interpreted a prophetic "day" to read not as a 24-hour period, but rather a calendar year. Miller became convinced that the 2,300-day period started in 457 BC, the date of the decree to rebuild Jerusalem by Artaxerxes I of Persia. His interpretation led Miller to believe—and predict, despite urging of his supporters—that Christ would return in "about 1843". Miller narrowed the time period to sometime in the Jewish year 5604, stating: "My principles in brief, are, that Jesus Christ will come again to this earth, cleanse, purify, and take possession of the same, with all the saints, sometime between March 21, 1843, and March 21, 1844." [20] March 21, 1844, passed without incident, but the majority of Millerites maintained their faith.[citation needed]

[The cleansing of the sanctuary did indeed take place at Christ's Second Coming. Exactly when Christ said it would happen. Exactly forty years from the time Christ said it would happen. This Miller's Great Disappointment article goes on for a long time. I'll read one more paragraph then move on.]

After further discussion and study, Miller briefly adopted a new date—April 18, 1844—one based on the Karaite Jewish calendar (as opposed to the Rabbinic calendar).[21] Like the previous date, April 18 passed without Christ's return. In the Advent Herald of April 24, Joshua Himes wrote that all the "expected and published time" had passed and admitted that they had been "mistaken in the precise time of the termination of the prophetic period". Josiah Litch surmised that the Adventists were probably "only in error relative to the event which marked its close". Miller published a letter "To Second Advent Believers," writing, "I confess my error, and acknowledge my disappointment; yet I still believe that the day of the Lord is near, even at the door." [22]

So the lie continues and continues and continues. People still believe the lie. Amazing how that can even be possible, but it does. Thankfully, there are some who have had enough and are looking at something different - like the truth.

And, for those who grasp Fulfilled Bible Prophecy quickly - the obvious next step is - "What does it mean? What are the implications? Does this mean that my life might need to make some changes?"

Yes. Understanding Fulfilled Bible Prophecy's implications means that a life change is coming. Because Fulfilled Bible Prophecy means that Christ finished His Work. There's nothing left for Him to do. He established His Government. He fulfilled Isaiah 9's prophecy concerning Government. The days where God allowed the nations to walk in their own ways. The days where God allowed Israel to "have a king like the other nations" - those days are over.

Everyone agrees principally to this. Even the heretics. Scofield's utopian Age to Come was supposedly to be fulfilled in the "earth rule of Messiah." All of them teach earth's golden age where a j e s u s will come back to this earth and put down all rule, all authority - and He and His Father will once again be the Only Ones ruling the earth - and - as Scofield said - it will be *"the age of resistless power. Whatever the inner thought of man may be, he must do right or die."*

And to that - I am in 100%, total agreement with C.I. Scofield and all the rest of those heretics - but I am in 100% total disagreement as to the timing of it. It's not in the future. The "earth rule of Messiah" began in the first century when the Old Covenant world ended and the New Covenant world began. Since that time, it has been the responsibility of every living, breathing creature - to leave the Old Covenant - whether it's the ceremonies in the Law - or whether it was the temporary allowance of man's little g "governments" - men and women, boys and girls are to leave the Old Covenant -

Come out from among them and be separate, saith the Lord...

Whether it's the judaizers who are doing everything within their power to keep people following the ceremonies of the Old Covenant, water, blood, temple, a future coming messiah - or whether it's the baptists, the pentecostals, the catholics, the mormons, etc., who are there to keep people following the "governments of men, the kingdoms of the world" - in the New Covenant World - everyone is commanded to come out from all of that - and come into the exclusive Government of God - or - die. That's the choice.

Salvation comes from making a conscious choice to enter into the Fulfillment of the Prophecies concerning the Christ and leave the world behind. That's what it is. That's what the Gospel of the Kingdom is. It's the Good News that God has established -

through His Son - the way of Salvation. Saved from the elements of the Old Covenant Law, saved from the rudiments of the world, saved from demons and devils whose purpose is to enslave people and force them into obeying their "laws, their definitions of good and evil, right and wrong."

When people understand that God has a Nation. That it is His Command that all men, women, boys and girls, leave the "nation of their birth" - just like in the example we see from the story of Abraham. God told Abraham to leave. Abraham said, "Ok, where do you want me to go?" And God said, "Just leave, then I'll tell you where to go." Spiritually speaking, that example is as valid for us today as it was for Abraham then. We must leave the mindset of what pretty much the entire world has - meaning that the concept of the nation-states - that's our home. That's where our allegiance is. That's where our obligations are. And God was saying to Abraham - leave everything - leave all your comforts, leave all your roots and foundations - and come and follow Me. We've seen this a hundred times. Turn to Hebrews chapter 11. A lot of people call this "the faith chapter." Rightly so. Except most people do not understand what faith is. Faith is belief. Faith is not hope. Faith is not trust. Faith is not mysterious. Faith is belief. This is what we are supposed to believe. We believe what we read in the Word of God and we trust that it is true and God will reward those who believe what He said.

Hebrews chapter 11, verse 8.

[8] By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went.

[9] By faith he sojourned in the land of promise, as in a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise:

[10] For he looked for a city which hath foundations, whose builder and maker is God.

[11] Through faith also Sara herself received strength to conceive seed, and was delivered of a child when she was past age, because she judged Him faithful who had promised.

[12] Therefore sprang there even of one, and him as good as dead, so many as the stars of the sky in multitude, and as the sand which is by the sea shore innumerable.

[13] These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.

[14] For they that say such things declare plainly that they seek a country.

[15] And truly, if they had been mindful of that country from whence they came out, they might have had opportunity to have returned.

[16] But now they desire a better country, that is, an heavenly: wherefore God is not ashamed to be called their God: for He hath prepared for them a city.

So my question is this. We say that the Christian faith is supposedly built on Abraham's faith, on Abraham's example. Here it is. Can't get any plainer. Can't be any clearer. Abraham did not lay claim to an earthly country. You know, I said, Abraham. This was not just limited to Abraham. This included all the founders. All those upon which our faith - our belief system - is supposed built upon. None of them claimed earthly citizenship. They confessed they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.

I do not believe this means that their attitude was to sit idly by while those who oppose Christ take dominion. I do not believe that at all. I believe their mindset was that they were controlled by, their minds, their opinions and their actions were controlled by the city of God and not by the cities of the world, the counties of the world, the states of the world and certainly not the federal nations of the world. They plainly declare, that they seek a country that is controlled by the God of Creation. And if this is not what we are supposed to be doing today - then I am of the opinion that we don't have a single thing correct about the Bible, about the God of the Bible or His Son the Christ.

So, I agree. In theory all of this sounds great. If we were talk about this behind the closed doors of our homes - this would all be great. But how do we live this in a world where people want to shoot you if you try to implement this faith into an actual lifestyle? With all of this said, here is the first email that came in a week or so ago.

Hello Charlie,

I've just been recommended to your sermons from the "fulfilled prophesy" facebook group...I'm so very glad to have been given your info.

Like you said on some of your sermons, 99.9% of "christians" don't believe this mindset, belief, understanding of fulfilled prophesy and it's sad. I am 40 years old and just started learning all the truths in the Bible about 2-3 years ago.

Do you recommend any good books on these topics as well?

[Let me stop right here for just a minute. What I would encourage people to do who

have come into the understanding of Fulfilled Bible Prophecy, is to simply go back to your Bibles and start re-reading again. Now that you understand that All Bible Prophecy has been fulfilled, the Book will become new. We need to re-read, study in light of the correct perspective and we'll have so much reading material - we won't even have time for other books. I have referred people to Paul Revere's website. There's a link to Paul and Rachel's website on the Links page of my website. Paul has a lot of really good material concerning entering into the Government of God. I have referred people to the writings of Caleb Israel. I have some of them in a little booklet called "Israel is Real" - that's on the website. J. Stuart Russell's book, The Parousia, is excellent for Fulfilled Bible Prophecy - but I warn people that I believe Russell's work is great - all the way to the end - but he loses it when it comes to Revelation 20.] The email continues.

I saw on your website you have one i will most likely be sending you a request for soon, just also looking for other good reads?

[The Religion of the New World Order is a good intro book to Fulfilled Bible Prophecy, then, They All Call Him King goes into more detail as to what the implications are.]

Thanks so much for your work and all the many audio sermons on your website. I have been listening to many sermons while i'm working through out the day, and i am constantly urged to say aloud "amen brother"...

In Christ, He is King of Kings and Lord of Lords, here and now, His Kingdom has come! Amen!

Then I responded with basically what I said a few minutes ago. Then this email came next.

Hey Charlie, I'm listening to your sermon online about paying taxes on our labor and since the governments of the world tax our labor, and it is clearly against Gods law to do so, how does one just simply not pay the taxes without repercussions...

[Alright. Rubber meets the road. I have never said living according to the Laws of God in a world that despises the Laws of God - can be - or will be accomplished without repercussions. We live in a world where demons and devils exist for one main reason - and that is to control the way other people live. These demons and devils are flesh and blood people who have duped people into believing that they have righteous power and authority - and even God Himself ordained them to sit around tables behind closed

doors - or sit at bars somewhere drinking their liquors and spirits - coming up with "laws" that are just their ideas of the way they want others to live - and they then enforce those ideas on other people - people they don't even know - people that don't know them - but they force people to conform to their ideas of the way people are supposed to live - and they have the audacity to force this on people with guns, with threats of taking their property, with threats of putting them in steel cages - and pretty much everyone in their world believes this is perfectly fine. Well, it isn't fine. It is antiChrist, it is antiGod it is antiBible and if a man says so or dares to live otherwise - you can rest assured - there will be repercussions. And the man who thinks he can live contrary to the world of demons without those demons declaring war on him - is naive in the least - and delusional at the worst.

We live in a world where road pirates are dressed in fancy uniforms now - and they'd just as soon shoot a man as they would spit on his shoes. Age doesn't matter to these demons. Male or female doesn't matter. Question the supposed authority of a devil and see what happens. Turn to Matthew chapter 16 and read beginning with verse 24.

Then said Jesus unto His disciples, If any man will come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me.

[25] For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: and whosoever will lose his life for My sake shall find it.

[26] For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?

Jesus told His disciples to take up their cross. He didn't tell them to take up His cross, the cross of Christ. He told them to take up their own individual cross. The cross is the symbol of the death penalty. This was not a religious ritual execution. The cross is the symbol of the death penalty carried out by man's little g "government." It's no different than the electric chair. It's no different than lethal injection. It's no different than a firing squad or a rope.

Did you notice last week when I was reading about the catholic inquisition? Did you catch where it said the inquisition would capture unrepentant people and turn them over to the "secular authorities for punishment - even execution?" That's how it works. That's what they did to Christ. That's what they to most of those other true Christians who were executed by the state - Stephen might be a notable exception to that.

Christ told His disciples to take up their own cross. When you live in a world that rejects

Christ - when you make the choice to follow Him - you are taking up your own cross - your own potential for the death penalty.

“But I don't like that option. Is there another?”

That's one of the reasons why the “churchmen” changed the Gospel into a lie. You aren't going to get many followers by telling people they might potentially get the death penalty for becoming a Christian. This is why state preachers like Scofield did all they could do to convince people that the Gospel of the Kingdom is future. It's not for today. Christ is not King now. He's just a coming King. And when He comes again to set up earth-rule of Messiah - then He'll be King. Just not now. When you tell people that they can “be saved” or they can escape “hell” - and do so without any change of lifestyle - that will be a popular message. And it certainly has been.

“All that business about taking up a cross - that was either just for the disciples - or - it is for a time in the future.” And that is exactly what Scofield taught. It is exactly what all the futurists teach. And it is a gospel that resembles nothing from the Gospel, the way of salvation, that Christ Himself taught. The email continues.

I hear your sermons on this, but may have missed your real-world recommendations for how to do these things?

I try to present the real-world recommendations every time I preach. I ask people all the time in my messages, “Who told you to do the things you do? Who told you to get licenses? Who told you to pay forced insurance? Who told you to put pieces of metal on your car with special numbers and letters? Who told you to get id cards from other men in order to exist? When they move from the plastic id cards to an implanted micro-chip, are you going to do that, too? Who is telling you the way you are expected to live your life? Are you getting these commands from God? Or are you getting them from men?

If you answer that you are trying to live by the voice of God, the voice of Christ only - then as you obey - you are going to figure things out for yourself.

When I was 20 years old - I became convinced that the u.s. social security was the “mark of the beast.” And anyone who took that mark was lost. That's what it says in the Book of Revelation as clear as anything is in our Bibles. Anyone who took the “mark of the beast” was damned. Simple. Plain. Clear. Well, I believed that in 1982, that number

- which if a man doesn't have - the world has made it very difficult to buy or sell - I believed that number was the "mark of the beast" and I could not use it. At that time, I didn't have anyone telling me how to live without that number. I continued living my life and whenever someone demanded that number - I refused - and figured out a way to get what I needed, or do what I needed to do, without the number.

In this demon filled world of men who believe they are to control the lives of everyone - the temptation is to just do what they say to get along. To make sure you don't have any issues with them. To avoid repercussions. But God said,

There is no temptation taken you - such as is common to man -

They've made their lifestyle mandates common to all men. Nearly everyone has fallen for the temptation to comply with them. To go along to get along. But God said,

There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.

When I made the commitment to never use that number again - I can tell you - I have never used that number or any other number for that matter - for more than 40 years. That number can not be part of the life of someone who claims to be a follower of Christ. That is what I believe. That is what I have preached and lived for more than 40 years. No one told me how to live in this world without that number and to avoid repercussions. I can't tell you what to do. I can't tell you how it works - I can only tell you what I believe the Bible says - what God wants for His children - and you have to work it out yourself. Turn to Philippians chapter 2, read beginning with verse 1.

[1] If there be therefore any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any bowels and mercies,

[2] Fulfil ye my joy, that ye be likeminded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind.

[3] Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves.

[4] Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others.

[5] Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:

[6] Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:

[7] But made Himself of no reputation, and took upon Him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men:

[8] And being found in fashion as a man, He humbled Himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

“What would Jesus do?” said the churchman as he was selling rubber bracelets to all the naive churchpeople who fell for his latest merchandise. Yeah. What would Jesus do - until they remember they He humbled Himself and became obedient unto death, even the death penalty of the state.

[9] Wherefore God also hath highly exalted Him, and given Him a name which is above every name:

[10] That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;

Of course. Again, great talk behind closed doors or around the campfire. Singing songs and eating smores. But demand that every knee bow, every tongue confess? Not hardly. Imagine politicians bowing their knee to Christ. Presidents, kings, members of the world economic forum. Bill Gates. Not a chance. But Christians are to hold everyone Philippians 2:9-10. Every knee is to bow. Every tongue is to confess that Jesus Christ is Lord.

[11] And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

[12] Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.

I can't tell you what to do. Sure, I'll tell you what I've done. I'll tell you how I've lived. But you have to work these things out for yourself in your own life. And I'm absolutely not going to give you some false hope that if you make the choice to follow Christ the King - the world is going to leave you alone. They tried to put me in prison for 98 years. We fought them for almost five years. They did everything they could to ruin me, ruin my family, they wanted to destroy us. But I have already given my life to Christ. I had already counted the cost. I believed the Words of Christ concerning taking up my own cross and following Him. I wasn't going to turn my back on Christ when the world tried to nail me on my own cross.

We aren't talking about works for our own salvation. We can't do that. That's not what this means. It means you know what it means to follow Christ. Now obey. Follow Christ. Even if it means following Him to your own cross.

[13] For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure.

[14] Do all things without murmurings and disputings:

[15] That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world;

Is anyone going to dare tell me that we do not live in a crooked and perverse nation? Scofield didn't even say that. He said the world was in the greatest crisis ever in 1918. William Miller said his world was in the greatest crisis ever. They all say their world is in the greatest crisis ever. That's because we live in a world that rejects the rule of Christ and demands the rule of demons and devils. And each generation that prefers man's rule over God's rule is going to be a crooked and perverse nation. But nonetheless, regardless of the condition of the world around us - we are commanded to remain blameless and harmless - the sons of God - not the sons of the world - not citizens of the world - the sons of God.

[16] Holding forth the Word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ, that I have not run in vain, neither laboured in vain.

The email continues.

I as much as anyone wants to follow Gods law, but other than joining the Amish community, how do you propose we do this?

I got news for you. The Amish community is not following God's Law. But if they were - why would anyone who claims to be a follower of Christ - not say - "I think I better join the Amish?" Listen now, I'm not criticizing the man who emailed me. But what we are seeing - not just here - but with a whole lot of others who have written to me - and don't take this as criticism - don't take this to be offensive - I'm just trying to help - I'm trying to encourage - you can't leave the world and take it with you at the same time.

If being a Christian means to join the Amish - then we better join as fast as we can. But again - the Amish are not Christian. The Amish are not following Christ and following

the Laws of God. They are just another religion with a whole set of their own definitions of good and evil, right and wrong, they are as demon possessed as anyone else who believes they are the ones who determine right and wrong, good and evil.

*Sincerely, I am not being condescending, i truly am wondering what you suggest?
Is there any good books on the process or other documented writings on how to do so?*

Now to the last email.

Ok, I'm hearing your suggestion as, if I have to go to jail and not be able to provide for my family and children that is what may happen and be ok with that?

Friends, you have to remember, and I'm not being condescending, I'm not talking down to anyone - but I did not write the Book. I just read it and believe it like everyone else is supposed to. First of all, no one wants to go to jail. I can't imagine anyone in their right mind wanting to go to jail. Christ told His Father - "If this cup - the 'baptism of death' could pass from Me, let that happen - but either way - it's not My Will but Thine." No one wants to go to jail - it is a horrible place - and they make it so. But I will tell you this - I think it's safe to say that the jails that Peter and James and John and Paul and countless others who were in from the time of Christ through the ages - I think it's safe to say those jails were probably a whole lot worse than jails today - maybe.

Think about these passages in our Bibles.

[10] But thou hast fully known my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, faith, longsuffering, charity, patience,

[11] Persecutions, afflictions, which came unto me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra; what persecutions I endured: but out of them all the Lord delivered me.

[12] Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution.

[10] For he that will love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no guile:

[11] Let him eschew evil, and do good; let him seek peace, and ensue it.

[12] For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and his ears are open unto their prayers: but the face of the Lord is against them that do evil.

[13] And who is he that will harm you, if ye be followers of that which is good?

[14] But and if ye suffer for righteousness' sake, happy are ye: and be not afraid of their terror, neither be troubled;

[15] But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear:

[16] Having a good conscience; that, whereas they speak evil of you, as of evildoers, they may be ashamed that falsely accuse your good conversation in Christ.

[17] For it is better, if the will of God be so, that ye suffer for well doing, than for evil doing.

How could it possibly be that someone suffer for well doing? How could your clear conscience be called evil and a good conversation - manner of living according to Christ - be called evil? We live in a world filled with demons and devils and satans. We live in an antiChrist world - and friends - it's not because that's the way God wants it. We live in the world because that is the world that has come from rebellion - from men choosing to live against the way of God - and no one - virtually no one standing up and saying "You are wrong. You aren't ordained of God to rule according to your own definitions of good and evil. You are actually demon possessed devils who have refused to bow the knee and confess that Christ is the Only Lord." Virtually no one in the last 200 years or so has had the courage to stand for Christ in the face of a world that despises Him. That's why demon possession has so flourished. We live in a world that says it's better to just go along to get along than to risk any persecution or loss at the hands of the demons - yet Christ said - Christ said - not Charlie - I would have, could have never come up with the concept that our love for God should be deeper than our love for our families and our lives. The email says:

The bible says to provide for your family, raise up your children, and raise an inheritance for them, train them in the scriptures etc....

Yes. Exactly. And that is to be done by example, not by words only. We are to obey Christ first and foremost - above everything else. I've heard that for 40 years - provide for your family - even at the risk of disobeying God. The whole duty of man is to obey God - and it doesn't say there are exceptions to that rule.

How can I do that if i am put in jail for not paying my taxes since that is the system my parents signed me up for...

Once again, I'm not being critical of a man's words, but when I read what I just read - this sounds exactly the same thing to me as when God asked Adam why he sinned -

Adam said, "Well, it was the woman you gave me."

At some point, we become grown men and women. And we can no longer blame our parents. Blame our grandparents. Blame our great great grandparents, our great great great grandparents who seemingly thought the u.s. CONstitution was the greatest thing since sliced bread - literally. The blame game needs to stop. None of this is our parents' fault. This is not God's fault. This is our fault. We have allowed this to continue in our generation. Each generation gets the offer to turn to God and start over again. If your parents signed you up - then as a grown adult - you can nullify that contract.

Problem is, take the contract their parents made and run with it. The email says.

Yes I have a social and a birth certificate, i know the "rabbit hole" of these documents and how i have signed up for a w-9, w-2 tax payer employee etc.

Ok. Well, if you know the rabbit hole - and that's certainly an understatement - it's not a rabbit hole - it's pure rebellion against the face of God and sticking a fist in the face of God and saying - "We don't care what your Laws say - we are going to do things our way." God never told you to "sign up for a W-9 or a W-2 of whatever else letters and numbers they require. God never said to do any of that. That is men deciding what's good and what's evil and followers of Christ should not be doing it. If you are in a "line of business" that requires those letters and numbers - then find something that doesn't. And no one is going to tell me that it can't be done today because I see it happening all the time. I've seen men close doors on Christians and I've seen God open another door to walk right on through. I've seen grown men go from being employees of other men - to having their own "businesses" without numbers and licenses, etc., and I've seen those men flourish in the blessings of God because of their refusal to live according to the dictates of men.

And, let me say this - their whole system works on tattling on each other. That's what the w9s and the 2s and all that is for. If a man is serious about following Christ and wants to lower the risk - if that's possible - then stop doing the things in their world that exposes the risk. The email continues.

But I want to do it in a way that sets me apart legally and sets me apart as many of the "state citizens" claim to be able to do so by following Gods laws and having any documentation ready in case someone does knock on my door one day demanding my "freedom" or back funds....

Well, that's the old make the cake and eat it, too. If you think there is a way to “legally set yourself apart from the world” then all I can say is “Good luck.” Do you really think the world has created a “legal” way to separate yourself from them? Christ is the Author of freedom. Christ is the way out. There are no silver bullets in the world's system and their prisons have lots of people in there who thought they found a “legal way out” and then when they got arrested and taken to court and they tried to argue their CON or their statutes against them - they got laughed right out of court and into jail. I've seen this over and over and over.

Their own declaration of independence says consent consent consent. “Governments” exist by consent of the “governed” and they laugh at their own document. On July 4th it's nothing for them to have roadblocks set up demanding to see papers and if you don't have them - they take you to jail.

The way to freedom is through Christ. Through obeying the God of the Bible.

There was more to that email, but I'm out of time. I will address one more thing from the last email. Quote:

Thanks Charlie, I get what you are saying, and i know there's no silver bullet.

I'm not saying you are the only one preaching this message, but does anyone else write extensively on this topic of Gods government only...?

I have heard all the same arguments you allude to in your sermons about the principalities and rulers of this world. I know we are to not be of the world but I have heard from a lot of people "living in the private" as it is termed, coming out of the public, and yes some of them call themselves state citizens.

Okay. So. This is what I'm saying. The follower of Christ does not use the world's numbers. They are then - for just lack of a better phrase “living in the private.” The world thinks they own you. They can tell you what your name is. They can tell you where to go, when to go, how to go and they do so because when you use their numbers and papers - you are admitting to them that they do in fact - own you. Use their id cards. That is saying you are identified by them. You belong to them.

If you say you do not belong to them - then you can't just say it - you have to live it. I saw this myself. I went through myself. For five years they put my life under a

microscope trying to find somewhere, somehow, where I had said one thing - but actually did another. And they couldn't do it. There is no record of me using their number. There is no record of me identifying with them. In Missouri, when someone gets their drivers license - the handbook says - taking the license means implied consent. It means you are consenting to do what they say. They could not produce anything in my life that says I gave them my consent.

They had a "tax expert" say - "he filed a tax form when he was 16 years old and that shows that he knows it was the right thing to do." To which I replied, "No it doesn't. It proves the exact opposite. It proves that for the next 56 years I knew it to be the wrong thing - and I never did it again. That's what that proves." They could not produce one shred of evidence that I have ever used their number. That I have ever taken their license. That I have ever given consent to follow anyone or anything other than Christ.

And people say, "Yeah, but for me it's different because I've done it my whole life and now I'm finding out it was wrong." Ok. That's the beautiful thing about coming to Christ. Age doesn't matter. God is willing to forgive and forget - wipe the slate clean - no matter what the age - no matter how long someone has been living in sin - the hand of God is not shortened to forgive just because someone was a sinner for most or all of his life.

The email continues.

I know what you are saying about not even being a state citizen, and that is fine too, but their education on how to live in the private while also understanding "their" terms and "legaleez" to help fight the system when they try to mess with you...Does that make sense what i'm saying?

Only to a certain extent. Only to where there may only be Biblical principles involved. Listen to me, I have been in this fight for a long long time. I've been in this fight for longer than the man who emailed me has been alive. When I was writing letters to their court telling them how and why I live the way I do - I used the phrase "common law." And you know what - that was a huge mistake. A huge mistake. It was such a huge mistake - I had to write them another letter and tell them that everytime I used that phrase - I was making a mistake. I had been operating under the delusion that the phrase "common law" meant God's Law. That is stupidity. That is not what it means and if you go into one of their courts and use that phrase they are going to think you are a total idiot if you say you obey God's Law. Common law means the decisions that have

been handed down by their court systems through the years. By their court systems. By their judges. It has nothing whatsoever to do with God's Laws. These "sovereign citizens" that go into their courts and try to argue their "laws and statutes" against them - that is 100% total folly. Now, they may get a "victory" here and there - but I'll assure you that is only to keep the charade going - or the facade that there's hope for the little man. The Christian must stand on the Bible. The Christian must stand on Christ.

A kind of "Know thy enemy" type of approach. For example the (Blacks law dictionary) definitions compared to everyday english words alone get us into their "jurisdiction" without any knowledge of the man or woman knowing it sometimes.

You can't argue "jurisdiction" to a demon who believes that he possesses everything and everyone. You get into "their jurisdiction" when you carry around their id card. When you take their license, when you use their numbers, when you put their metal on your car and when you go to All State to get into their good hands.

You don't argue "jurisdiction" - you let your life prove that you are solely and completely under the jurisdiction of God and not man when you live your life without man's documents. You aren't going to argue "jurisdiction" say you have no authority over me - when everything in your billfold says otherwise. The email continues.

I don't want to beat a dead horse, but all i'm saying is there is a way to learn the system in which we are being controlled by, to overcome it, come out and follow only Gods laws, and also have answers and correct right standing if and when the governments of the world call to "punish us."

The Bible says:

For your obedience is come abroad unto all men. I am glad therefore on your behalf: but yet I would have you wise unto that which is good, and simple concerning evil.

If you want to learn their system. Do this. Go spend about a month sitting in one of their criminal courtrooms. You'll learn more from doing that than you'll ever learn from these "sovereign citizens" or from watching youtube videos. The youtube videos - the man tells the cop - "I'm not going to give you my id." Then they argue about the CON. They argue about the "statutes". Then the cop proceeds to tell the guy he's going to jail

if he doesn't provide the id - and the sovereign citizen says, "Well if you tell me you're going to arrest me if I don't give you an id, then I'll go ahead and give it to you." If that is the type of individual that you think "knows the system" etc., then all I can say is, "Good luck with that."

It seems to me about education, learning and standing on the word of God and also understanding the enemy to be able to fight them with there own structure, because we know how it works.

Absolutely. Let's learn the Word of God and stand on the Word of God. You aren't going to "fight them with their own structure." They change their structure all the time. It's never the same. Not only is it not the same on their paper - it isn't the same from one cop to the next. From one persecutor to the next. From one judge to the next. There's nothing sure in their system. The only thing that is sure - is that their system is unsure. It is just like Christ said - it is a house built on sinking sand. Learn the Word of God. Learn the mind of God - the Will of God and stand on that.

I have been learning from different people about how the social security card, license, birth certificate, w2, w9 etc. are all contracts and have the majority of men and women chained because of them.

Of course. So you don't, you can't, learn how to overcome all of that while still holding onto it. All of those things are evil and Christians are to run from evil and from the appearance of evil.

Also learning about private property, owning your own land, land patents, etc.

You say live by Gods laws only, well how do you build a house, install a septic, hook up to electricity without being apart of this world in some way?

You just do it. You get a piece of land and you build your house. You install a septic. If you want to get electricity - you just go to the electric company and tell them to hook you up. The better thing to do is to make your own electricity with solar panels and batteries - but the electric company will not turn you down because you don't have a number to give them. They might make you pay a deposit - but so what - you'll get it back in a year. And, don't try to tell me that can't be done. I've done it before - and we did it again just a year ago.

You say all the time to have no part of this world government, and also say it is a process of cutting ties in every way possible little by little or as much as we can.

I'm praying hard for discernment, wisdom and digging in scripture as I am praying believing for revelation from Gods word as i read and meditate daily.

And that is awesome. When we obey, God gives us more. The more we obey, the more He gives.

I must say I haven't been this convicted about anything in my life as much as this topic, and i know that is a good thing...

And that, too, is awesome. Being convicted of sin is a great thing. That means we're still in touch with the Father.

Thanks again for hearing me, and helping me and being patient as i'm sure i'm one of a thousand who ask the same questions for you over and over...

I have been cutting off so many other worldly, "churchianity" concepts and false practices the past few years, and it is a process, unlearning really is the hardest kind of learning... Indoctrination, cognitive dissonance, and family traditions are strong, but compared to our Kings government that which his burden is easy and his yoke is light the choice is simple.

Amen, amen and amen! Those are fantastic comments.

I want everyday to live under Gods government, to make the kingdom of God more tangible and real than the dirt under my literal feet. I know he is calling his people out, and many people around me are waking up to the deception of "futurism." I am trying to help people, and i get into debates a lot about futurist concepts. I am finally being persecuted and being called preaching false doctrine, when it's so easy now to see I used to have it wrong for 40 years...

His Kingdom is here now, the end of the age happened, we are in the new covenant age, Praise God and Jesus the Christ!

That is awesome. Very happy to read and hear these things. I truly hope and pray that fire continues to kindle and grow into a consuming fire that won't let go. Once we begin to actually live according to the faith - I promise you - God will lead you. He will guide

you. He will show you the steps to take. He didn't tell us to live this way and then just leave us like fish out of water.

Now a final word of caution. This emailer is expressing a lot of zeal. And that's great. I would never ever do anything but encourage that. But I have seen many times - and I mean many times - where someone gets all fired up about wanting to live right and wanting to come out of the world - and then when they begin counting the cost - or when they realize that this is not just a fly-by-night happenstance - that it is real work - hard work - it's a fight - it's a battle - and if they do not feel that they have instant success - then they just get discouraged, give up hope and quit. And when, or if those thoughts of quitting arise, I want you to be reminded of the Words of Christ. I'll close with Luke 9:44-62:

[44] Let these sayings sink down into your ears: for the Son of man shall be delivered into the hands of men.

[45] But they understood not this saying, and it was hid from them, that they perceived it not: and they feared to ask Him of that saying.

[46] Then there arose a reasoning among them, which of them should be greatest.

[47] And Jesus, perceiving the thought of their heart, took a child, and set him by him,

[48] And said unto them, Whosoever shall receive this child in my name receiveth me: and whosoever shall receive me receiveth him that sent me: for he that is least among you all, the same shall be great.

[49] And John answered and said, Master, we saw one casting out devils in thy name; and we forbad him, because he followeth not with us.

[50] And Jesus said unto him, Forbid him not: for he that is not against us is for us.

[51] And it came to pass, when the time was come that he should be received up, he stedfastly set his face to go to Jerusalem,

[52] And sent messengers before his face: and they went, and entered into a village of the Samaritans, to make ready for him.

[53] And they did not receive him, because his face was as though he would go to Jerusalem.

[54] And when his disciples James and John saw this, they said, Lord, wilt thou that we command fire to come down from heaven, and consume them, even as Elias did?

[55] But he turned, and rebuked them, and said, Ye know not what manner of

spirit ye are of.

[56] For the Son of man is not come to destroy men's lives, but to save them. And they went to another village.

[57] And it came to pass, that, as they went in the way, a certain man said unto him, Lord, I will follow thee whithersoever thou goest.

[58] And Jesus said unto him, Foxes have holes, and birds of the air have nests; but the Son of man hath not where to lay his head.

[59] And he said unto another, Follow me. But he said, Lord, suffer me first to go and bury my father.

[60] Jesus said unto him, Let the dead bury their dead: but go thou and preach the kingdom of God.

[61] And another also said, Lord, I will follow thee; but let me first go bid them farewell, which are at home at my house.

[62] And Jesus said unto him, No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God.
